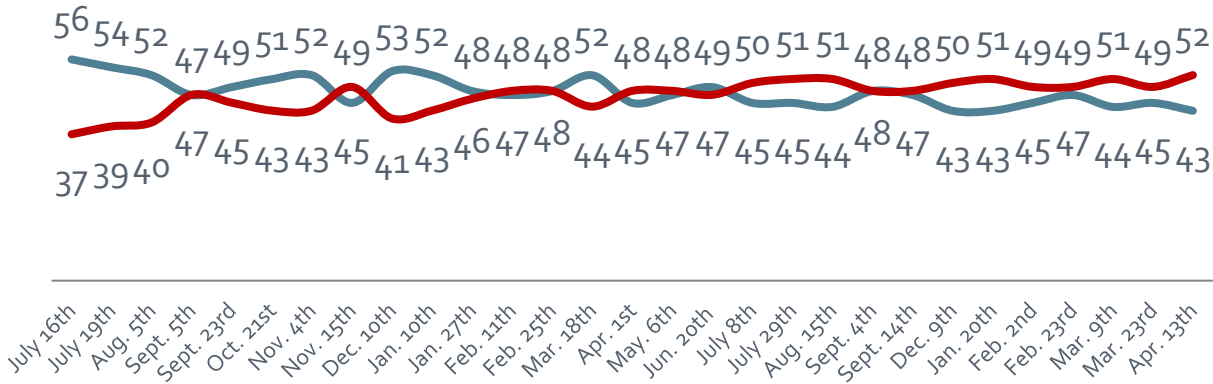

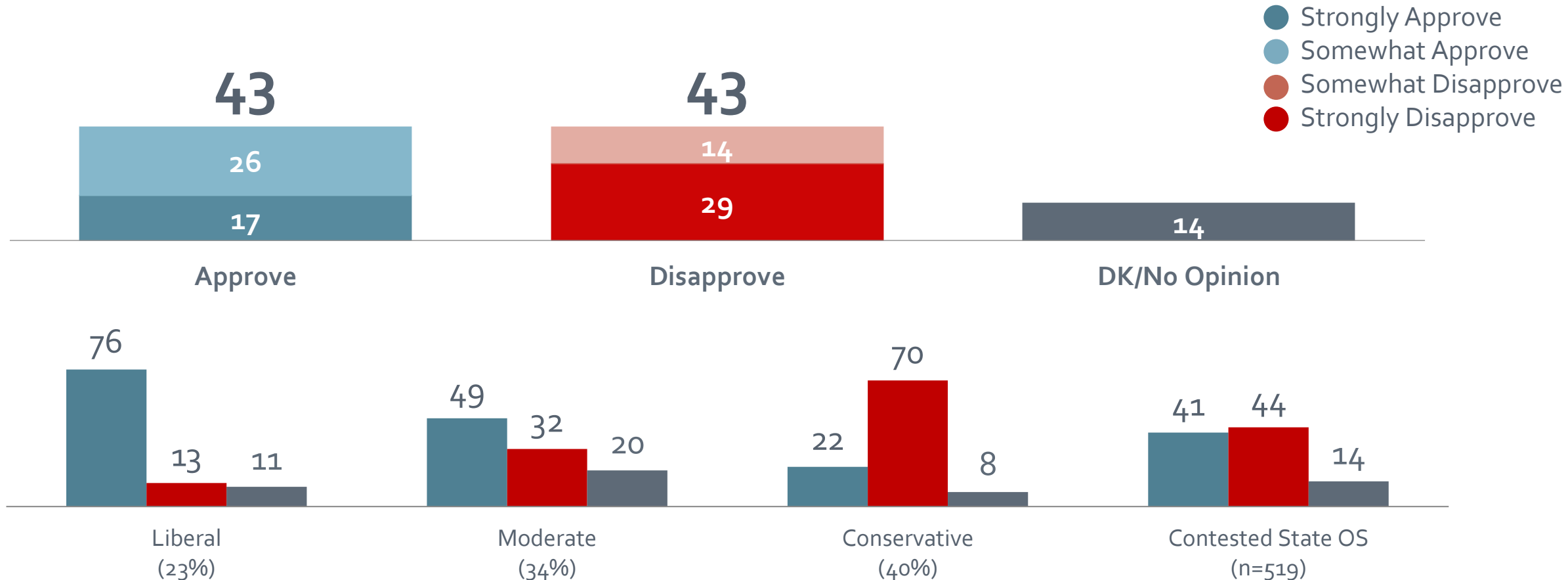

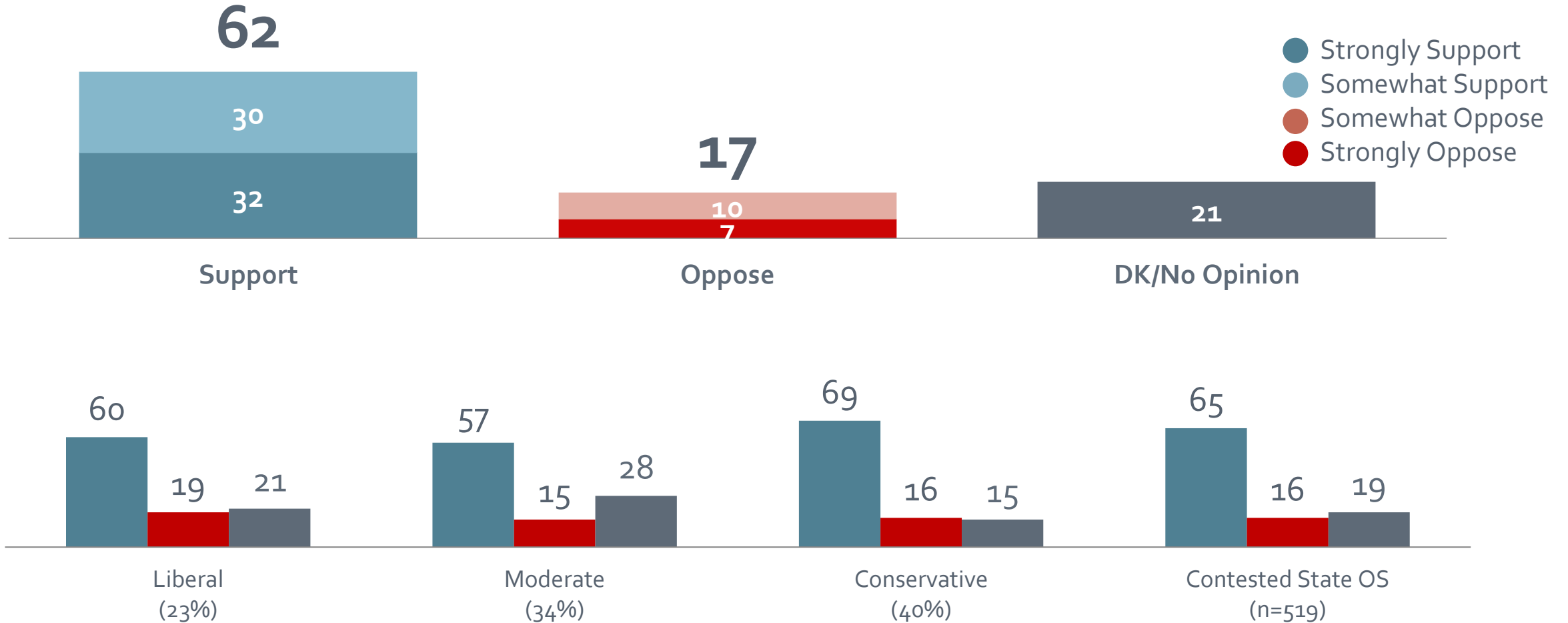
BIDEN EDUCATION APPROVAL

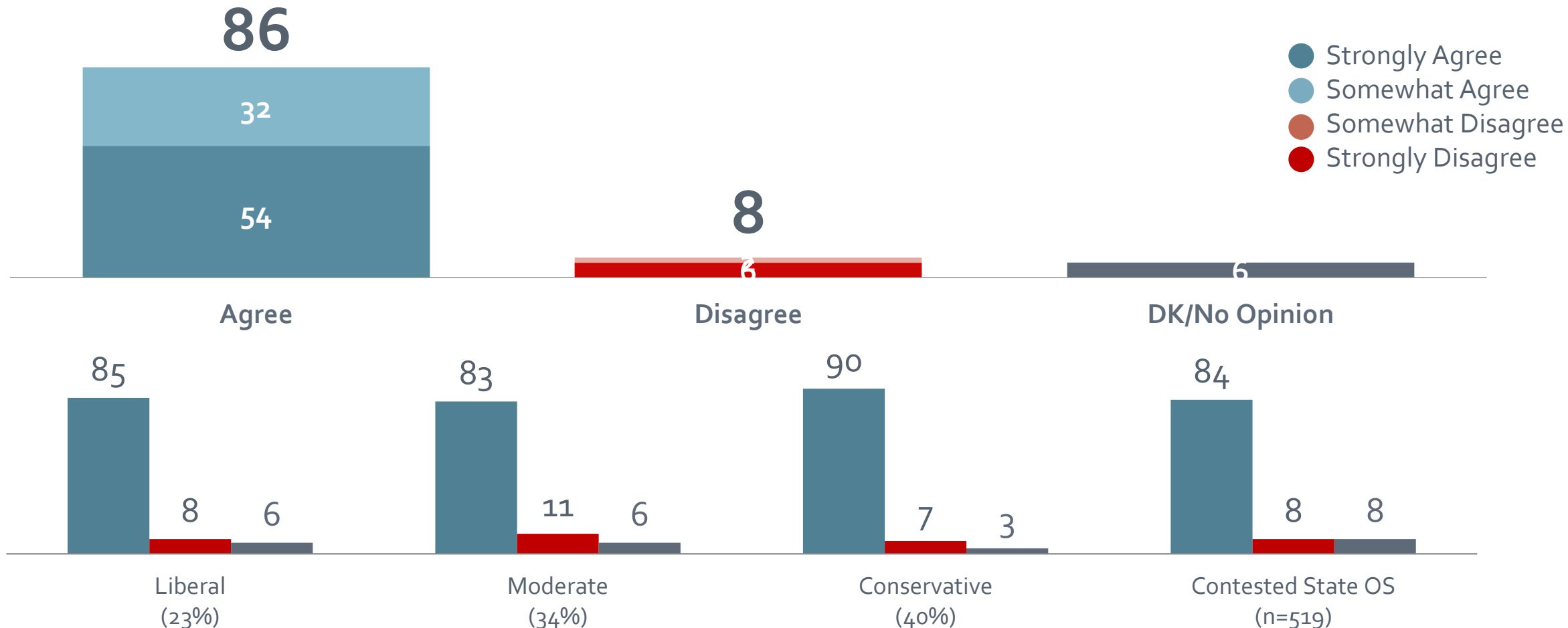
Do you generally support or oppose School Choice?

Thinking about K-12 education in our country, do you agree or disagree with the following statement?

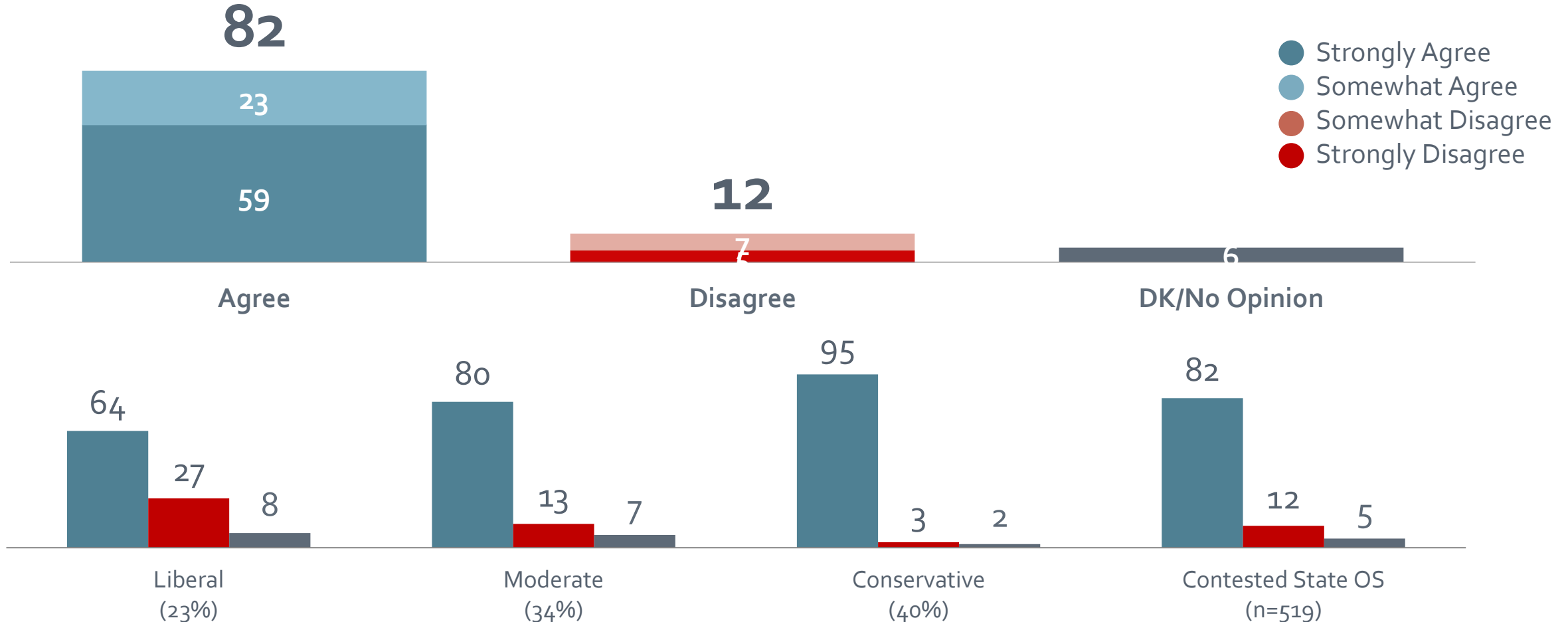
"No child should be forced to attend an unsafe or failing school because they can't afford to go somewhere else."

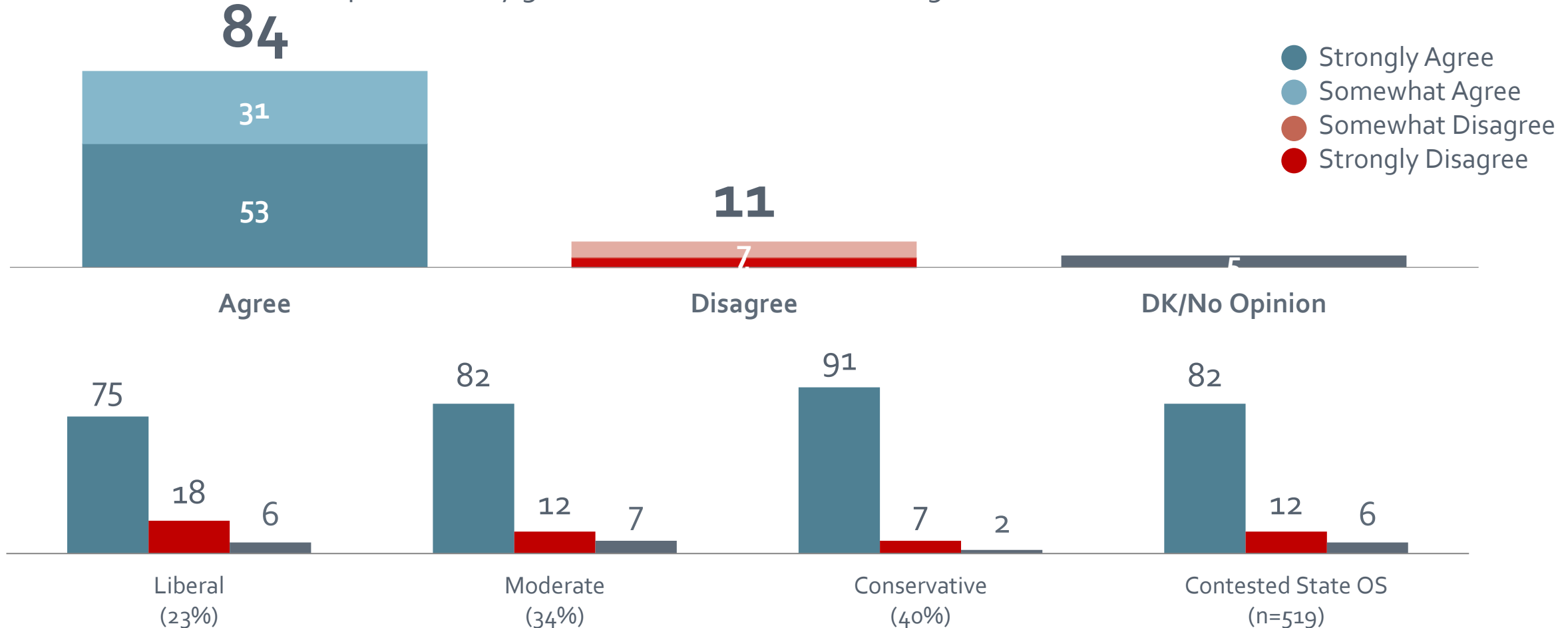

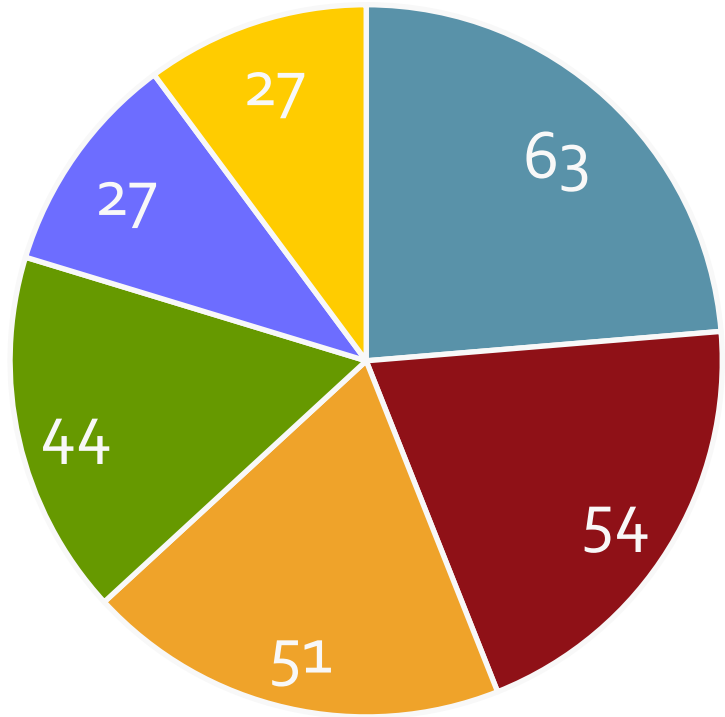

- Nutrition – 26%

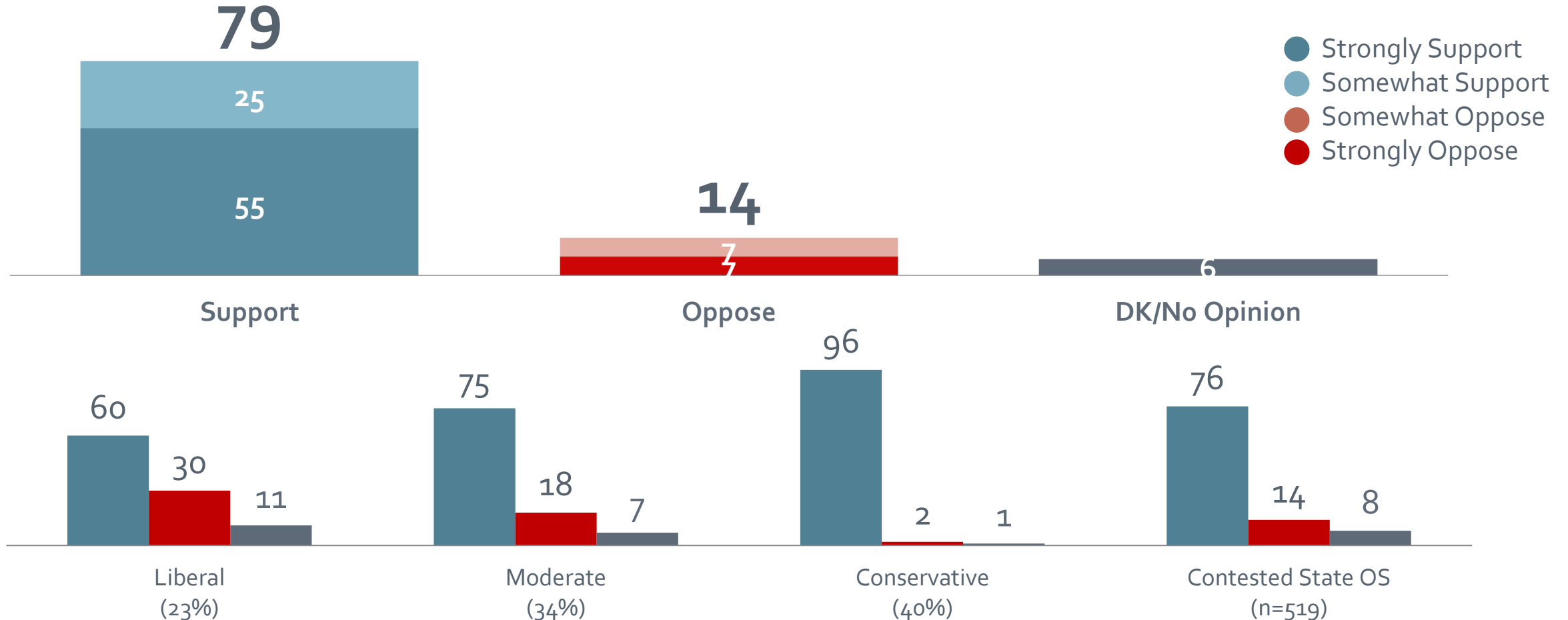
Top Five Among Conservatives (40%):
