Senate Opportunity Fund is pleased to share the results of a Colorado statewide survey of N=600 likely voters. The survey was fielded September 20-27, 2022 and has a margin of error of +/- 4.0%.

### Political Environment Update:

- Mood of the Country: 42% Right Direction / 53% Wrong Track

### Inflation and Crime Are Top Priorities:

- A strong majority of 65% of Colorado voters list inflation as the most concerning issue facing America. This feeling is strongest with Independents, with 71% saying inflation is a top concern.
- Crime comes in as the second most important issue at 46%, bolstered by Independents and Republicans.

### O'Dea Has a Positive Image:

- Joe O'Dea's image currently sits at 43% favorable / 37% unfavorable with Colorado voters.

### The Senate Ballot is Tied:

- The ballot shows 45% O'Dea / 46% Bennet / 4% Someone Else / 5% Undecided.
- Only 68% of Democrats say they are voting for Bennet.
- Independents have not broken clearly in either direction yet, voting 34% O'Dea / 43% Bennet.
