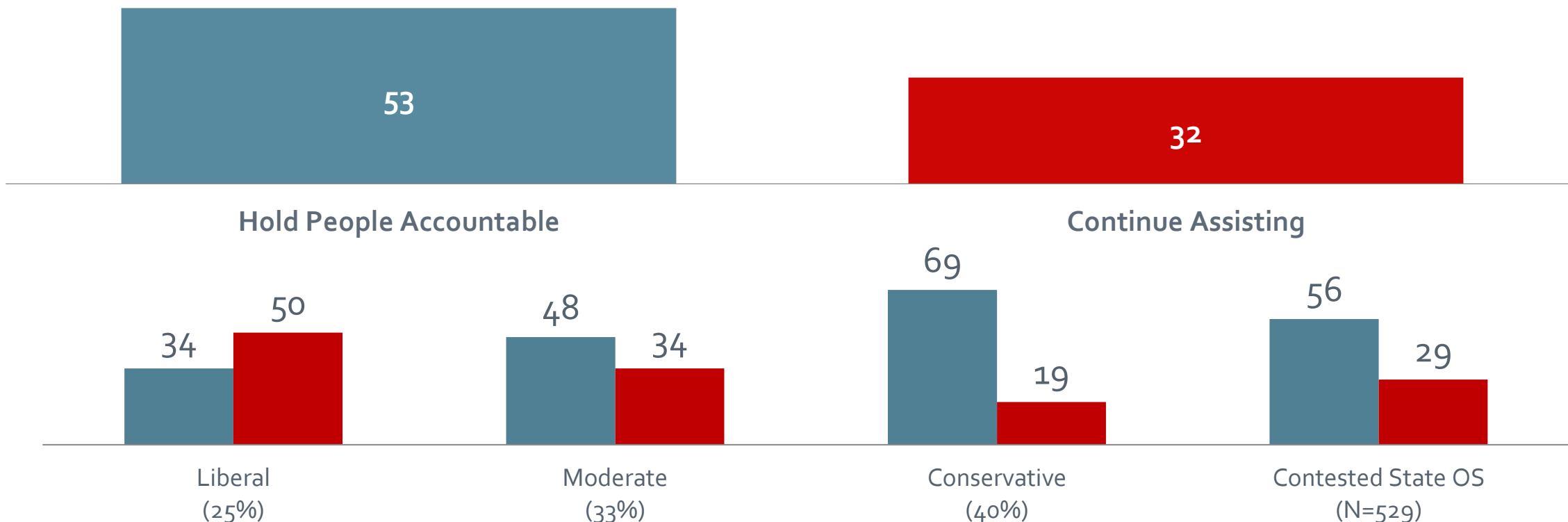


# BANK FAILURE

Thinking about the reaction from Congress on the bank failures, which of the following statements do you agree with most, even if neither is exactly correct?

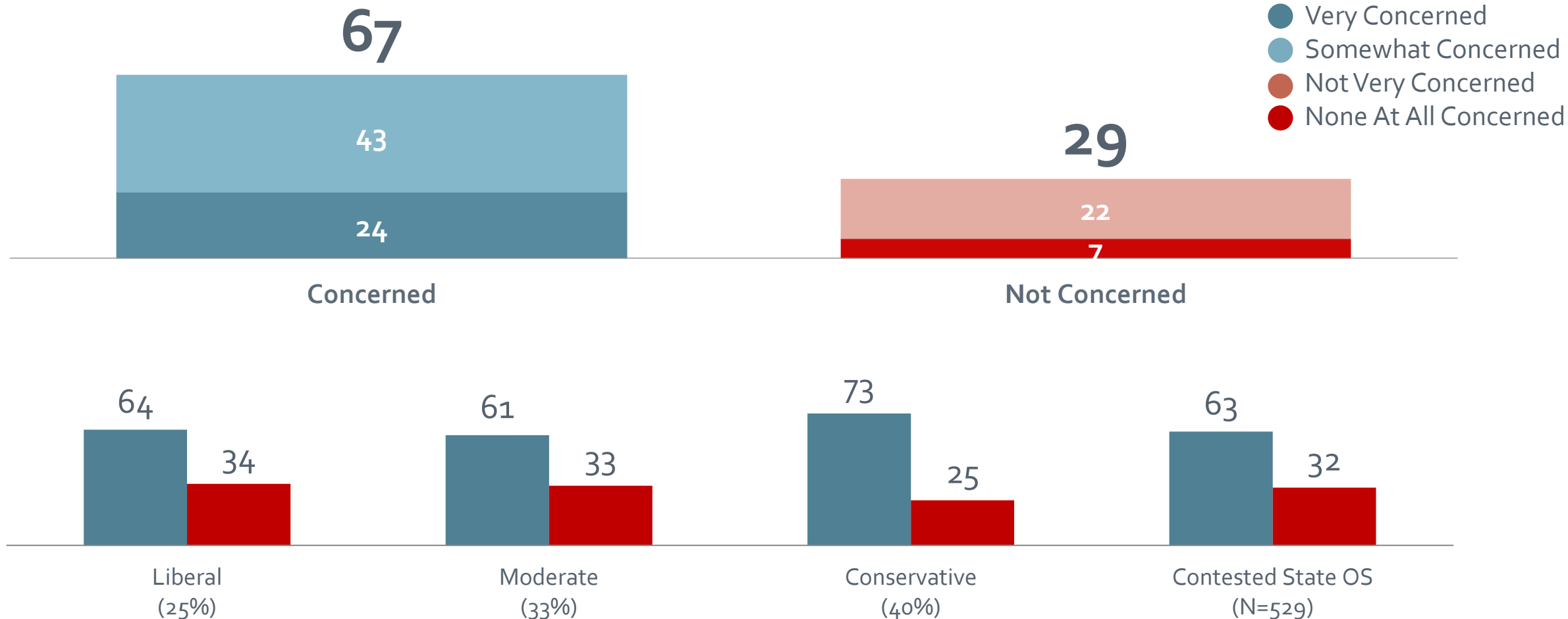
Some say that Congress needs to support the American taxpayer, hold California regulators accountable for the Silicon Valley Bank failure, and get answers from the Biden administration on what happened.

# PERSONAL FINANCE CONCERN

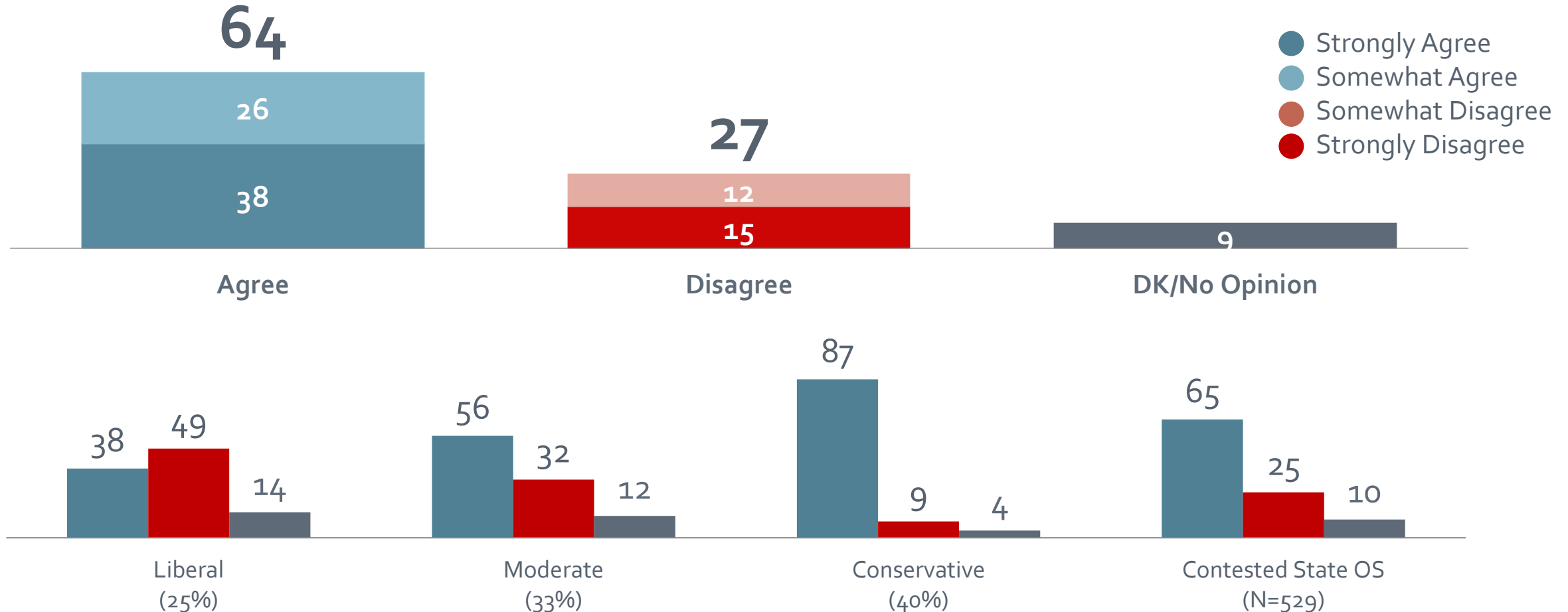
How concerned are you that recent bank failures will impact your personal finances in the coming months?

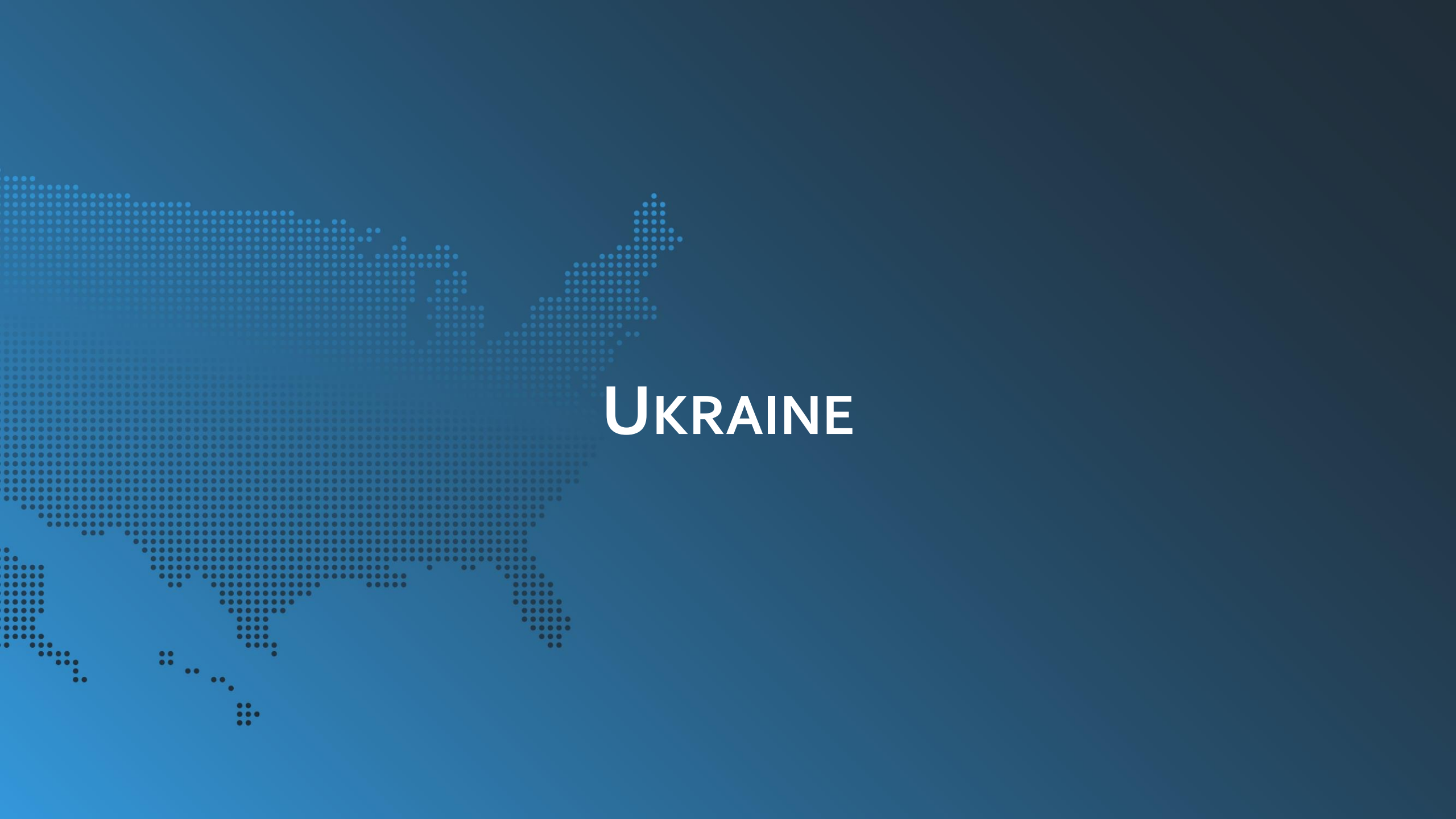


# HOLD BIDEN AND DEMOCRATS ACCOUNTABLE

President Biden and Congressional Democrats should be held accountable for their reckless spending and inflation which drove up interest rates and contributed to the recent bank failures.

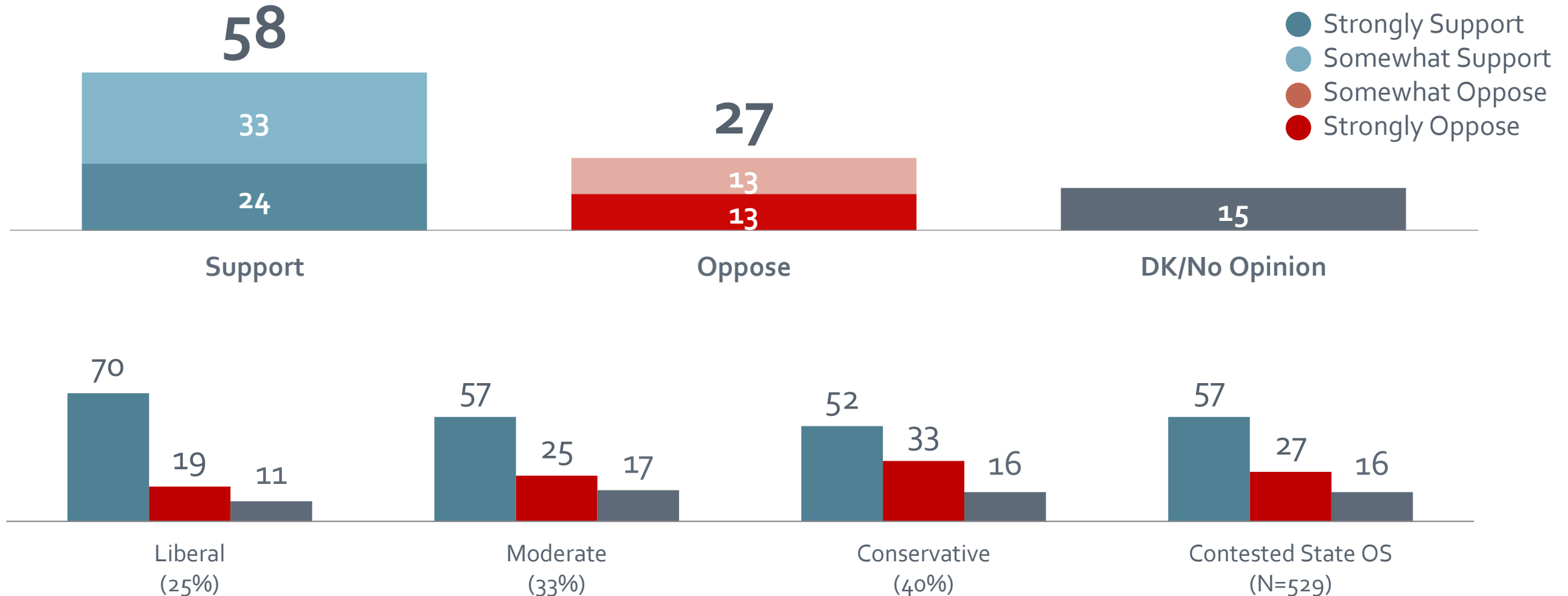

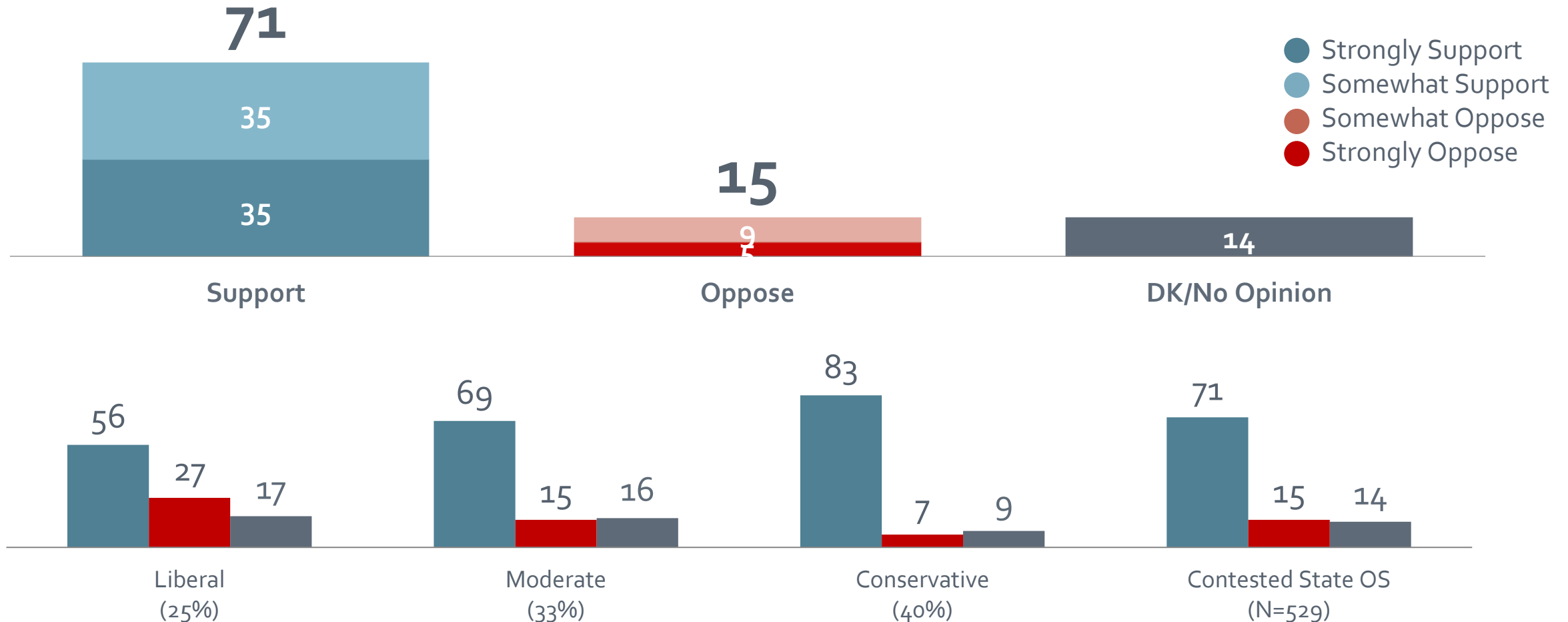

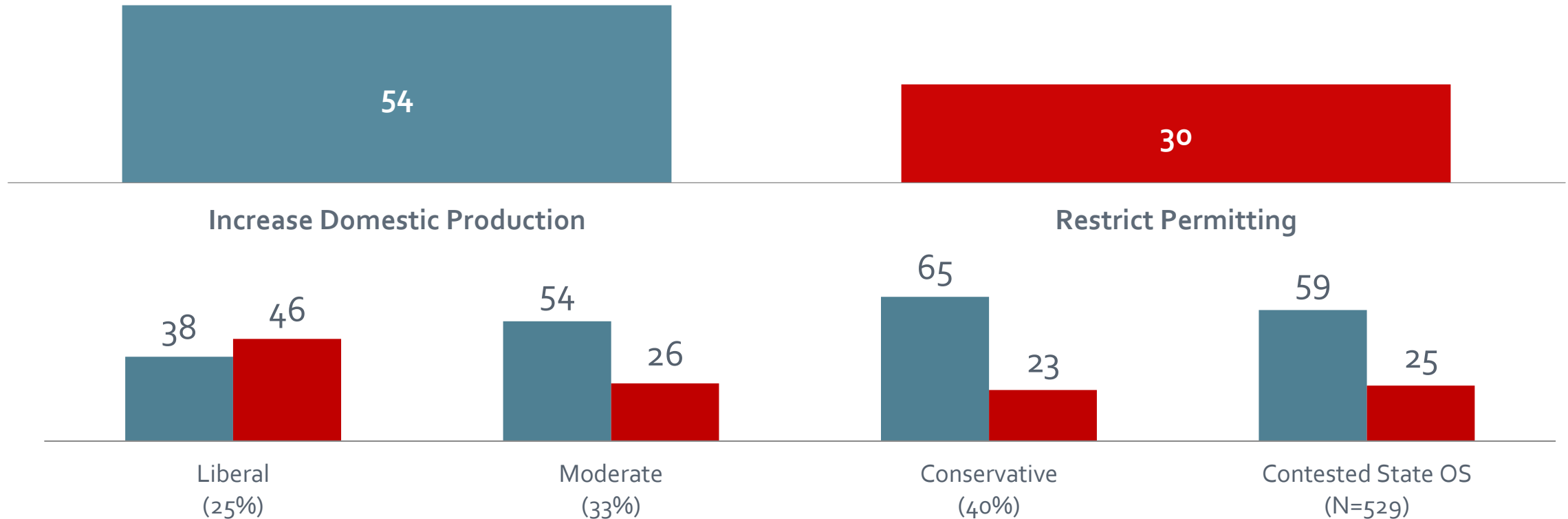
Do you support or oppose this bill?

Some say that increasing domestic energy production and streamlining permitting will enable the U.S. to be a leader in all energy sources and lower costs for Americans who are already struggling.

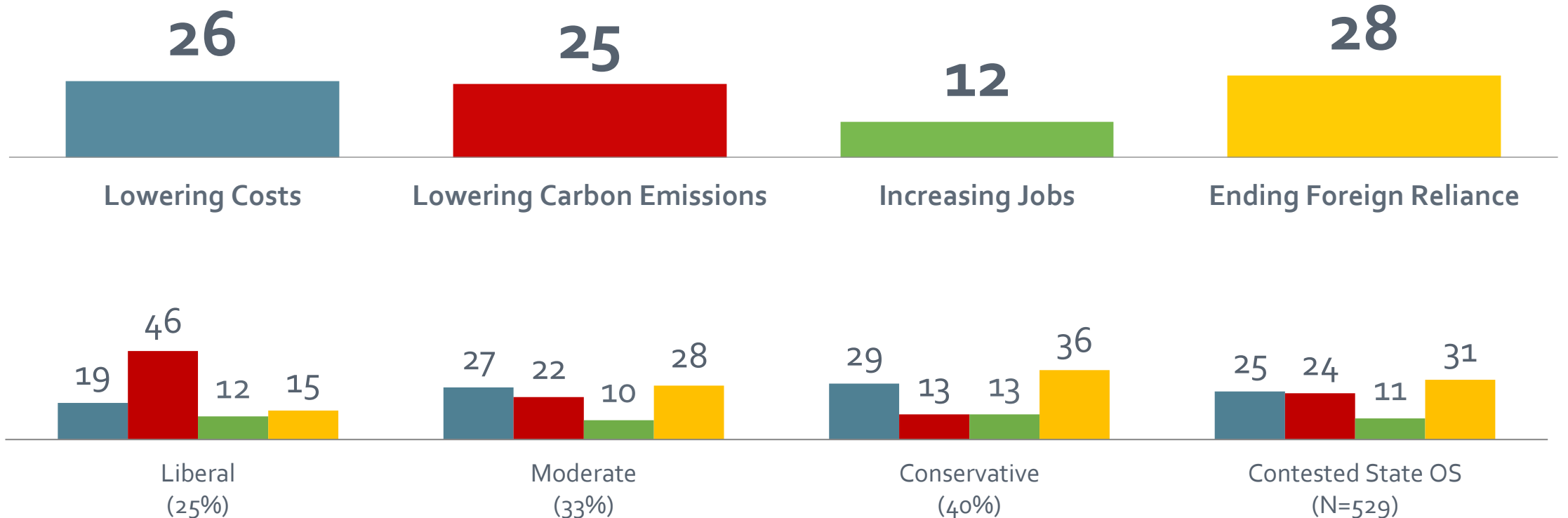
Others say that we need to be restrictive in permitting domestic energy projects in order to protect our environment and ensure that we have coordinated transition away from fossil fuels.



# ENERGY PRIORITIES

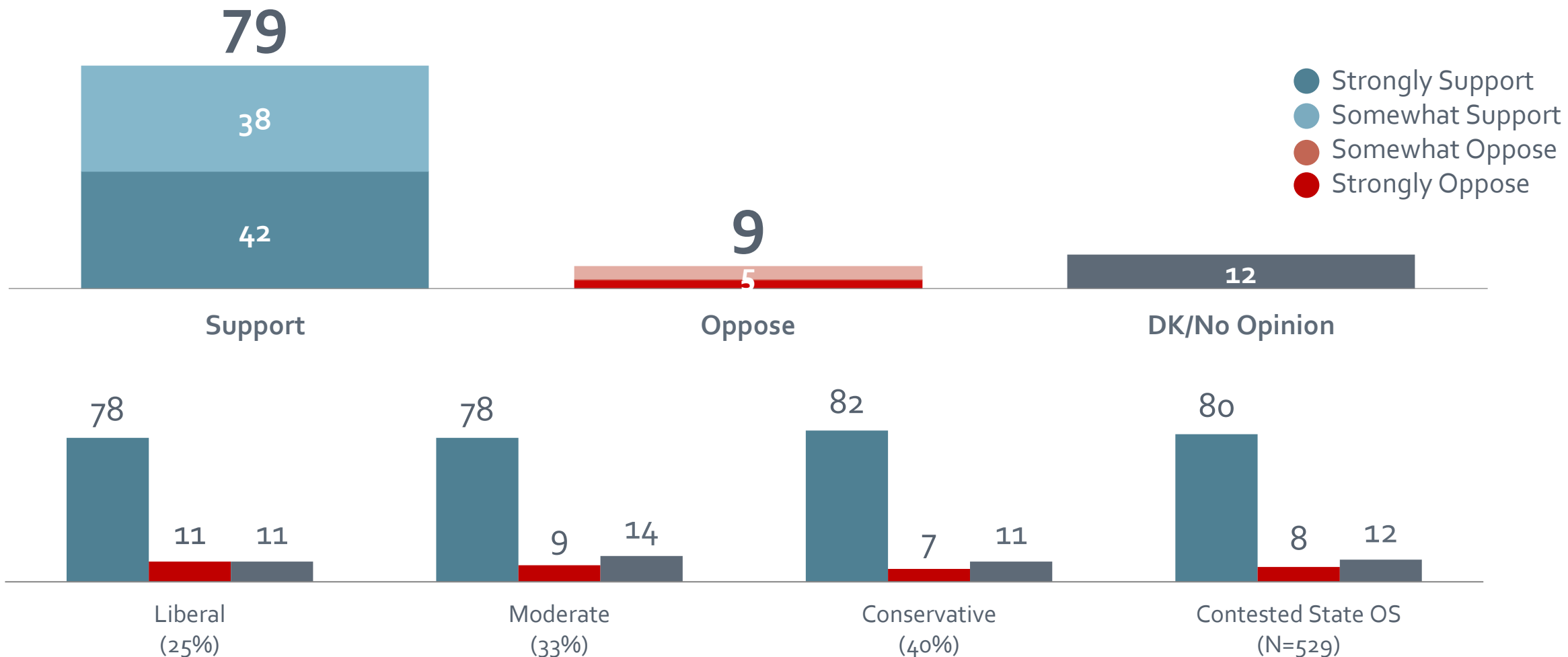
Which of the following do you personally think is the most important when it comes to American energy?
