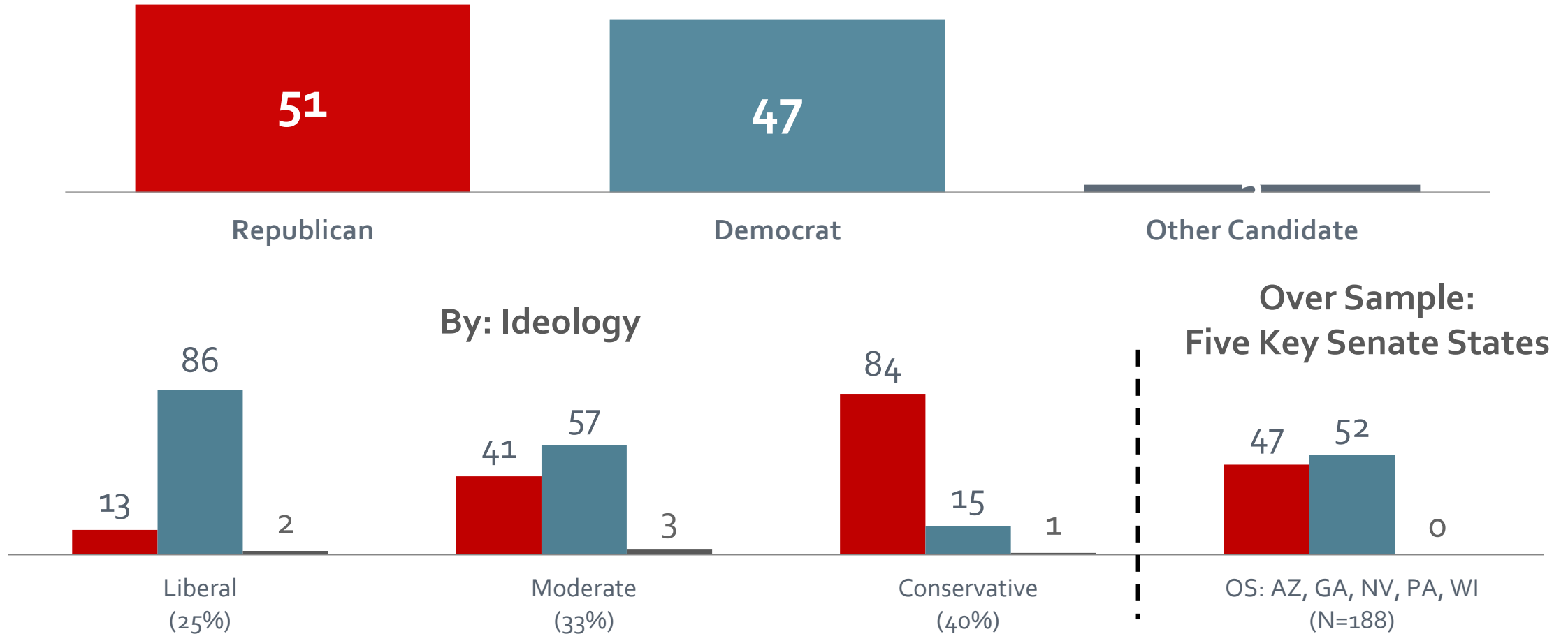

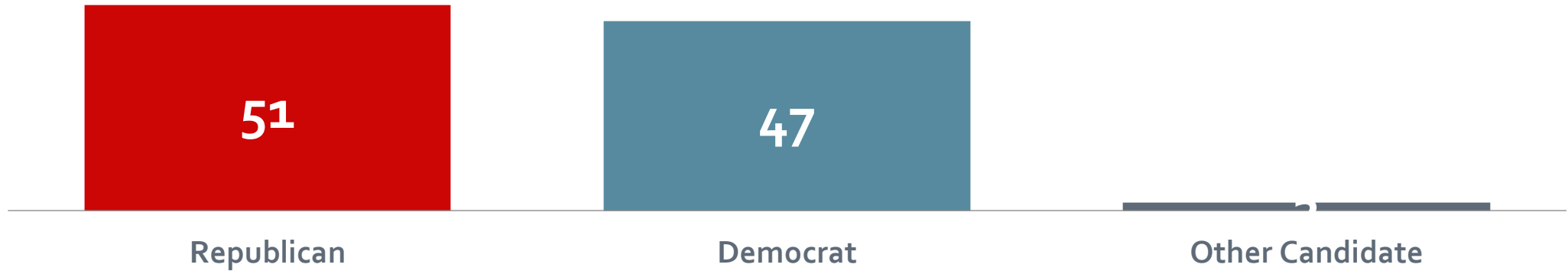
KEY FINDINGS

- While Republicans “won” the national vote total by (currently) a margin of +3.2% in the House, this does not fully explain the geographic concentration of these votes.
 - Note: This margin will likely shrink a bit more as California finishes its vote counting.
- In the five Senate states most crucial to Senate Control (Arizona, Georgia, Nevada, Pennsylvania, Wisconsin) we see that Republicans came up short.
- Notably, while the GOP had October momentum (winning October voters by +19, as we saw in the “catching up” in horserace polling), those deciding either in the last week or on election day were evenly split, defying historical norms of late deciders breaking against the party in the White House.
- Also, while Strongly & Somewhat Biden Approvers voted by similar margins for Democrats, Somewhat Disapprovers were almost evenly split between the parties, muting the possibility of a GOP wave.

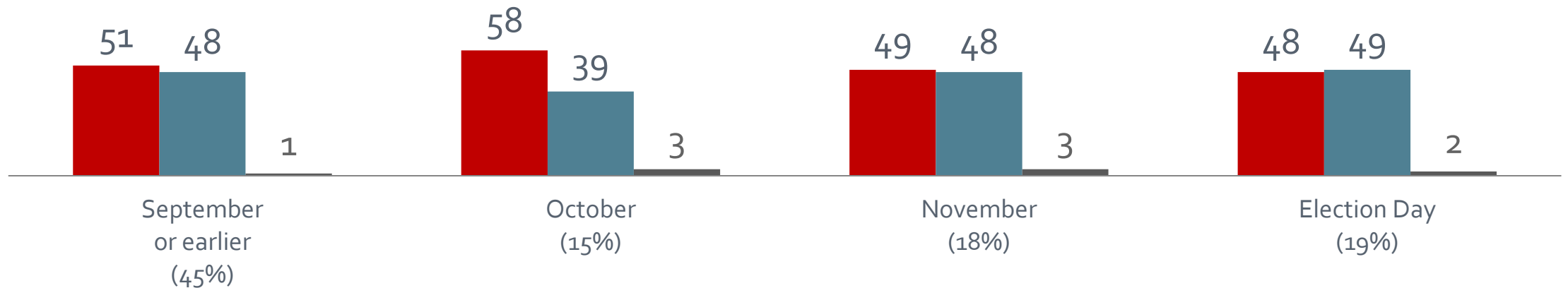
In your local election for Congress, did you vote for the Republican or the Democrat?



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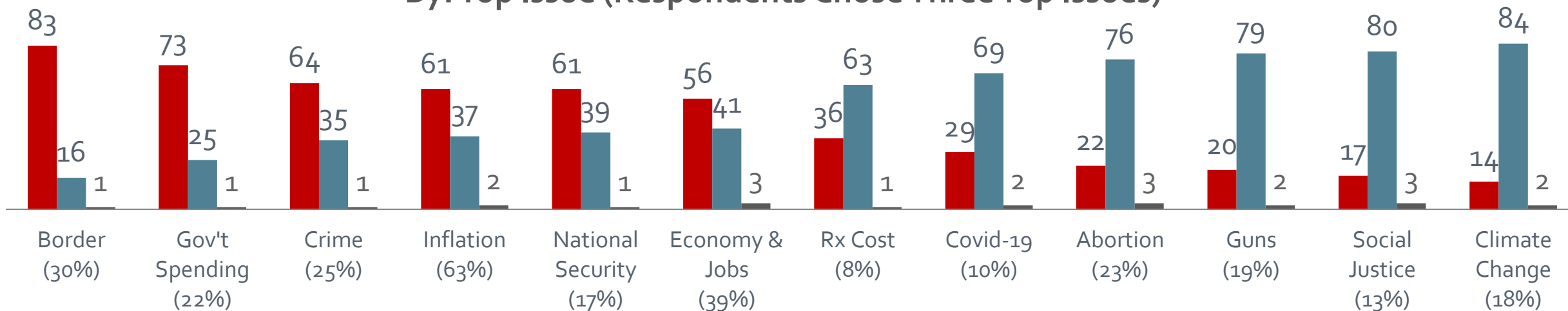
By: Timing of Vote Decision



In your local election for Congress, did you vote for the Republican or the Democrat?



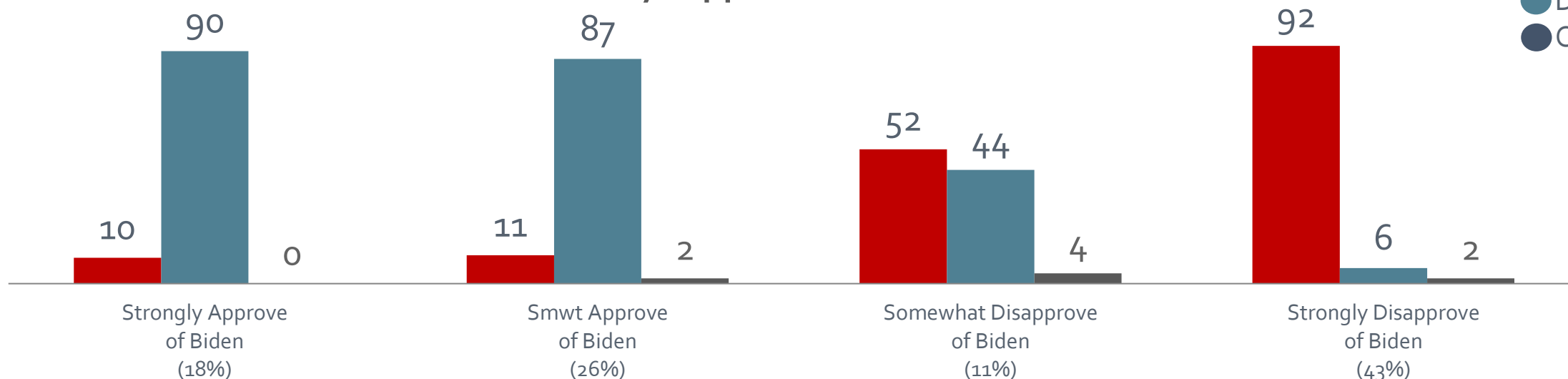
By: Top Issue (Respondents Chose Three Top Issues)



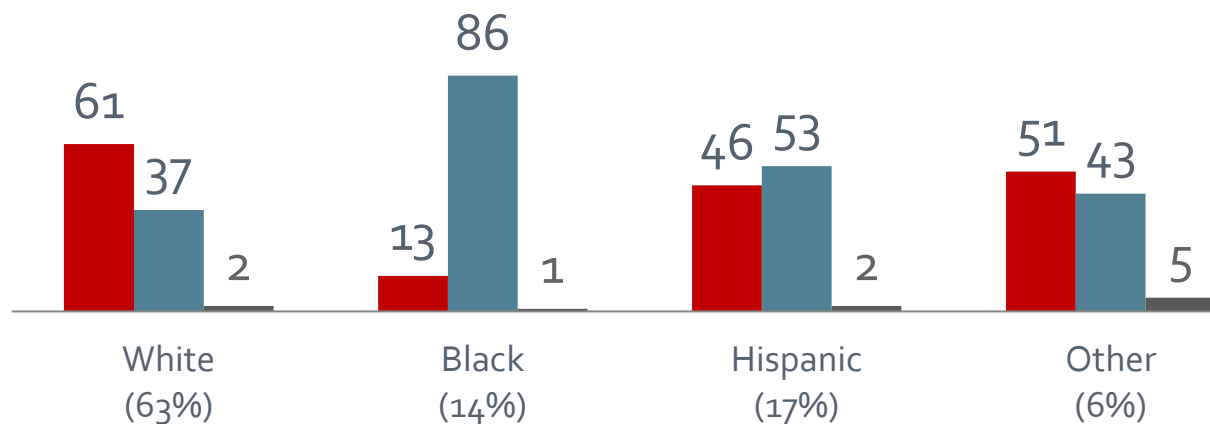
In your local election for Congress, did you vote for the Republican or the Democrat?



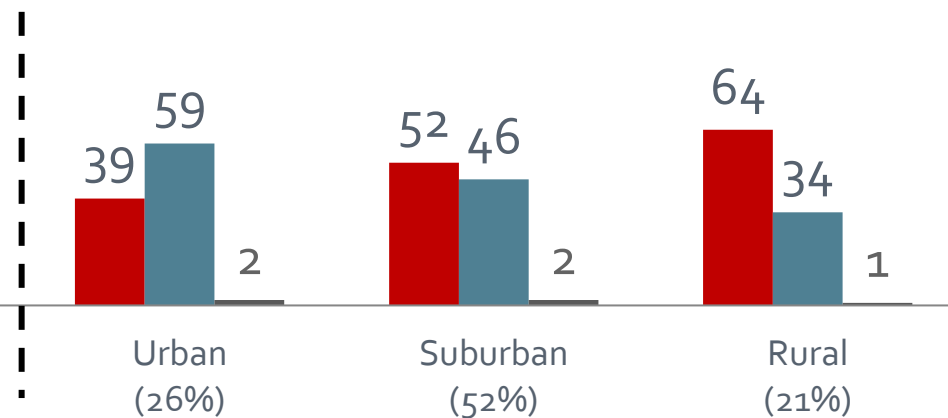

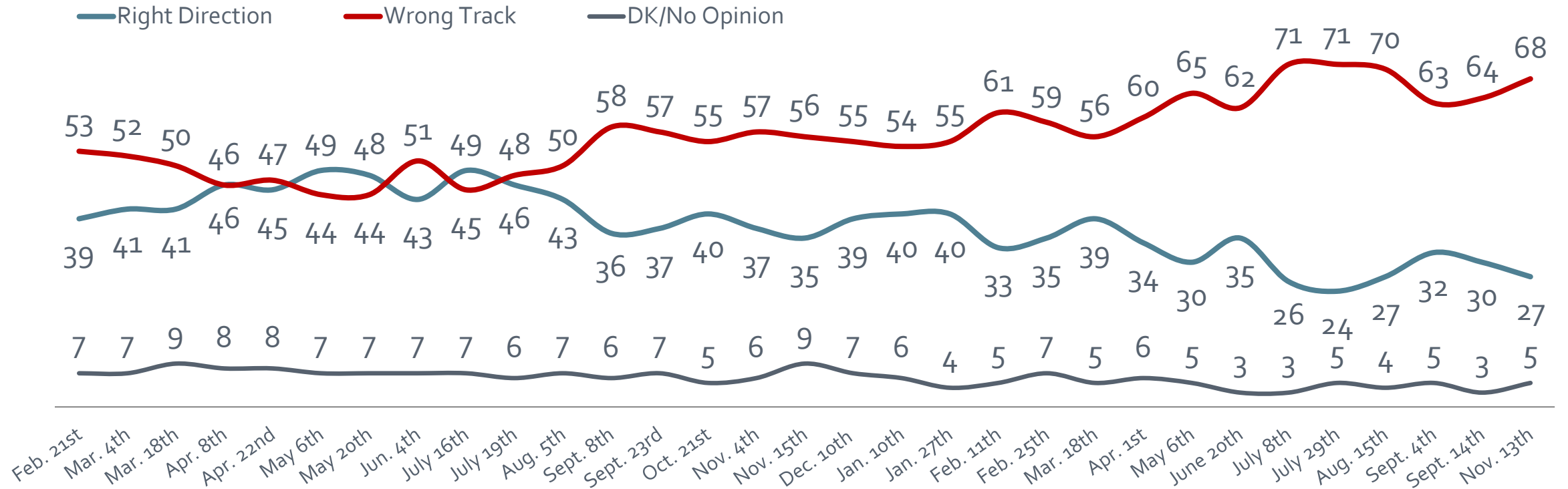

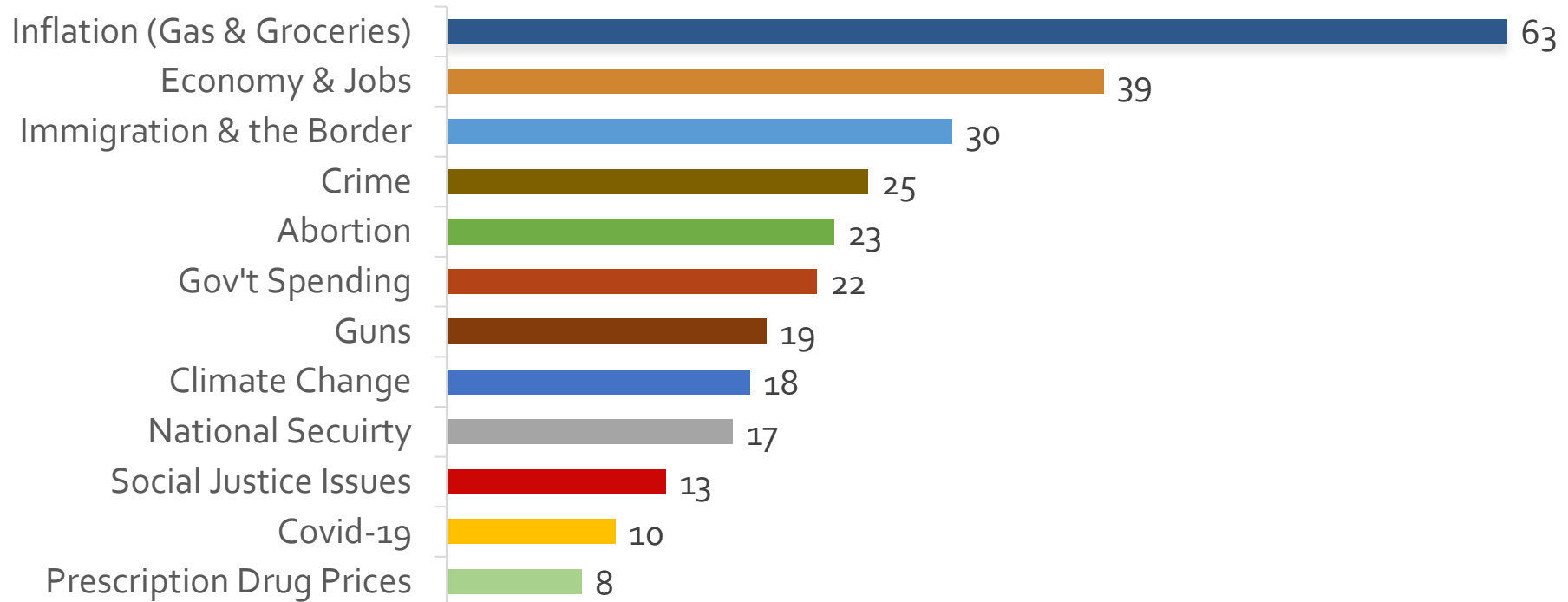

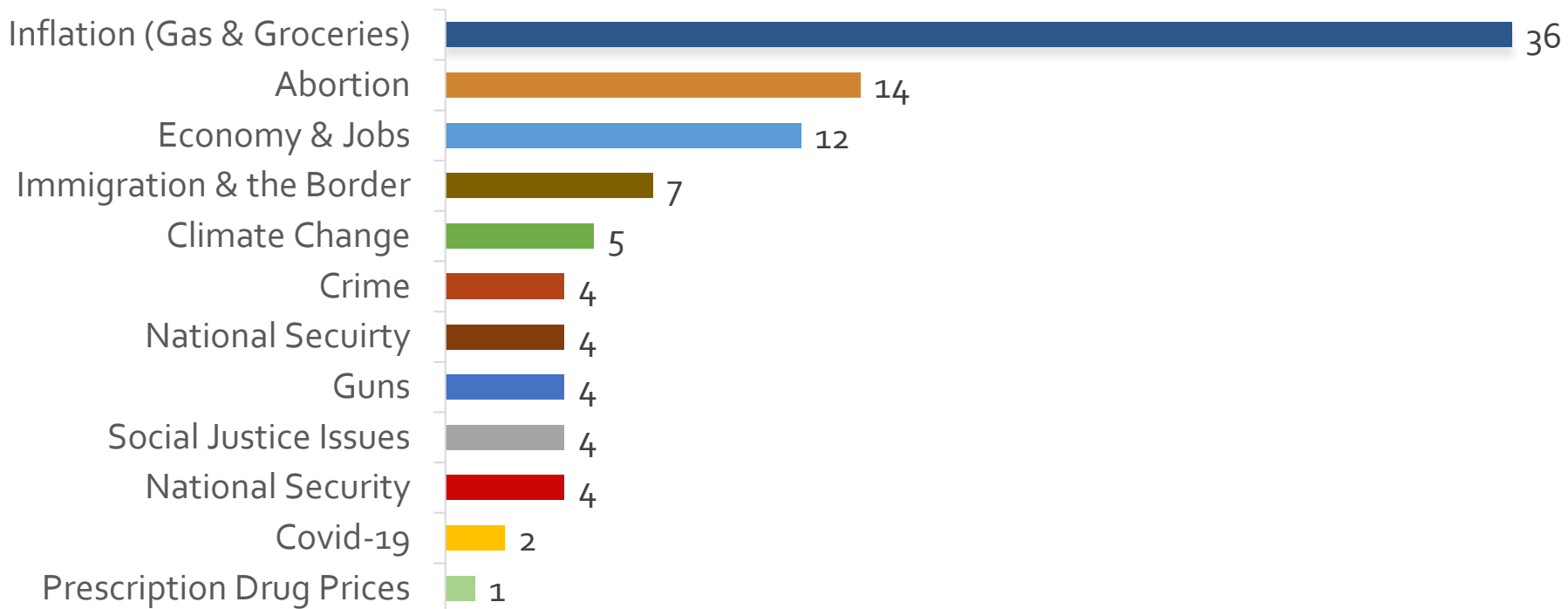

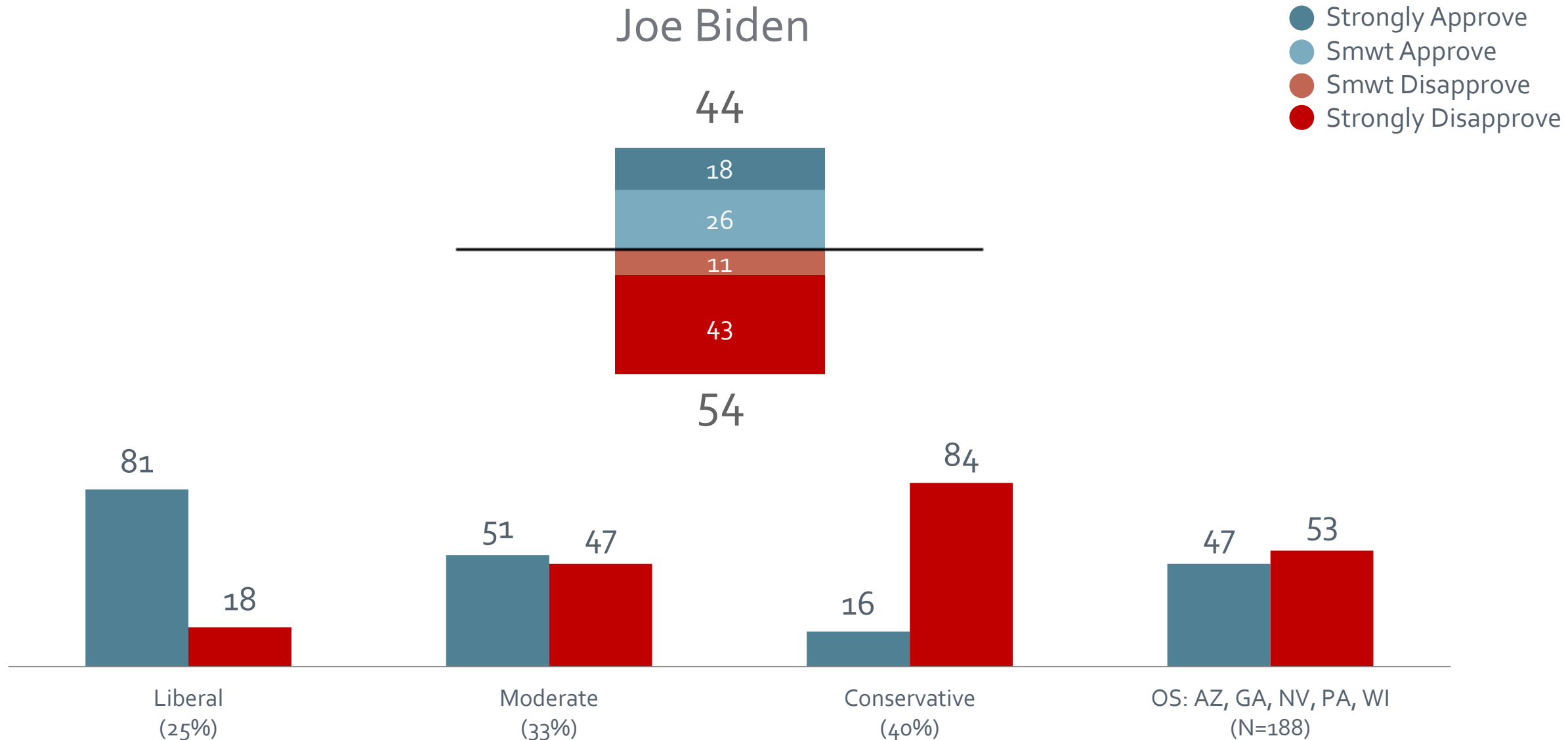

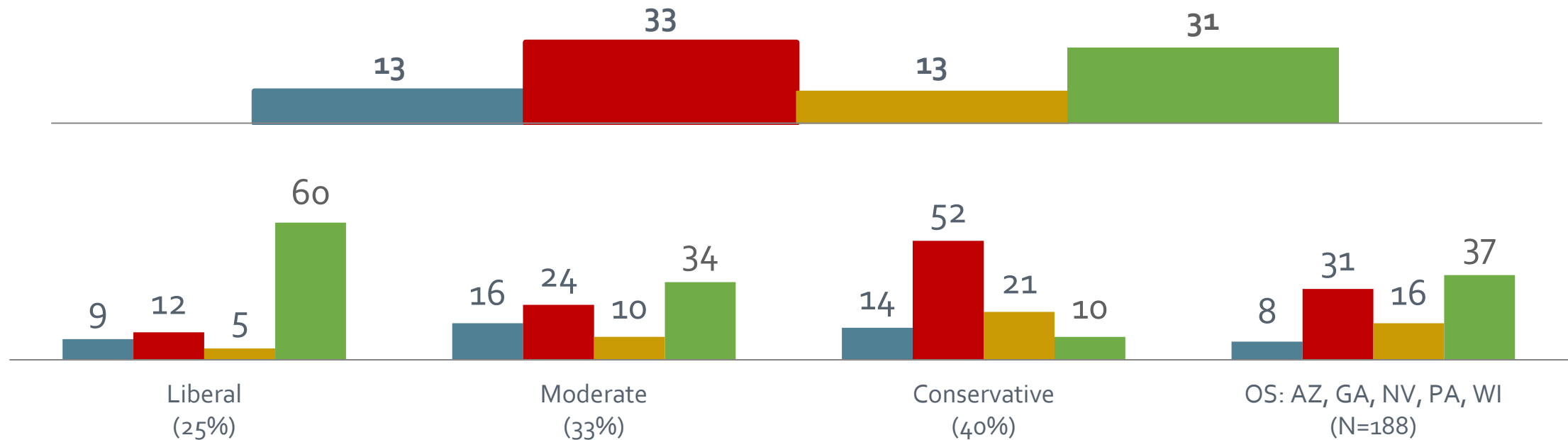
Overall, do you approve or disapprove of the job Joe Biden has done as President?



GREATEST BIDEN CONCERN

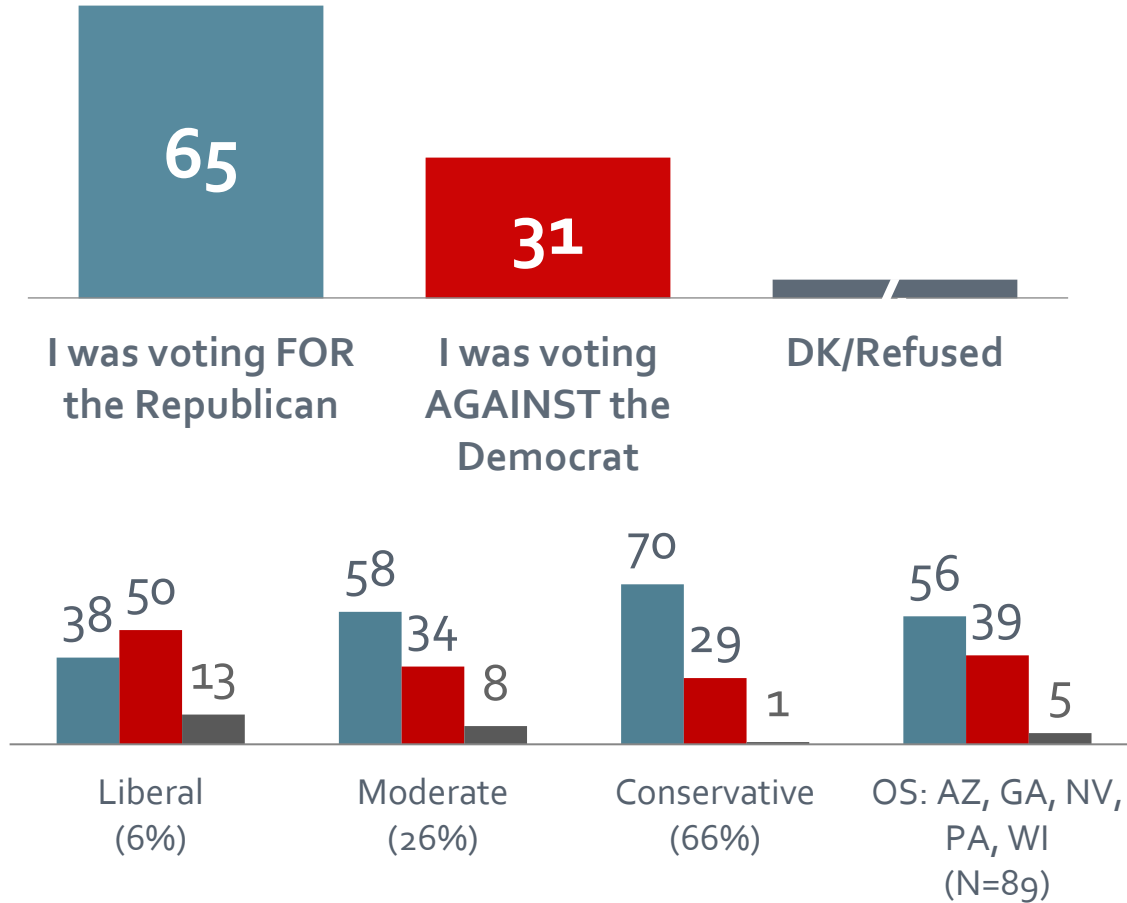
Thinking more about President Joe Biden, and regardless of whether or not you support him, what is your greatest concern regarding his Presidency?

- Biden will be blocked from doing what's necessary by a Republican House and Senate



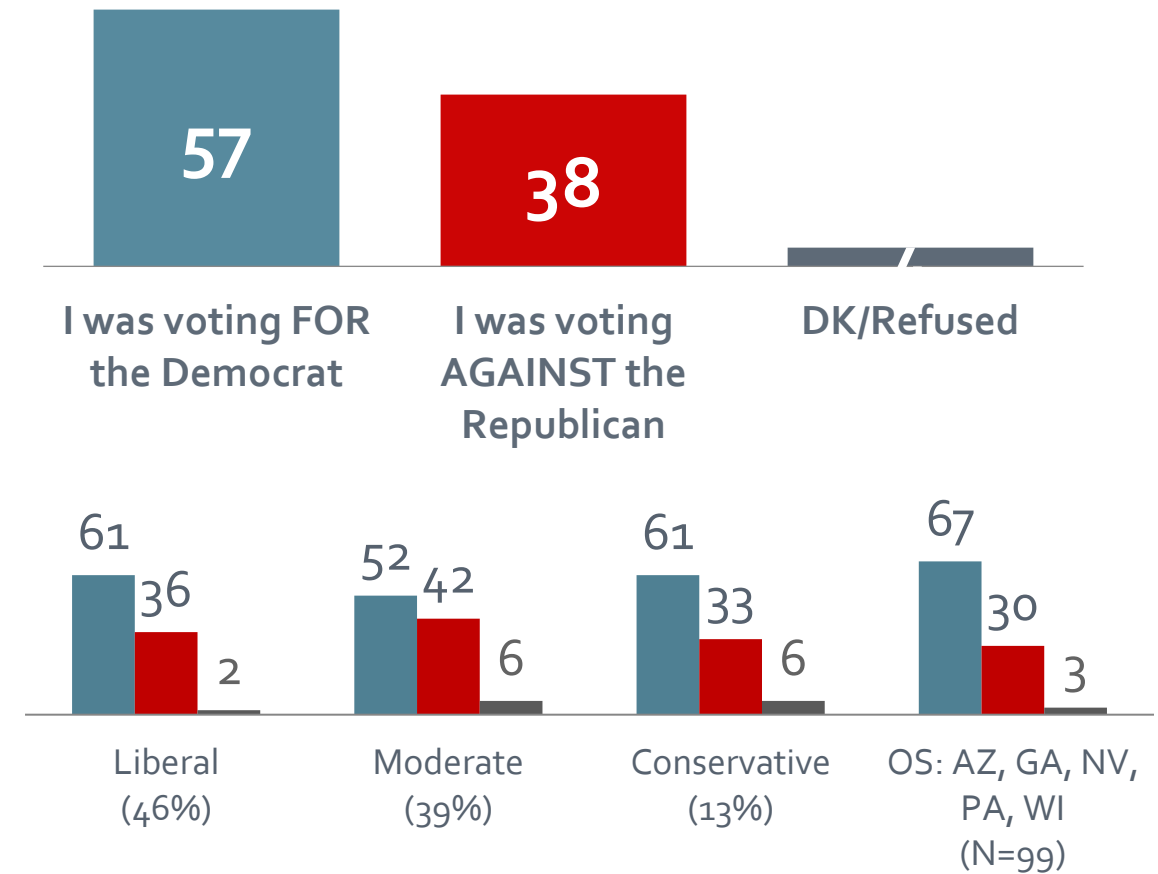
REASON FOR VOTE - REPUBLICANS

Thinking again about your vote for the Republican candidate, which of the following statements comes closest to your opinion?



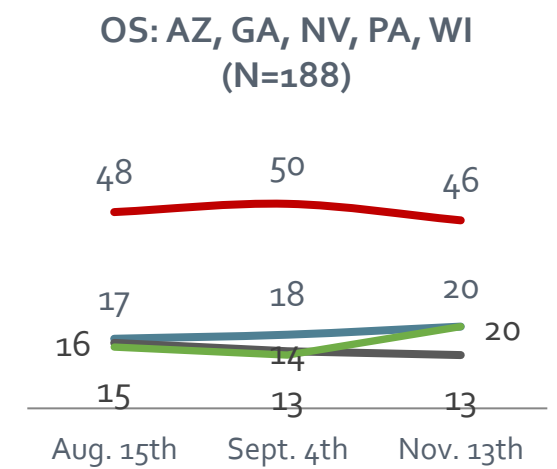
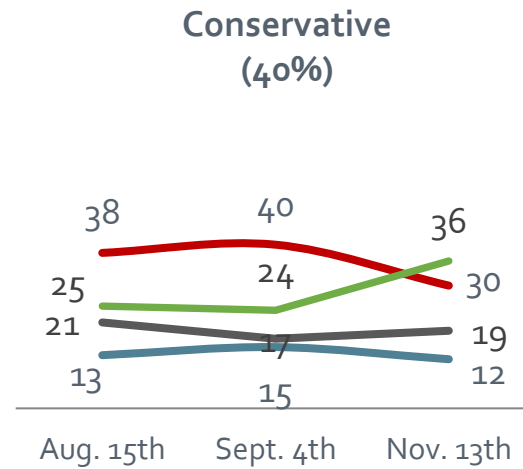
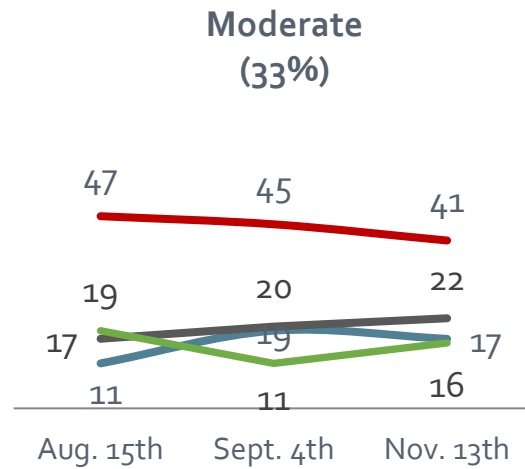
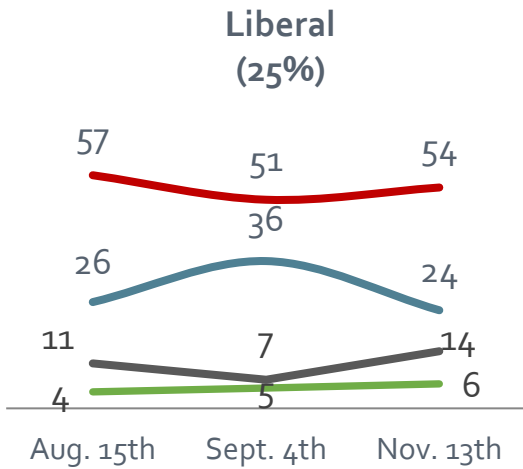
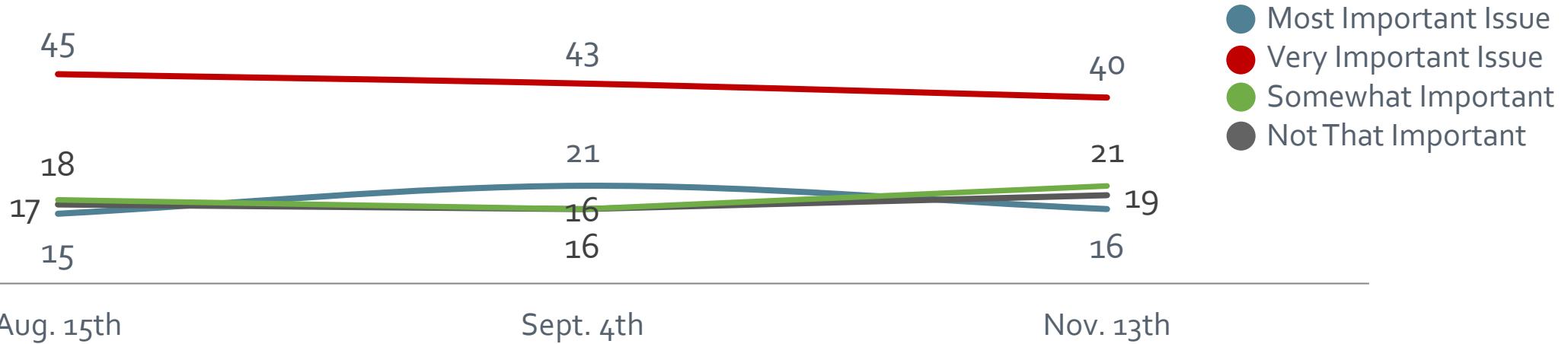

Thinking again about your vote for the Democrat candidate, which of the following statements comes closest to your opinion?



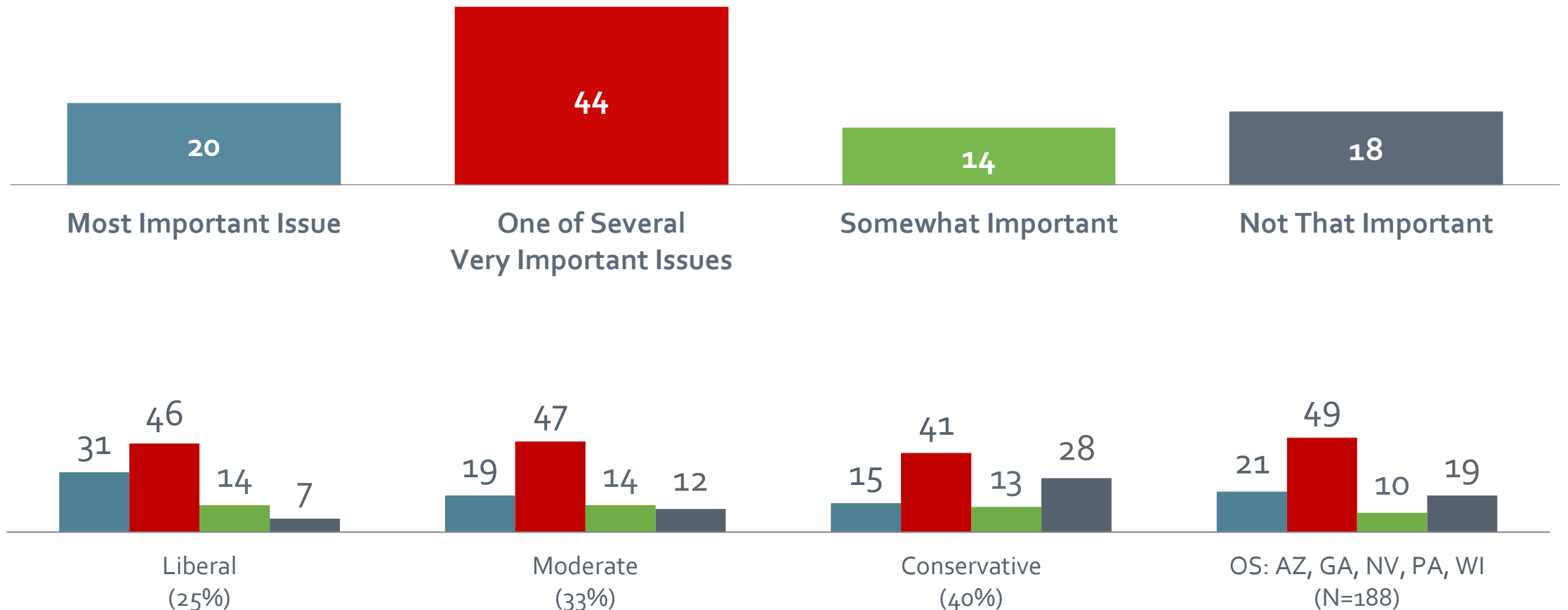
ABORTION IMPORTANCE

How important would you say the issue of **ABORTION** was in deciding your vote? Would you say it was...



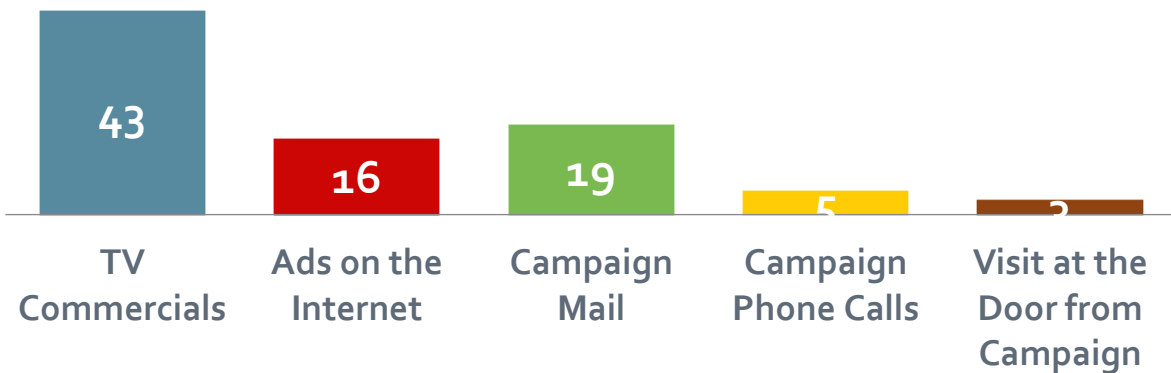
THREATS TO DEMOCRACY IMPORTANCE

How important would you say the issue of THREATS TO DEMOCRACY was in deciding your vote? Would you say it was...

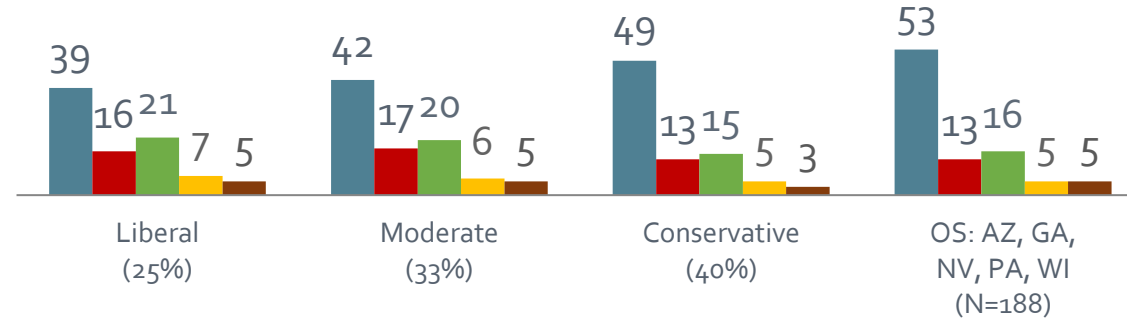
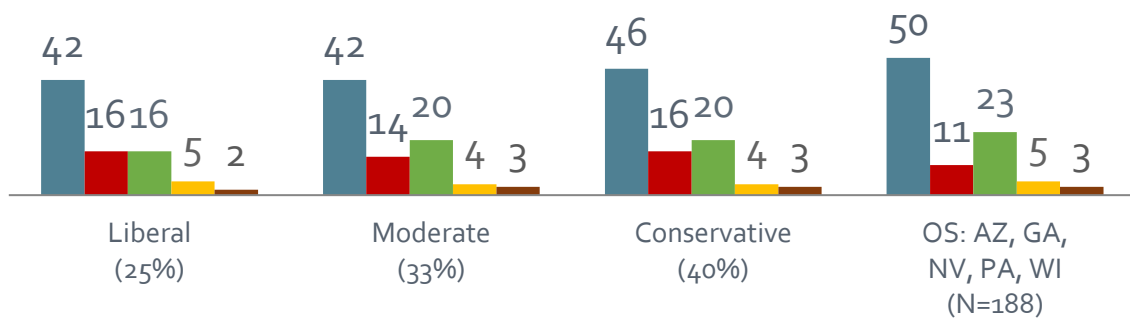
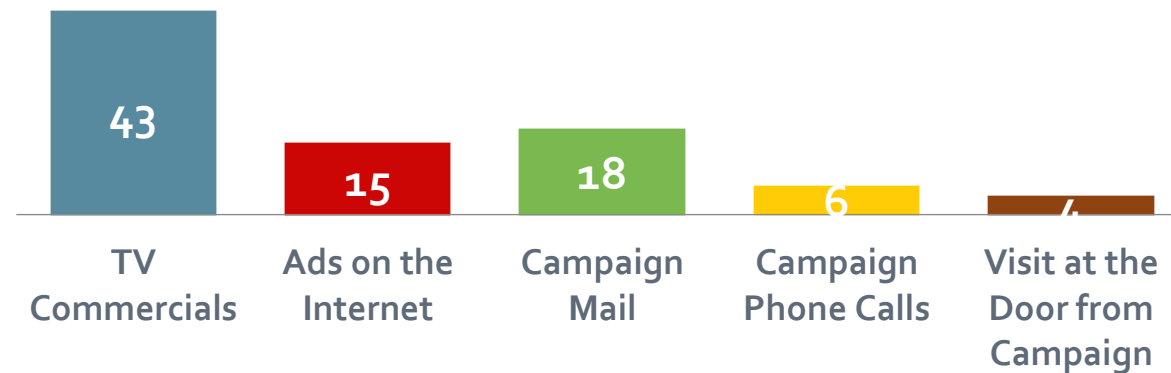

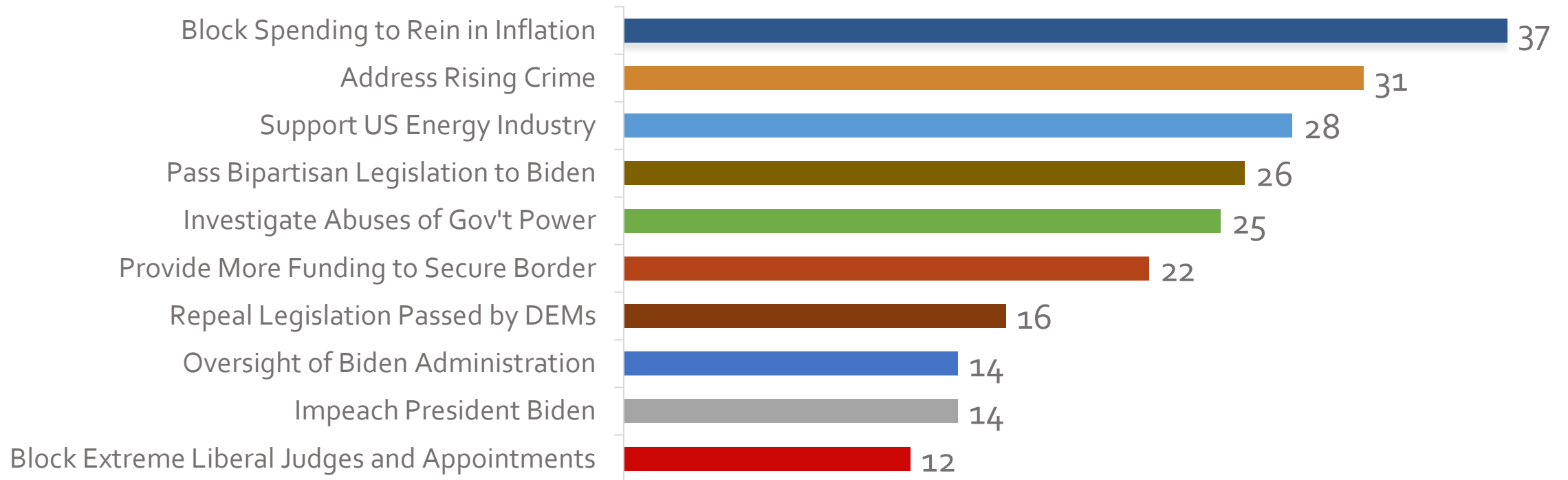

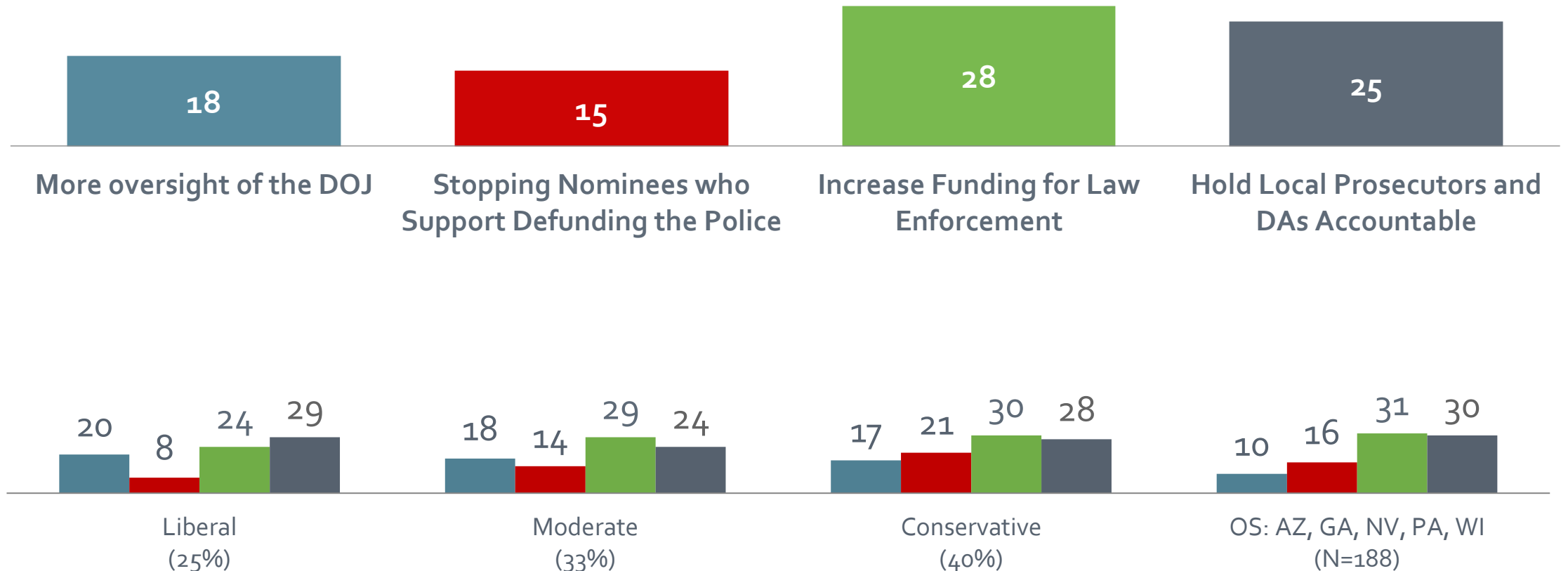
HANDLING INFLATION

On the issue of INFLATION, what do you think is most important for Congress to do?



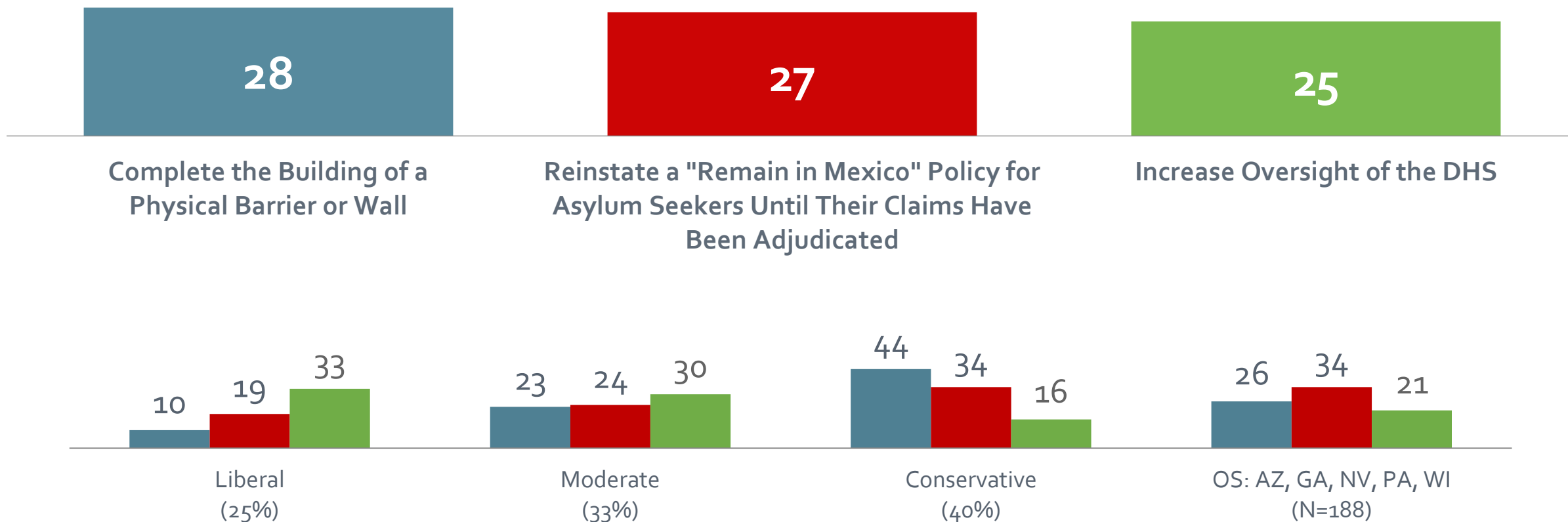
HANDLING CRIME

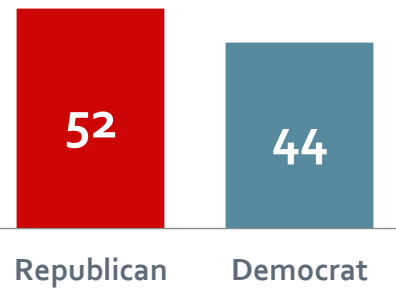

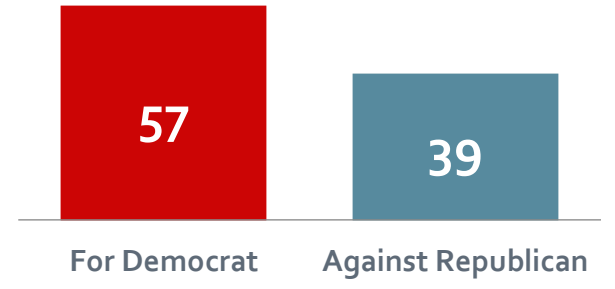
