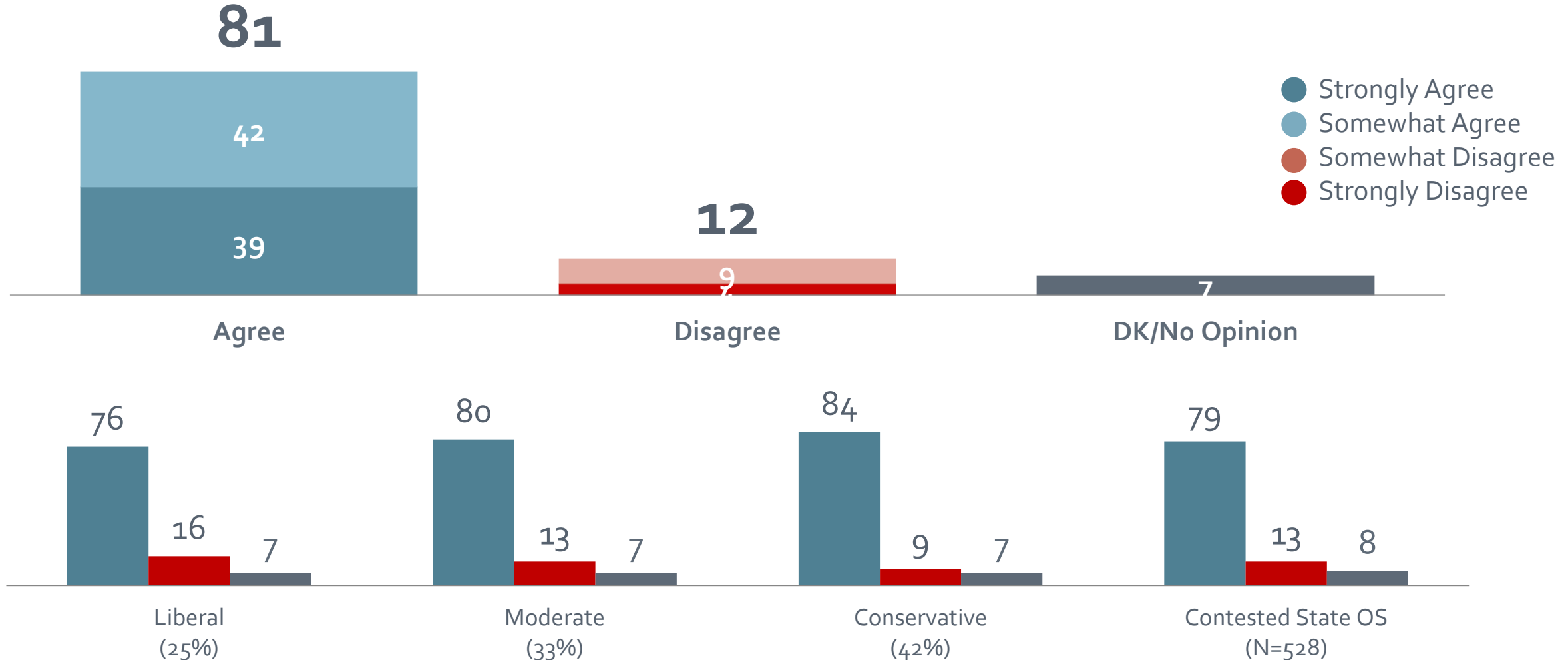

Thinking about the debt ceiling and spending, do you agree or disagree with the following statement?

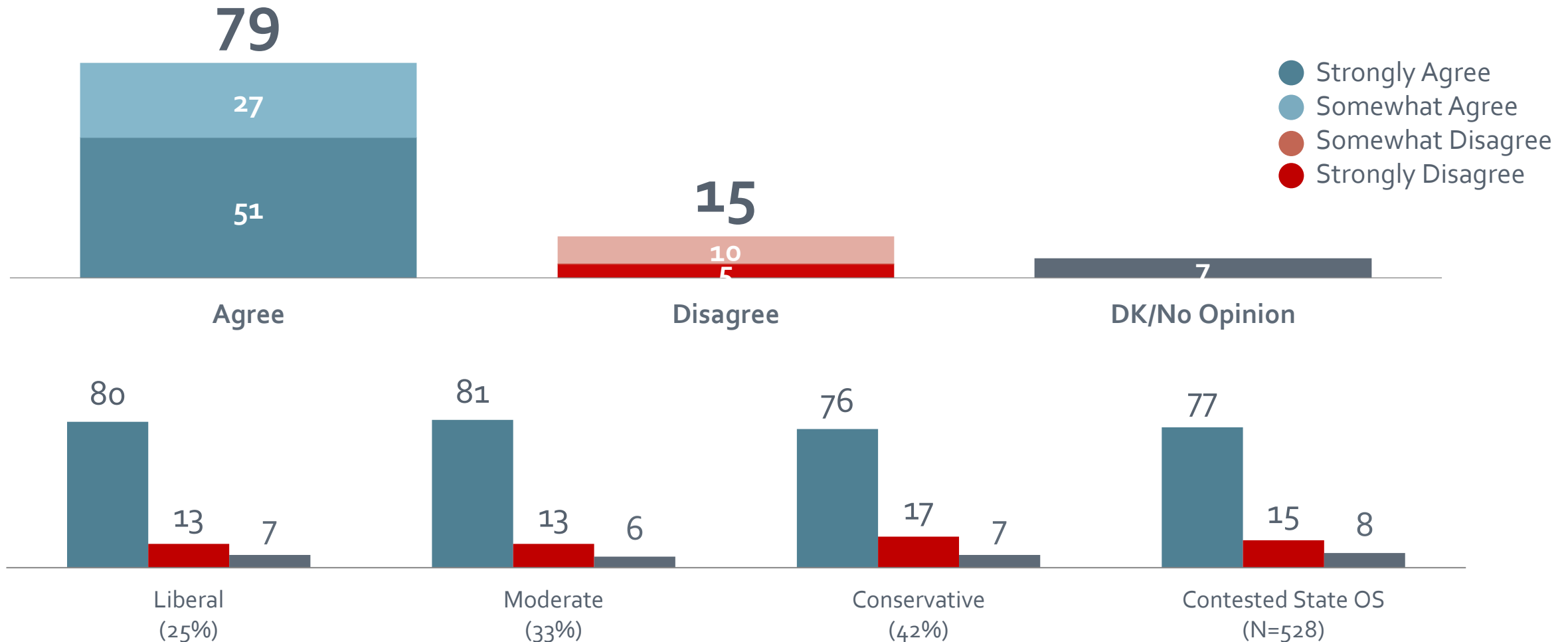
We can balance our budget and not touch Social Security or Medicare, but that means other federal programs need major cuts and reforms.

Social Security and Medicare should be completely off the table when it comes to debt ceiling negotiations.



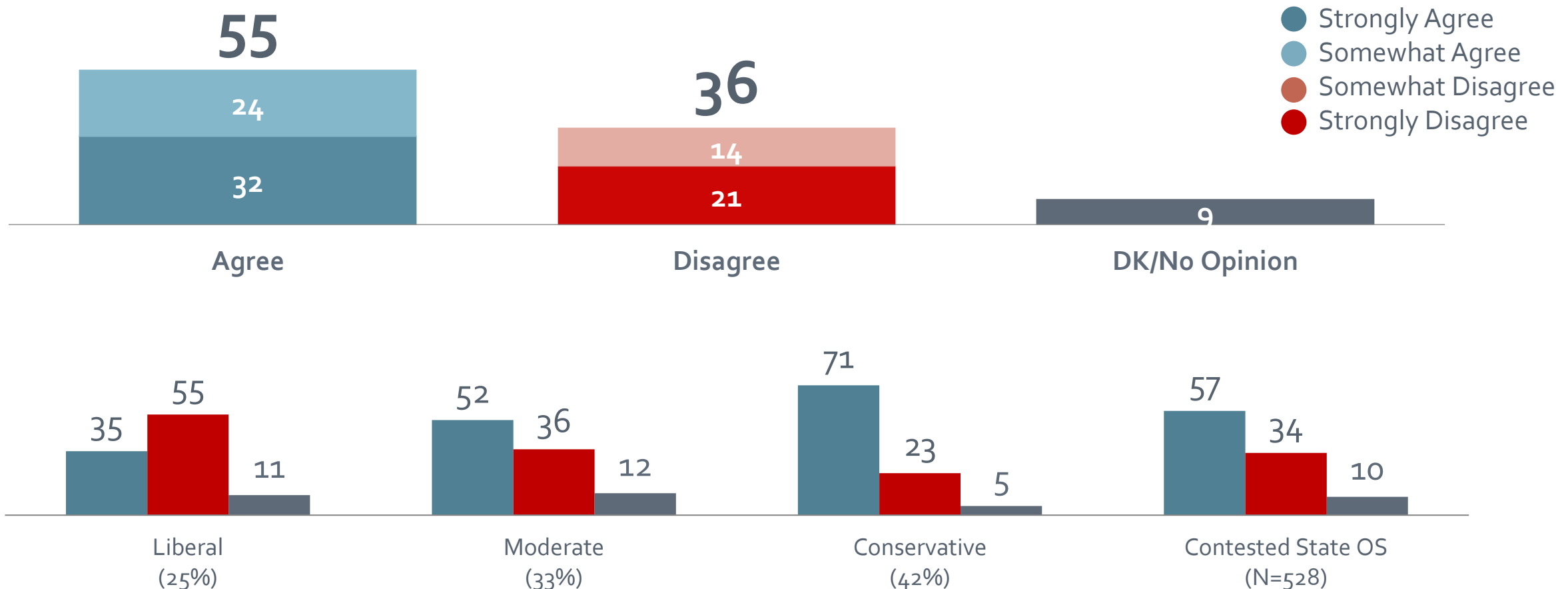

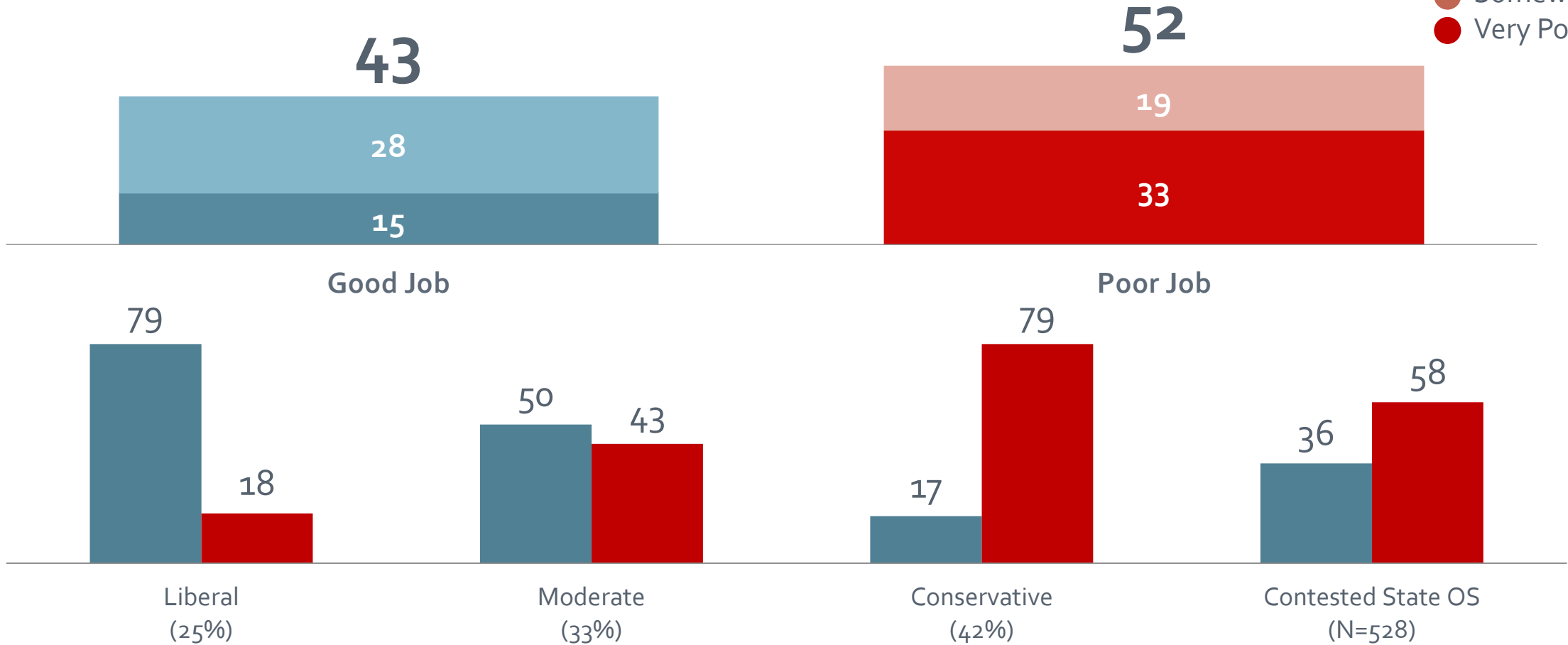

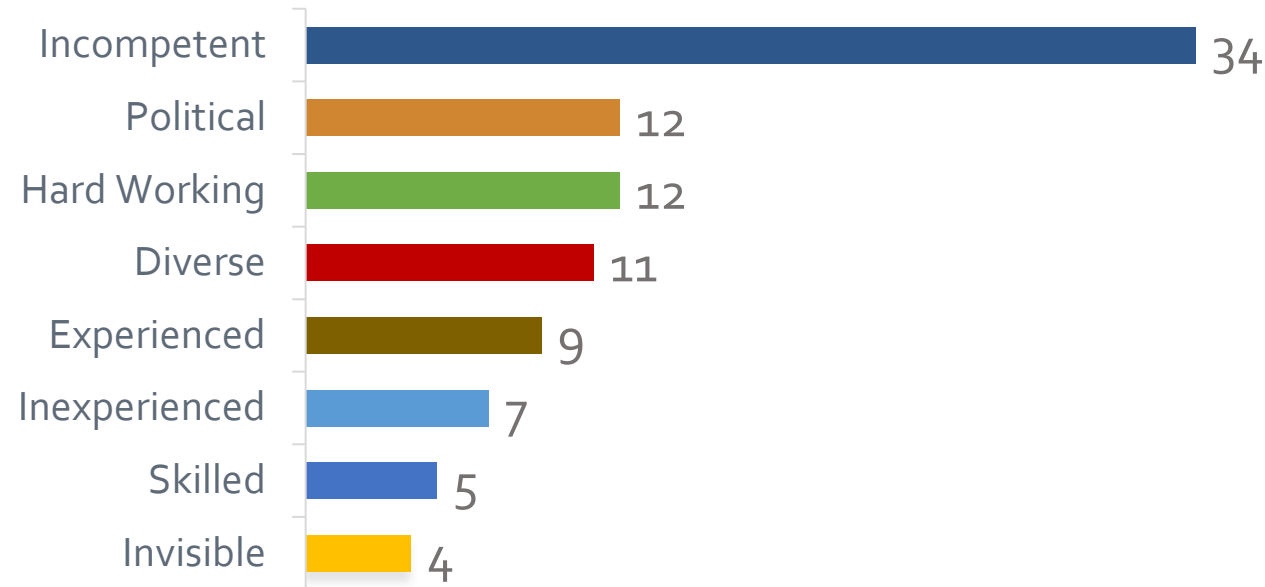
JOB OF BIDEN'S CABINET AND AGENCIES

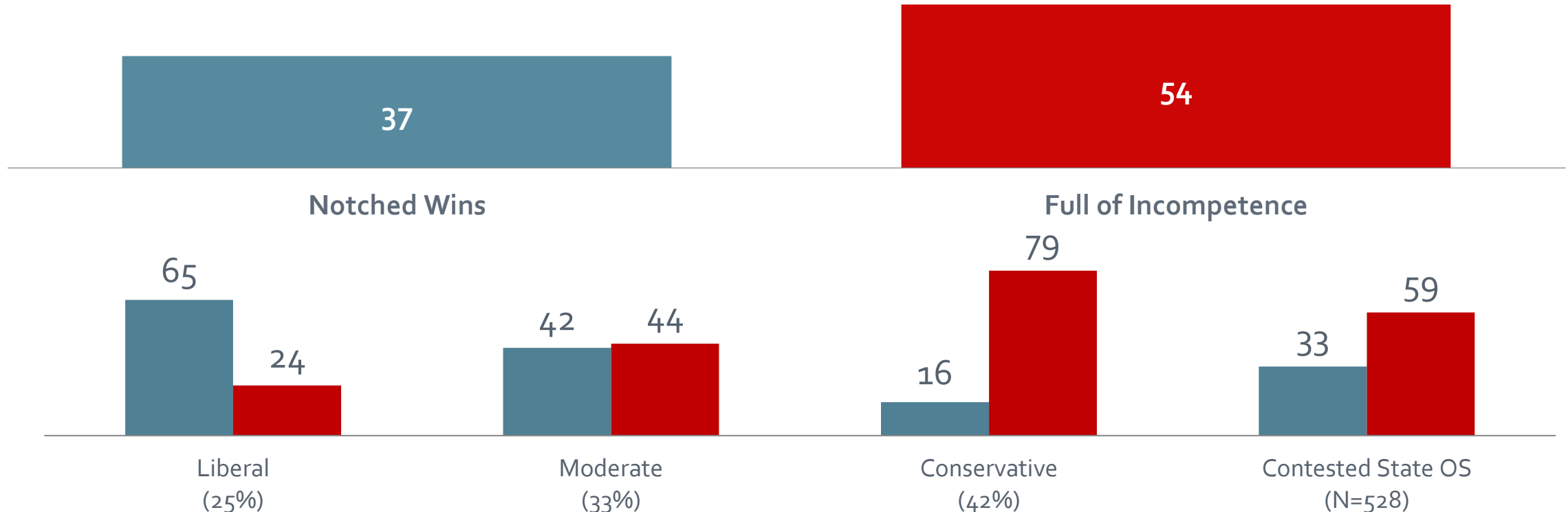

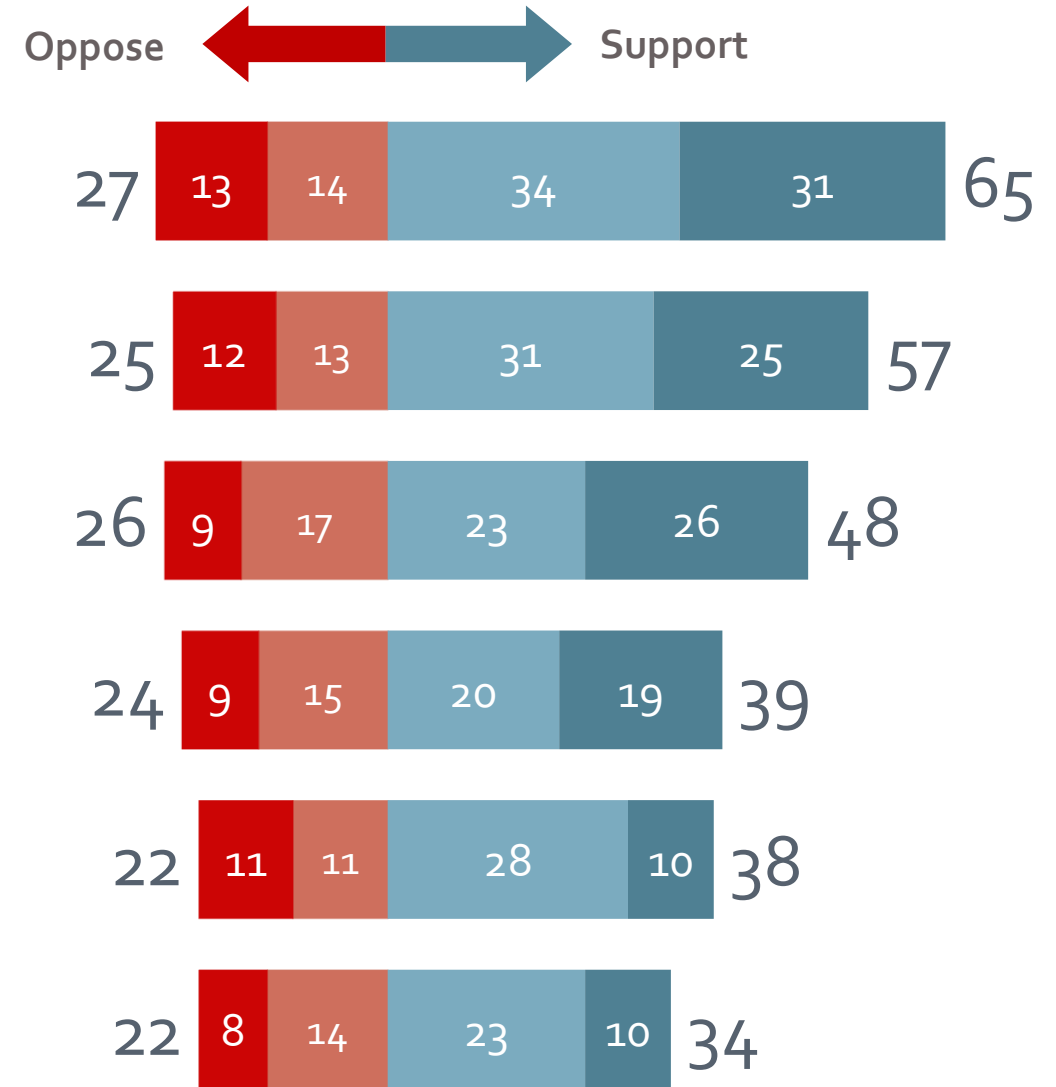
