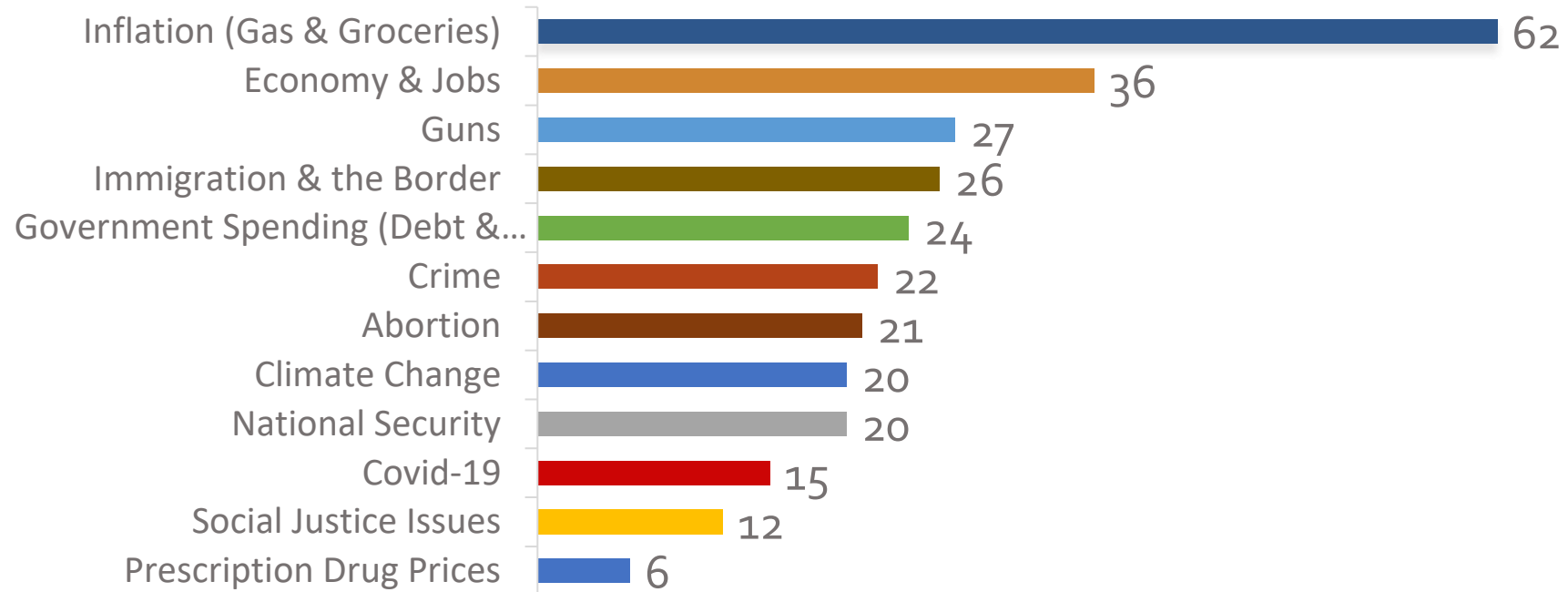

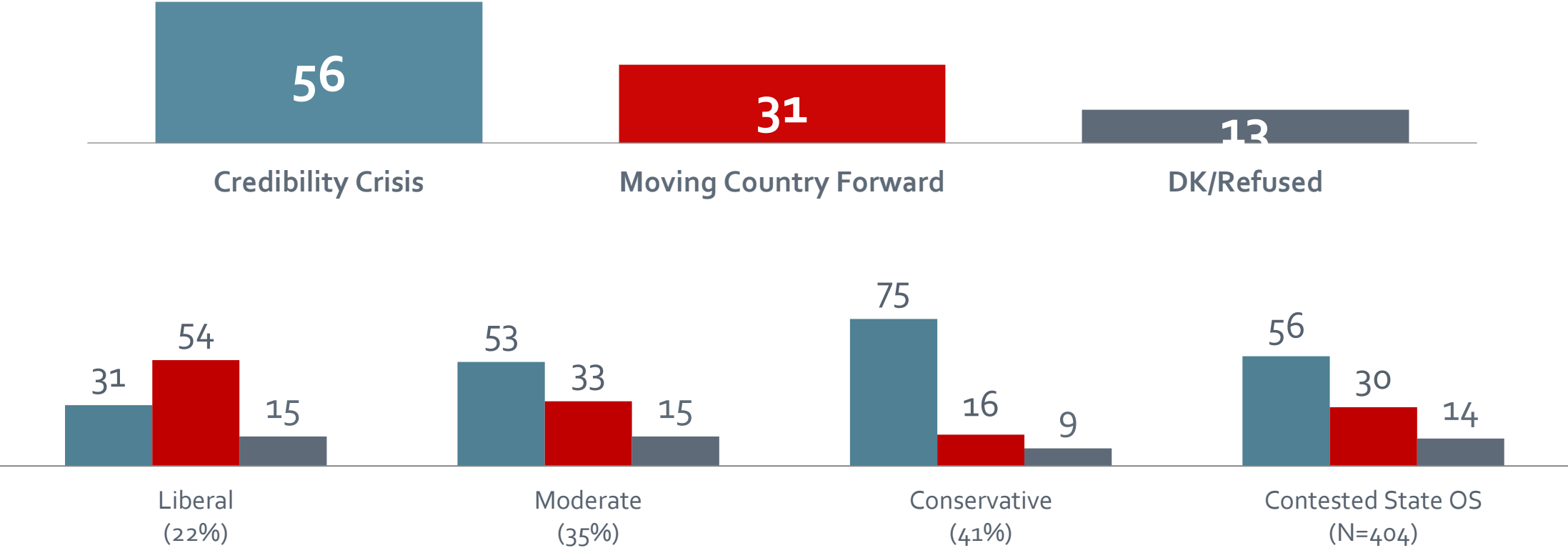
In your personal opinion, do you think President Biden and Congressional Democrats are doing enough to stop inflation?

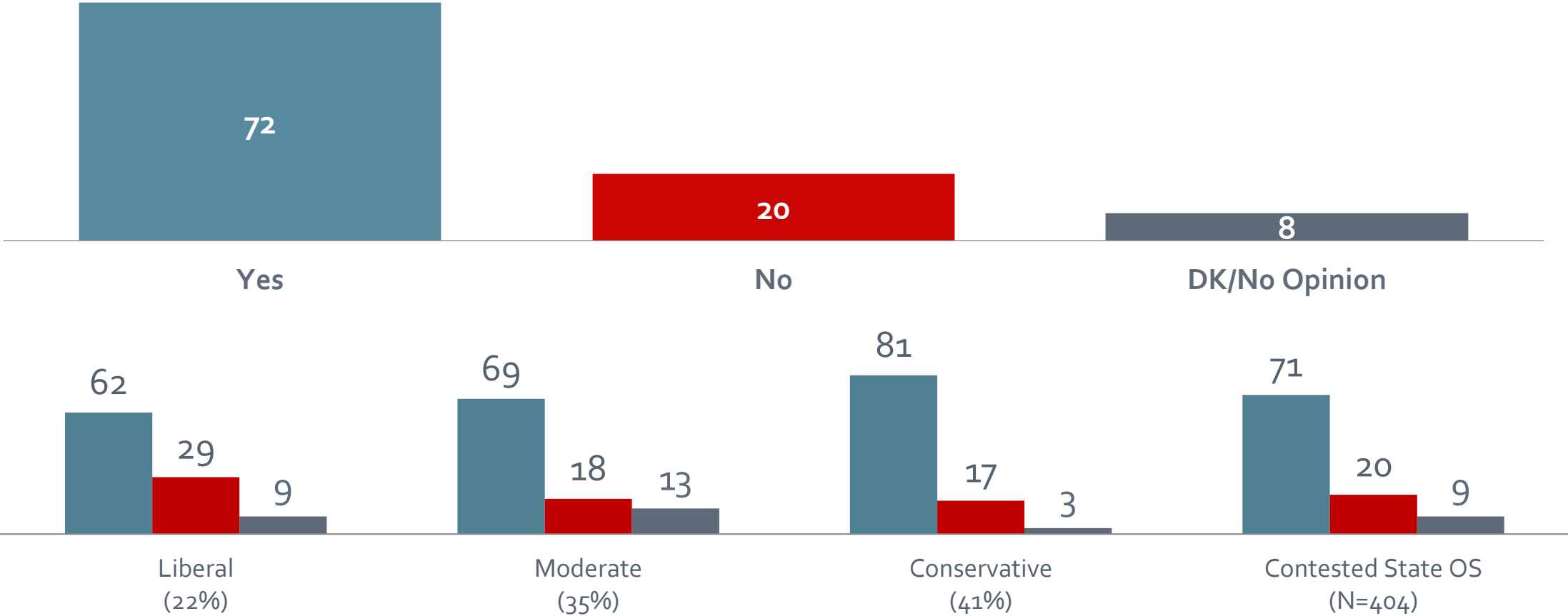

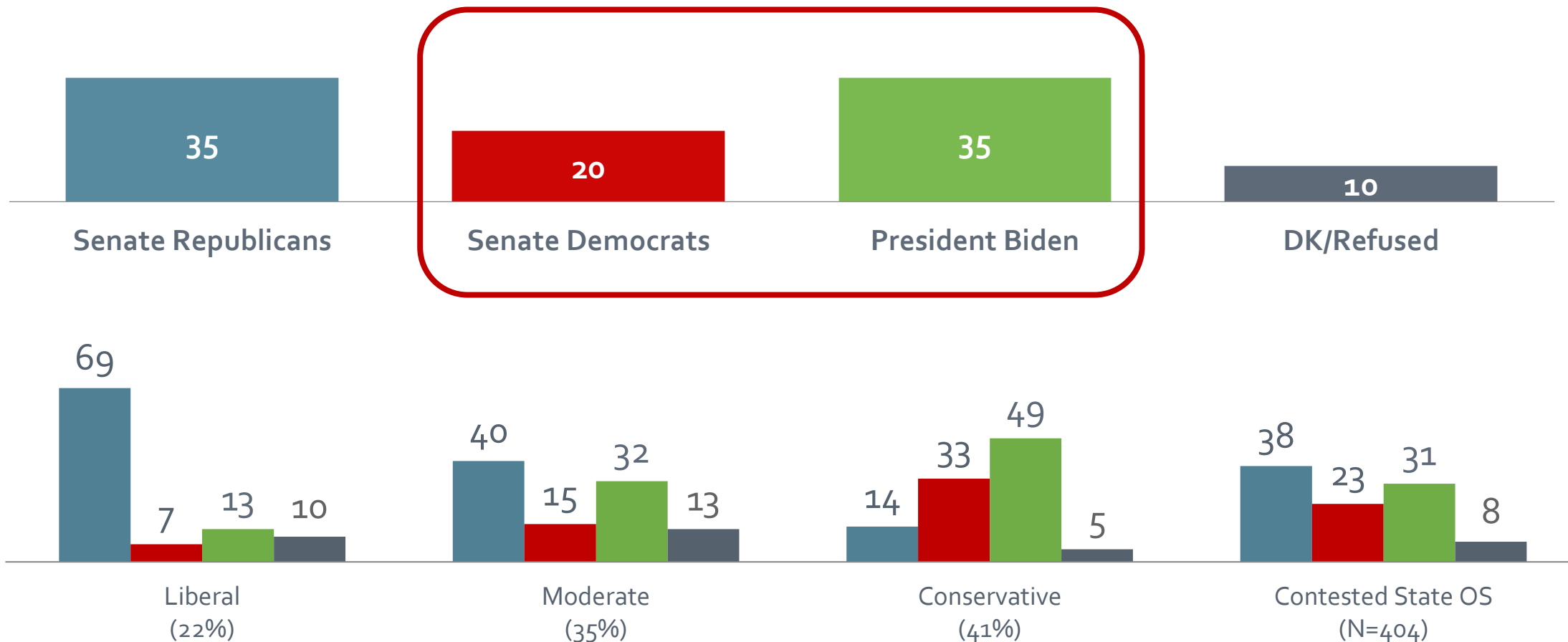
Are you angry with the current state of affairs in Washington, D.C.?

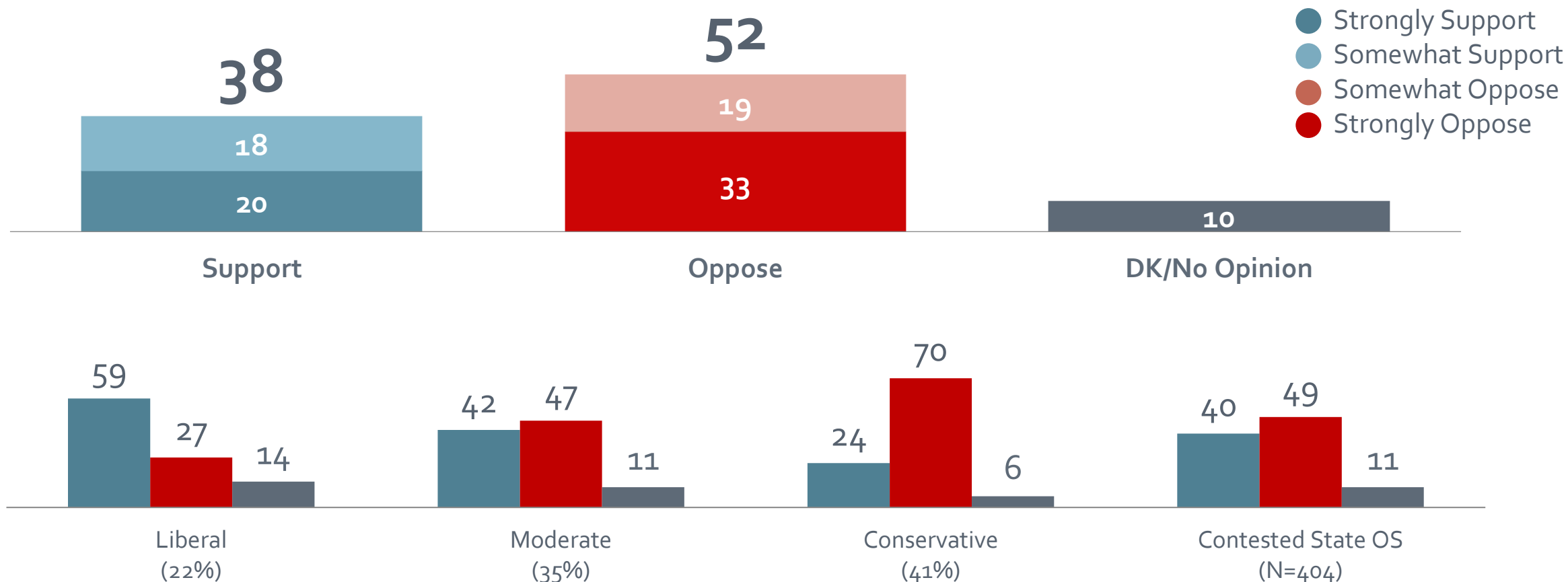

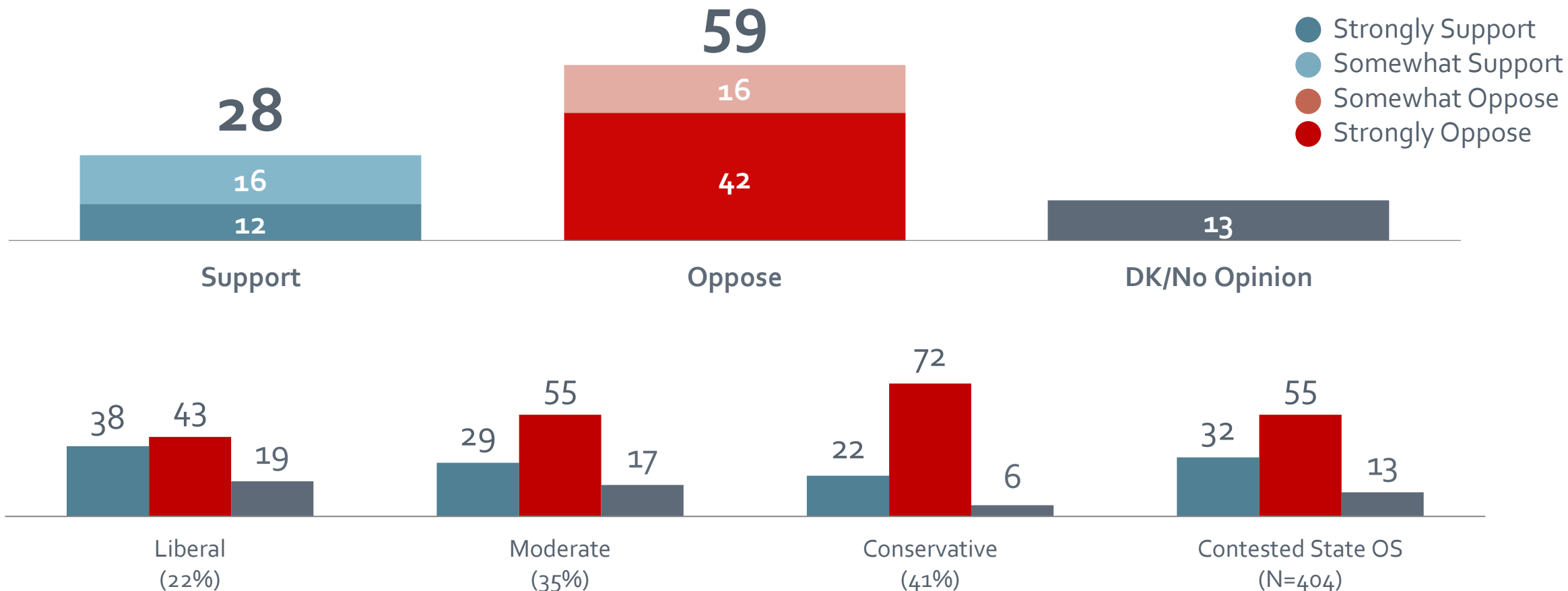
# IRS BUDGET INCREASE

# NEW TAXES

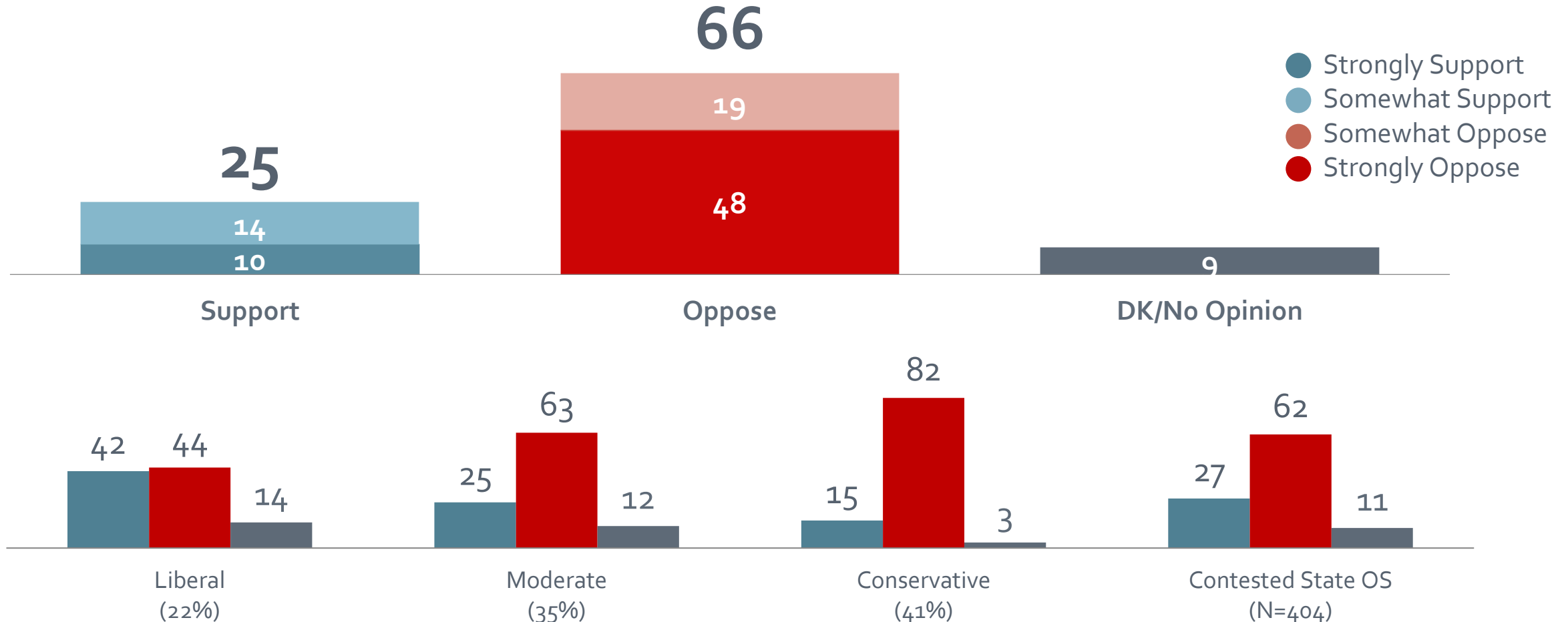

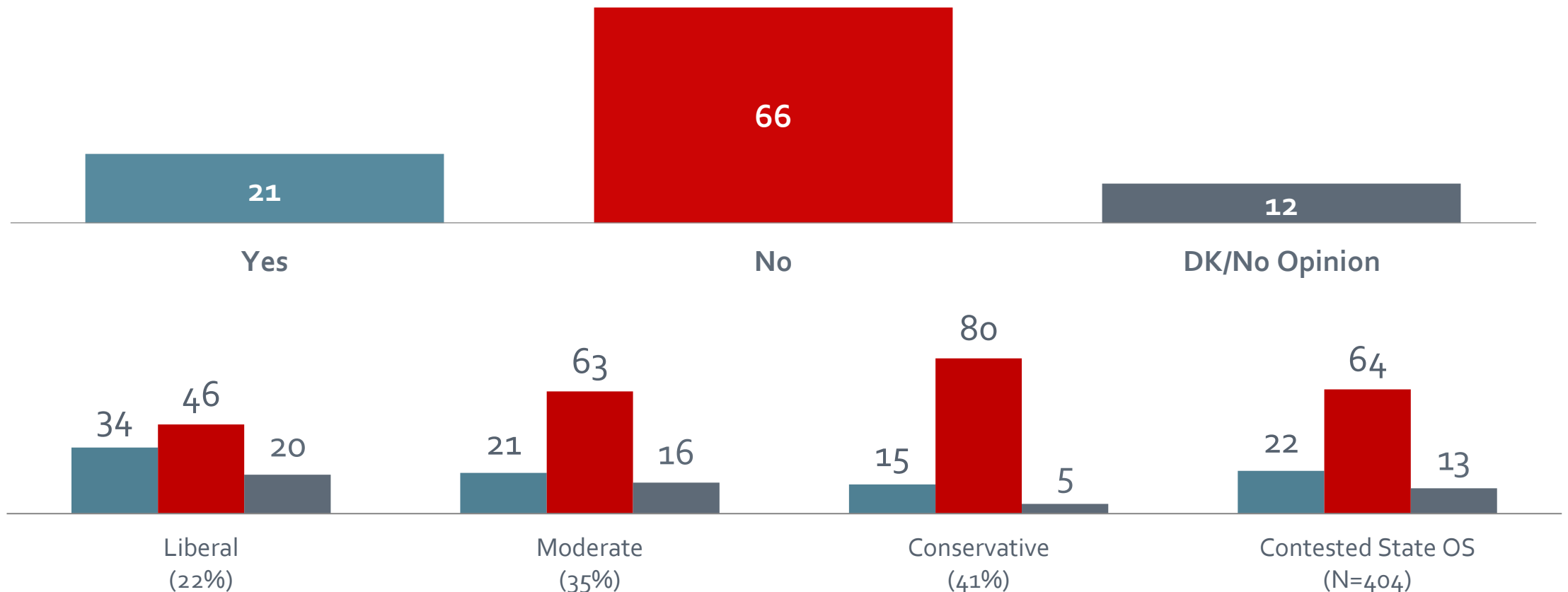
# RAISING TAXES

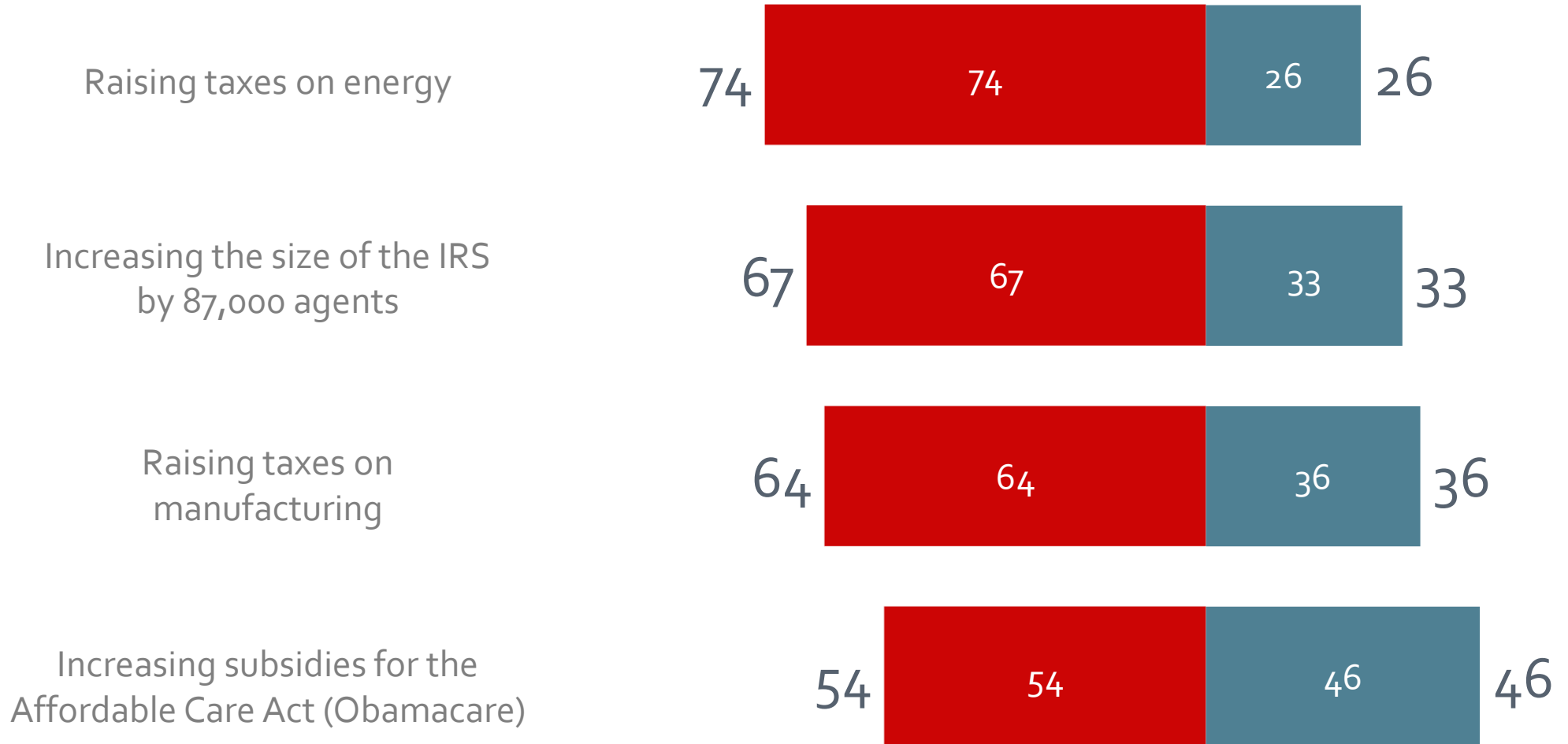
# TIME TO RAISE TAXES

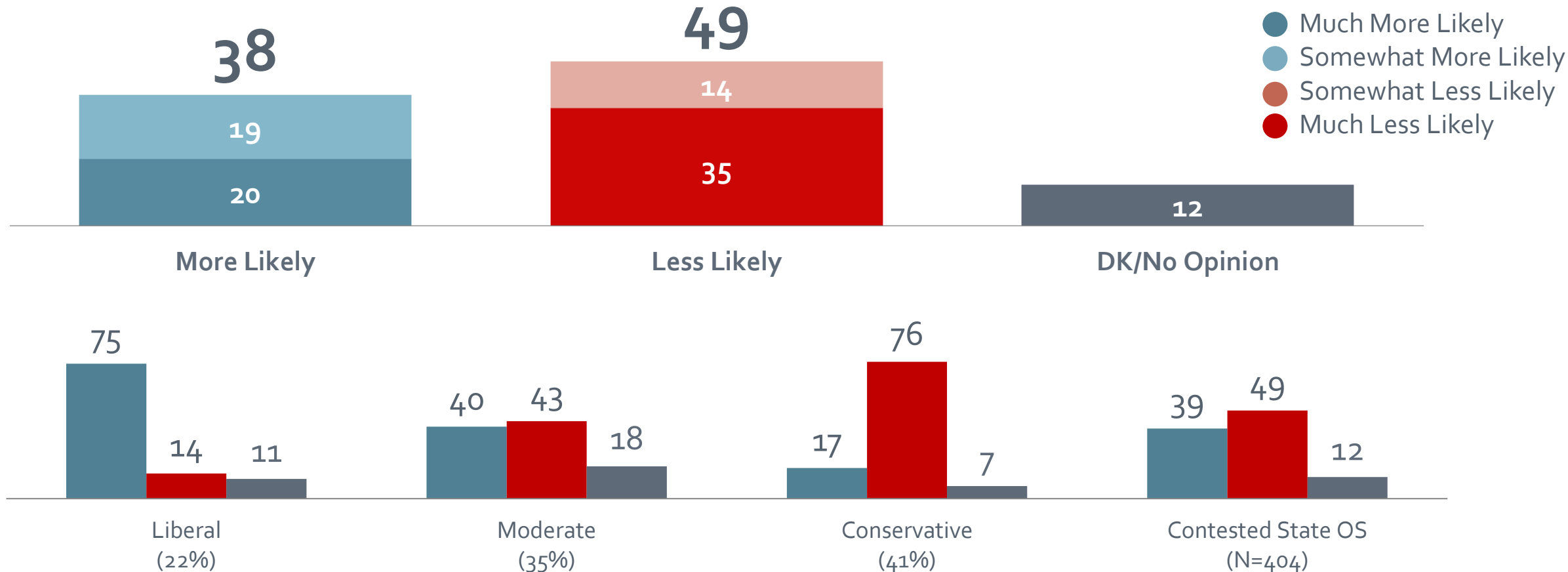
Do you approve or disapprove of the following policies in the Inflation Reduction Act?

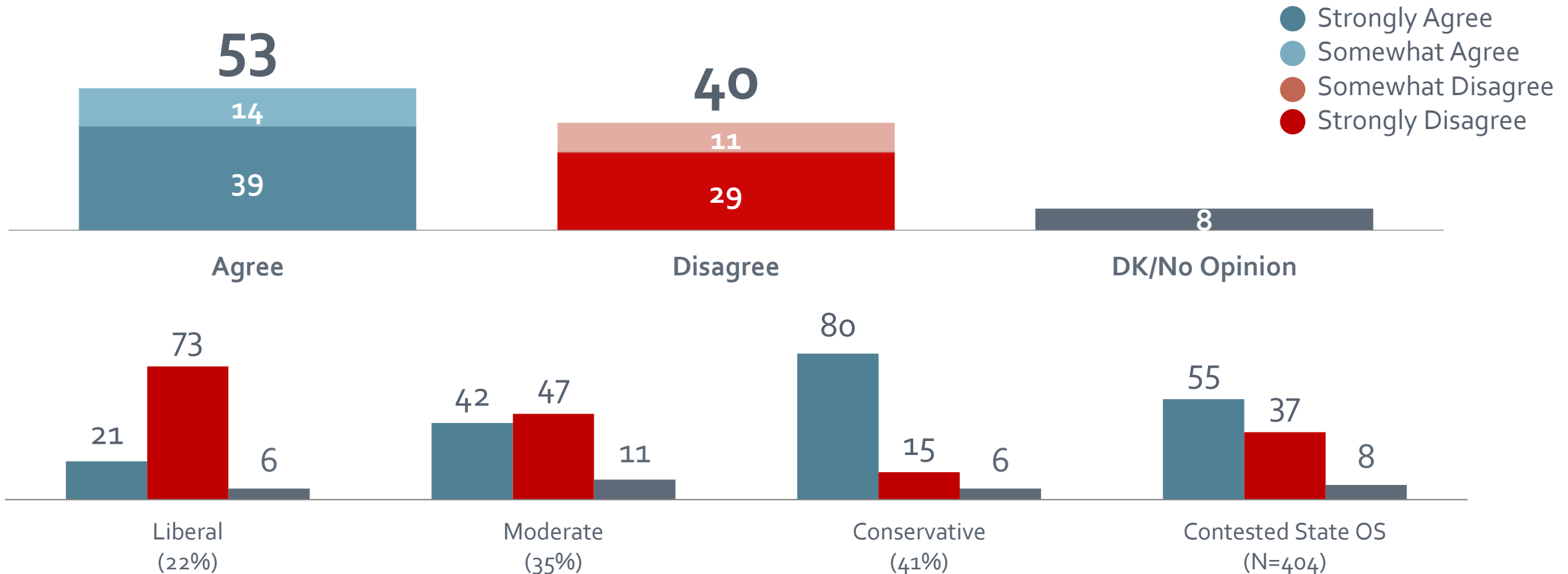

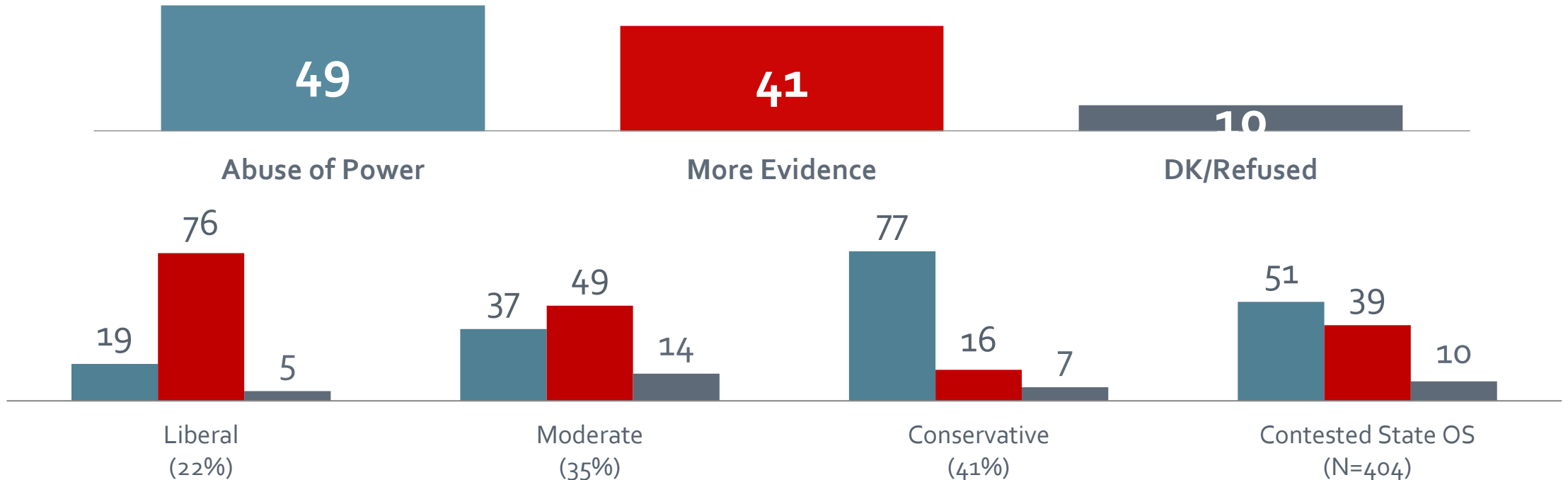


The raid has sparked a great deal of debate about the legitimacy of the investigation and the proper role of the FBI.

With that in mind, please tell me which statement you agree with more even if neither is exactly right.

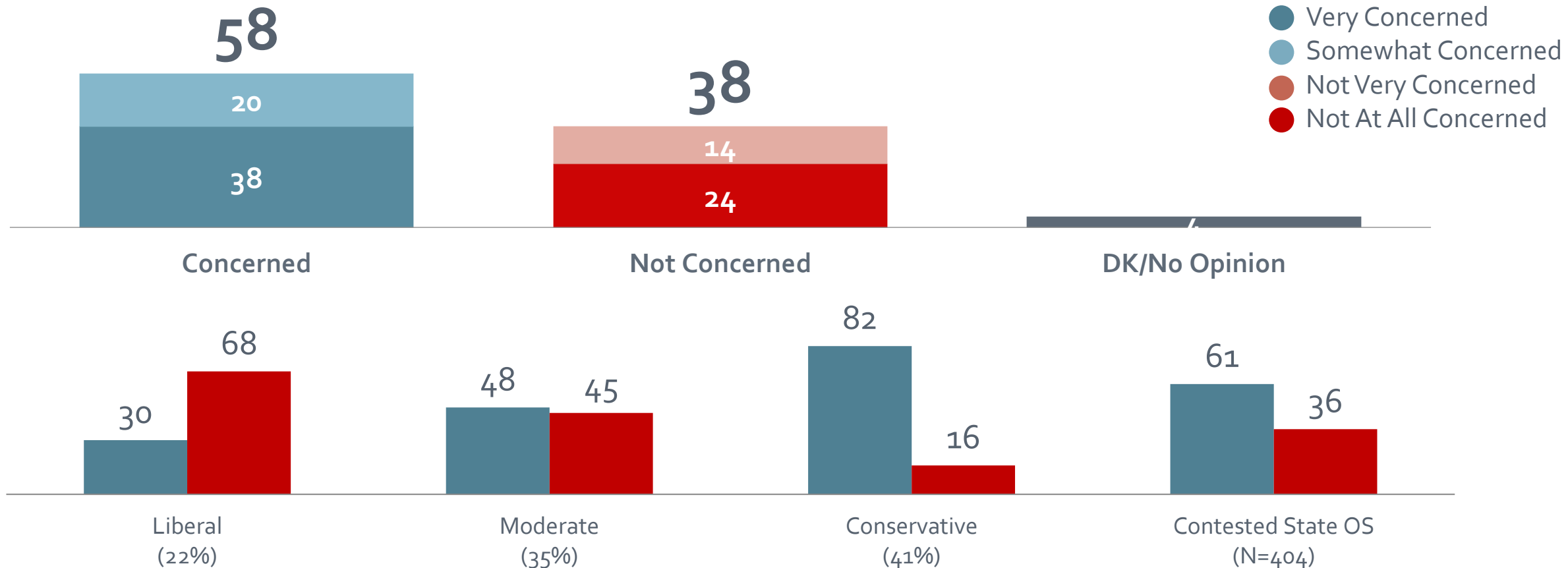

How concerned are you that the FBI stormed into a former President's home without making it clear to the American public why they did it?

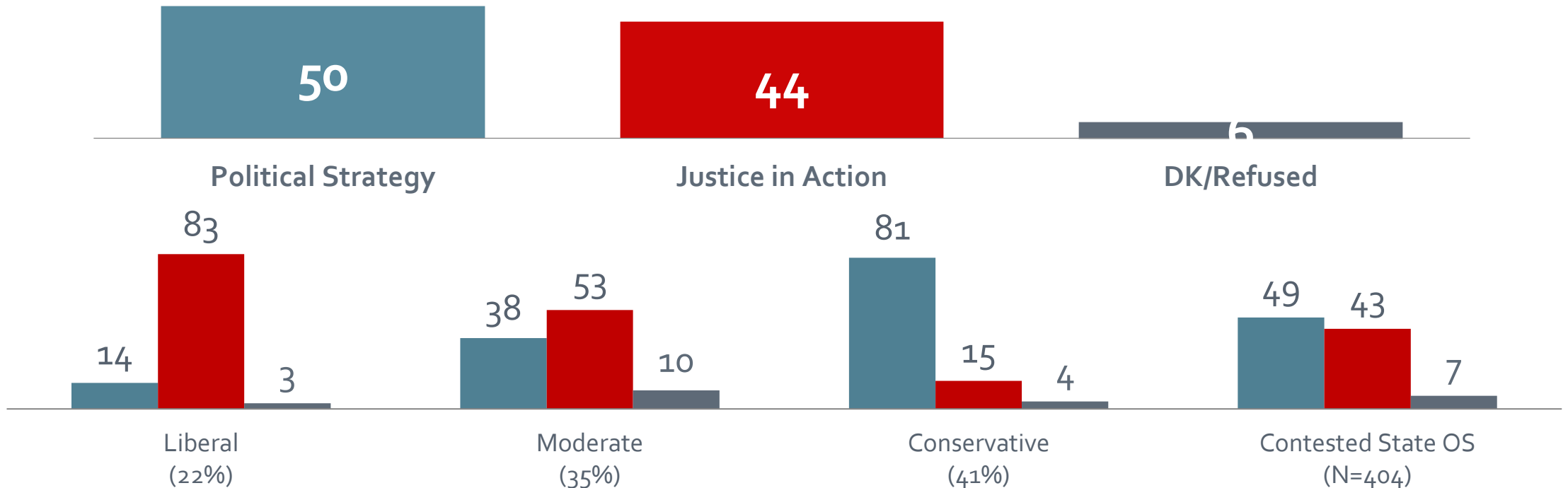




As you may know, the FBI and Department of Justice are agencies under the authority of President Biden. With that in mind, please tell me which statement you agree with more even if neither is exactly right.
