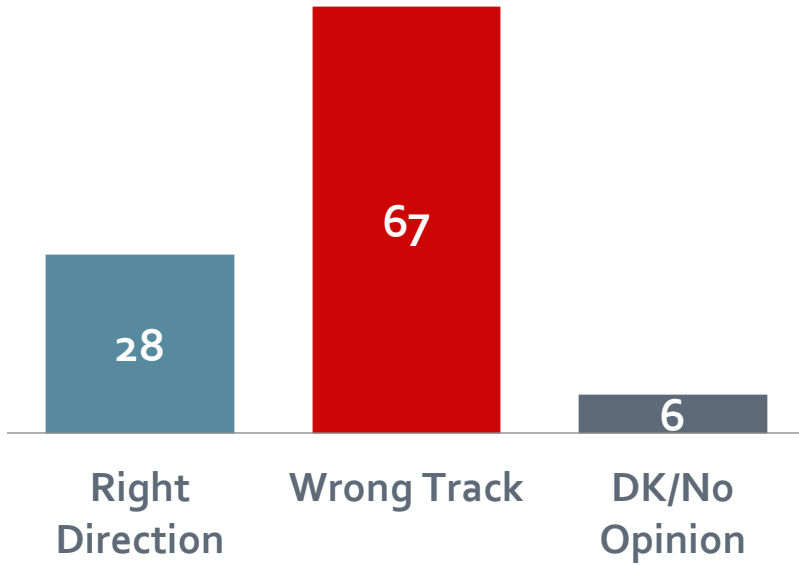

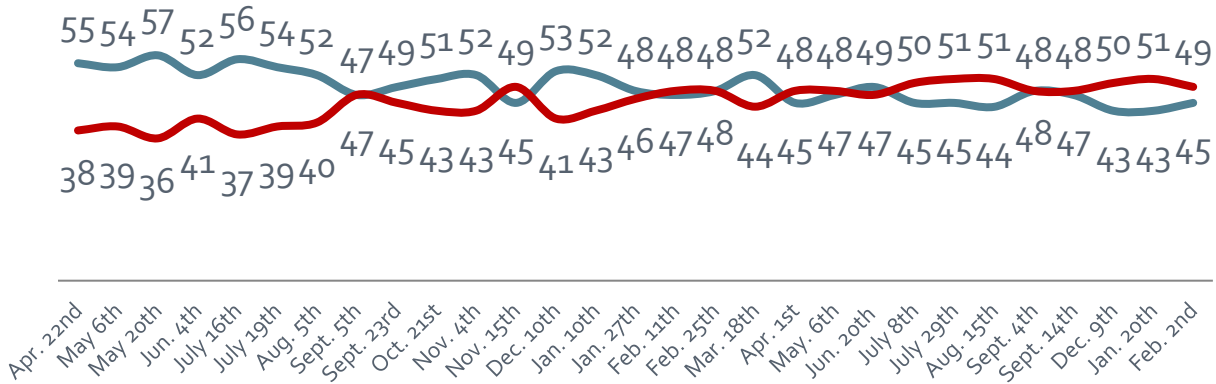

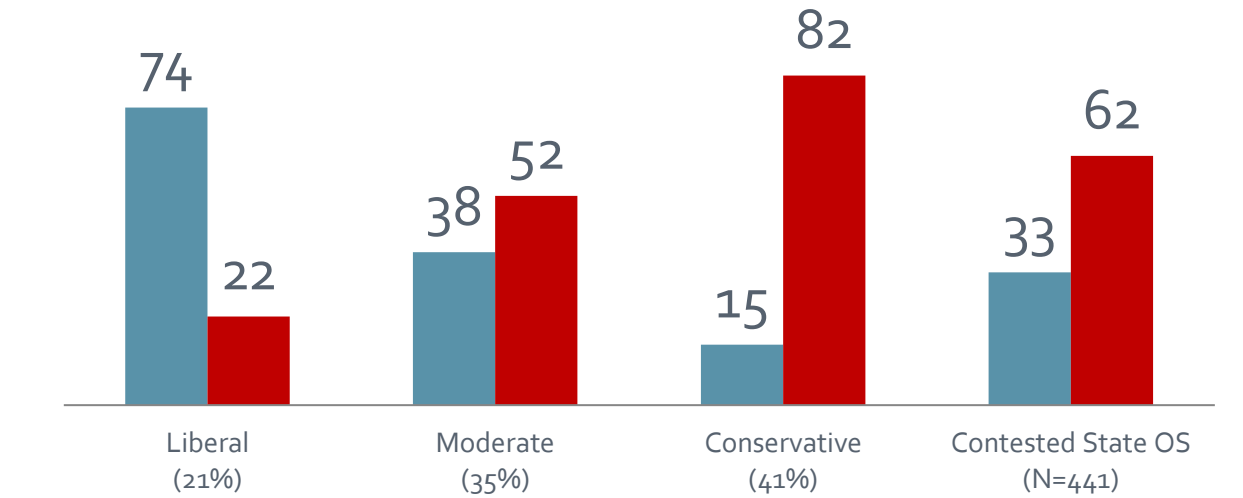

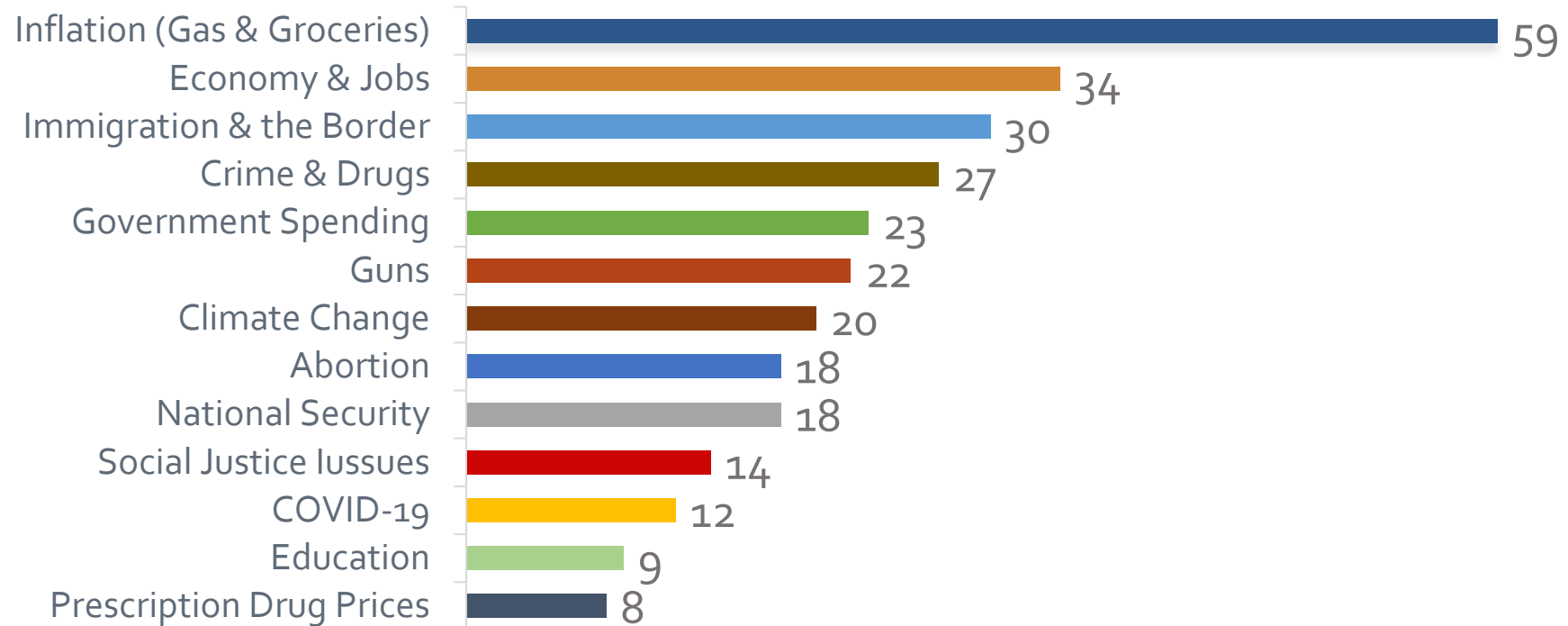

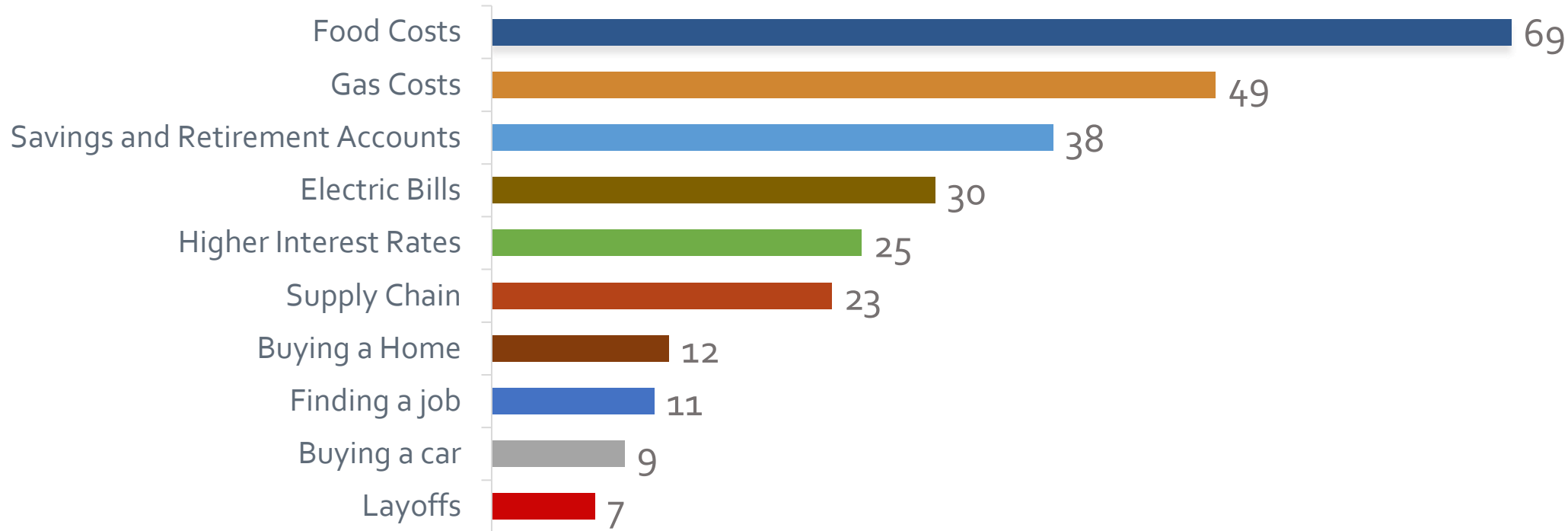

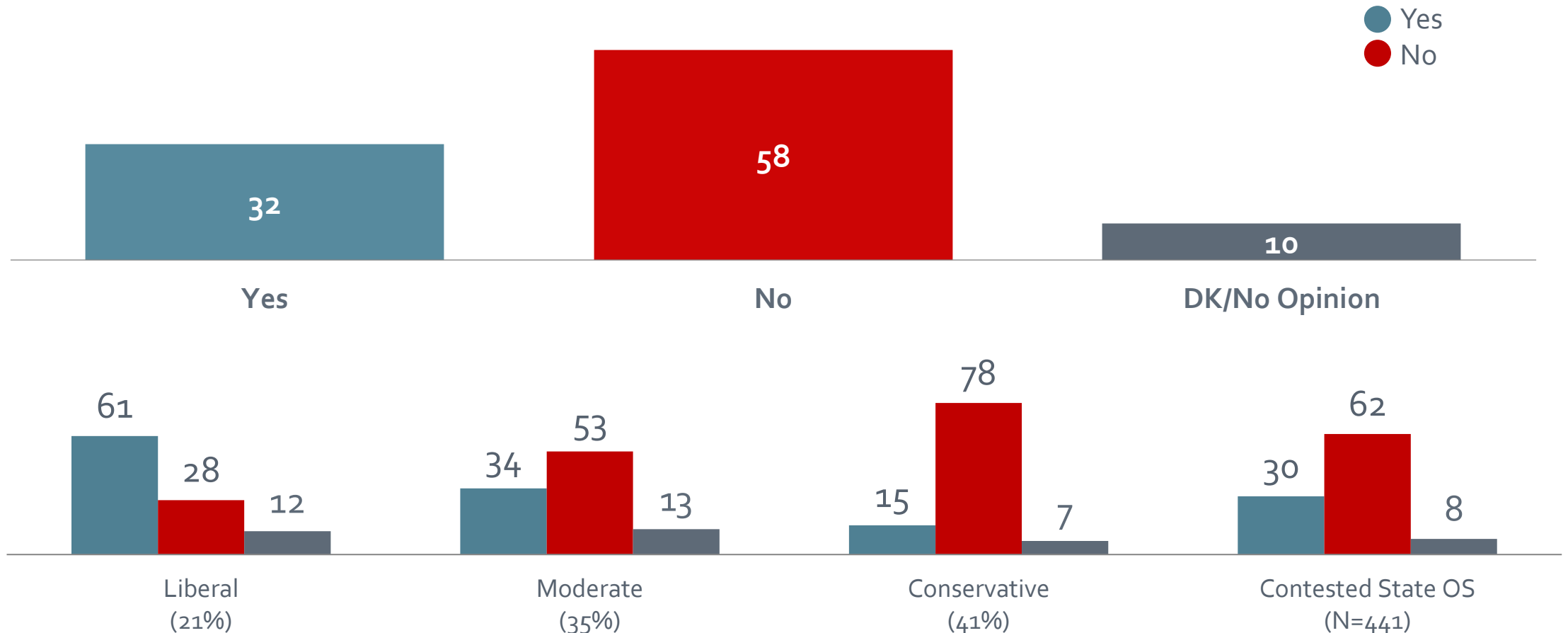

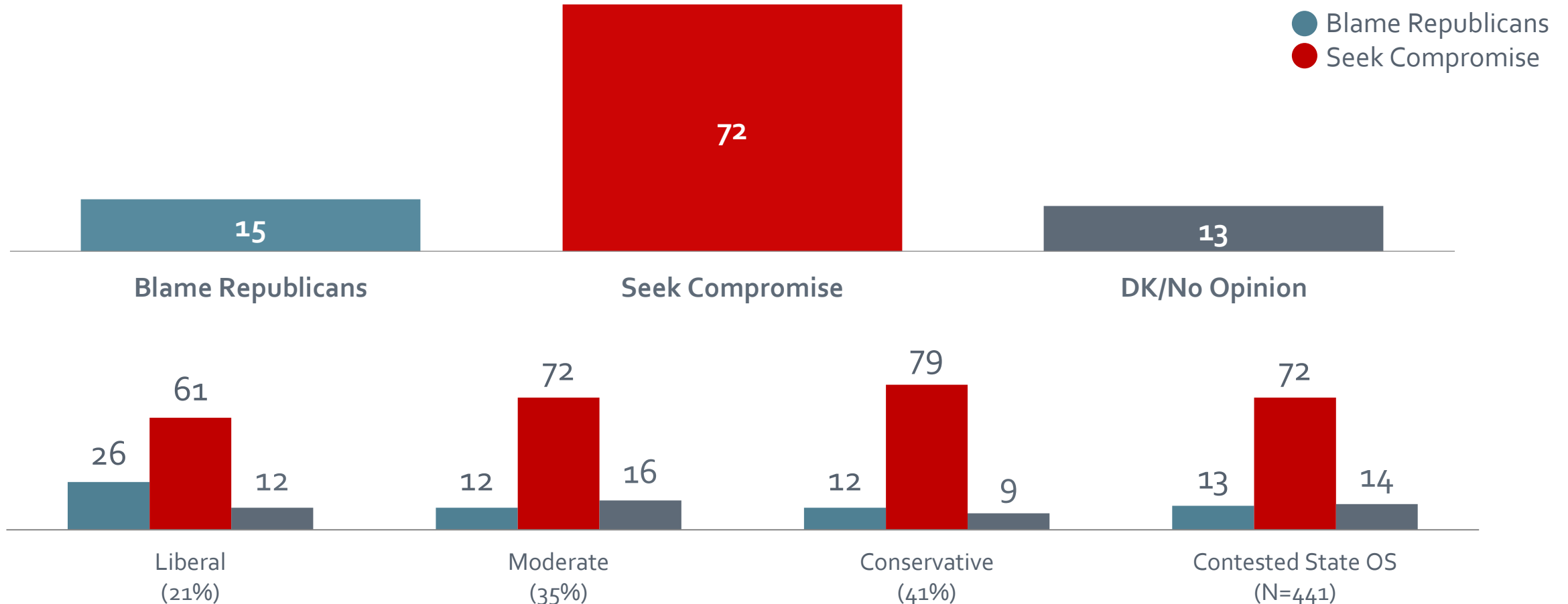
SOTU – ECONOMY

Do you believe President Biden has a strong economic record to tout in his State of the Union address?



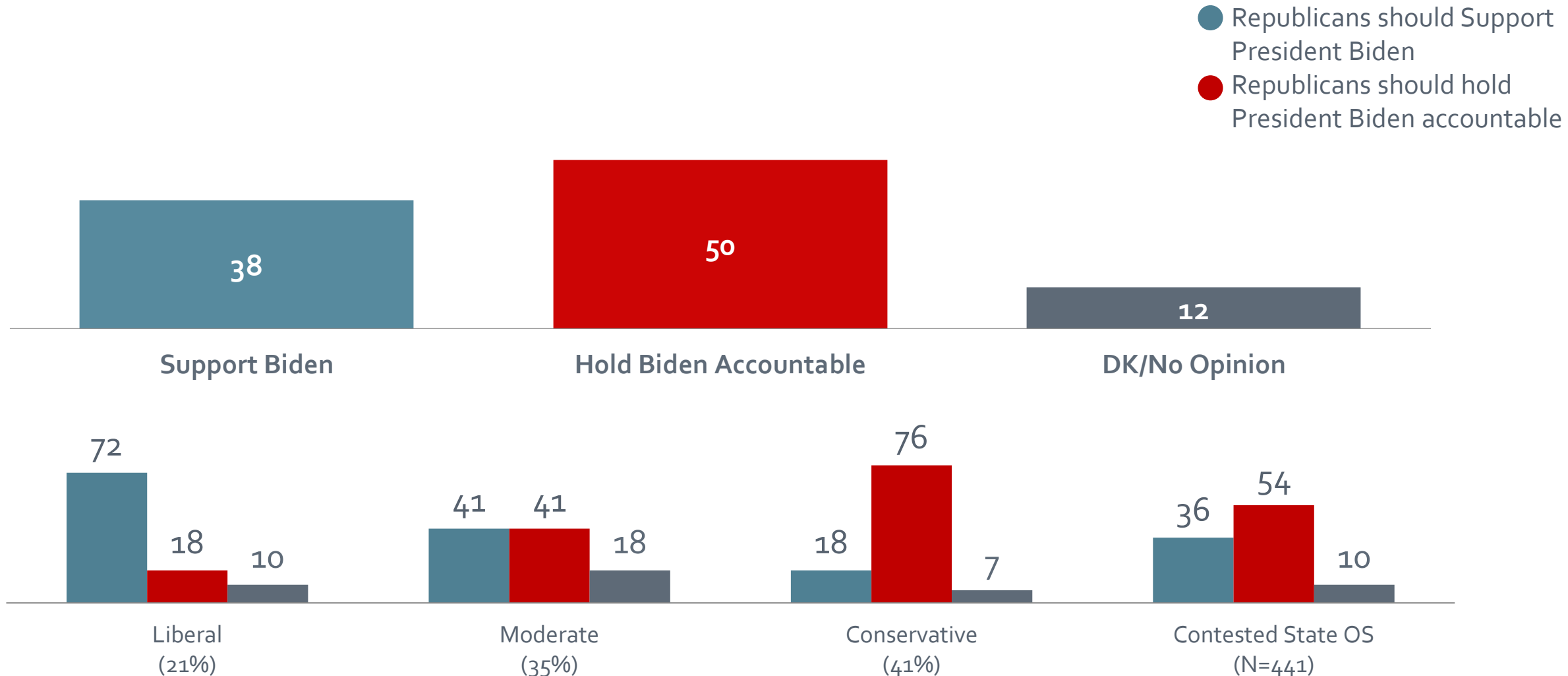
SOTU – BLAME REPUBLICANS

Do you believe Republicans should support President Biden the next two years, or hold him accountable?

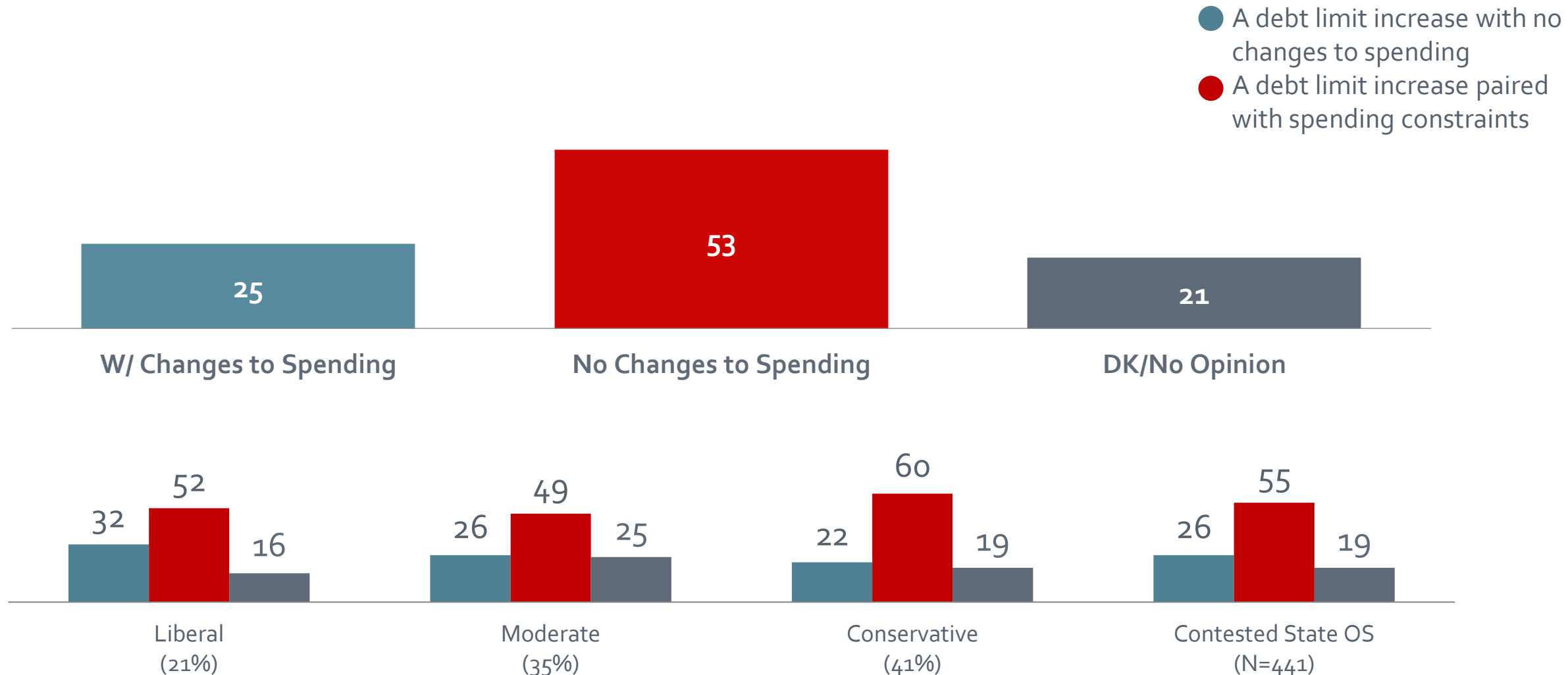

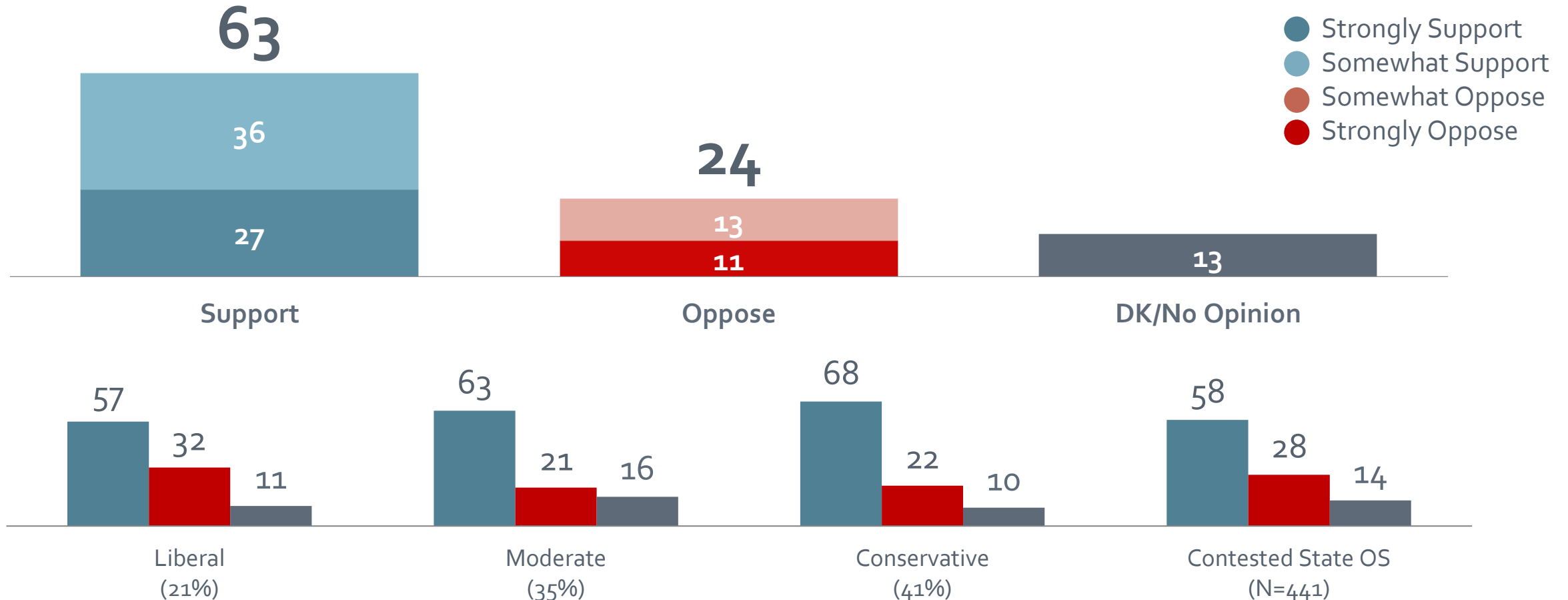


DIVIDED GOVERNMENT

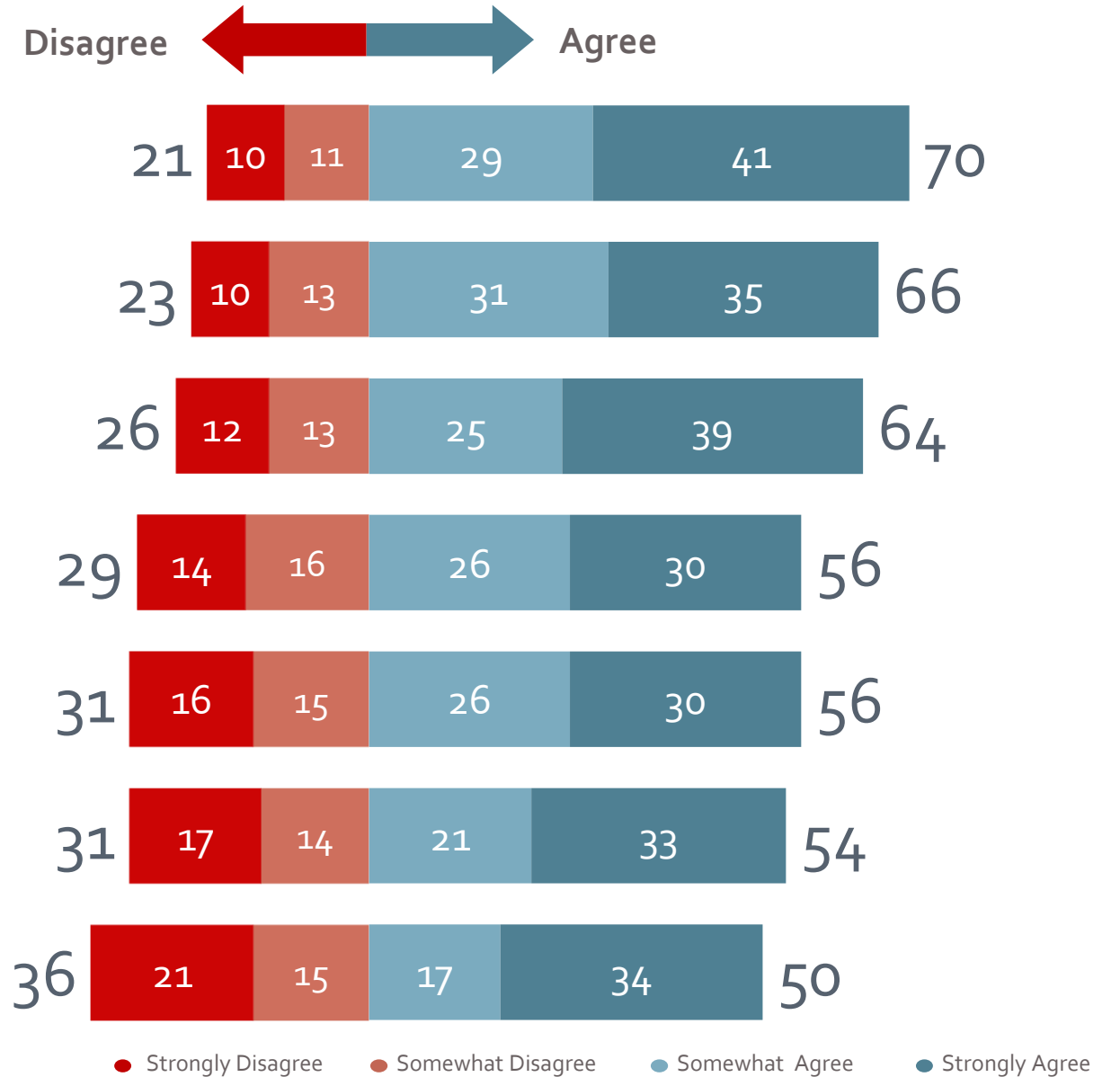
