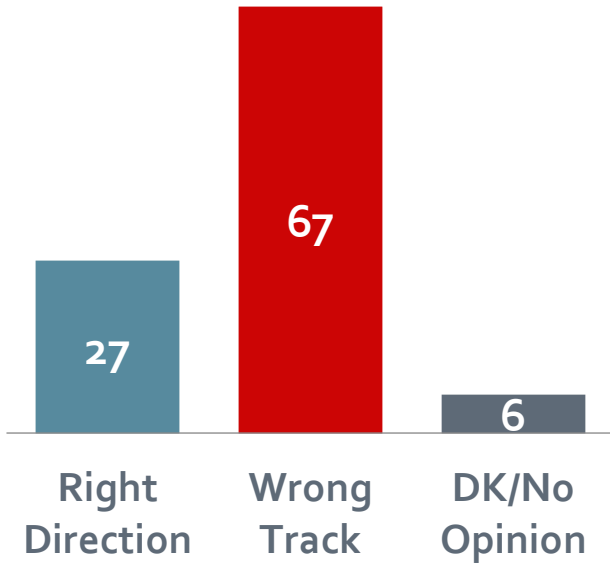

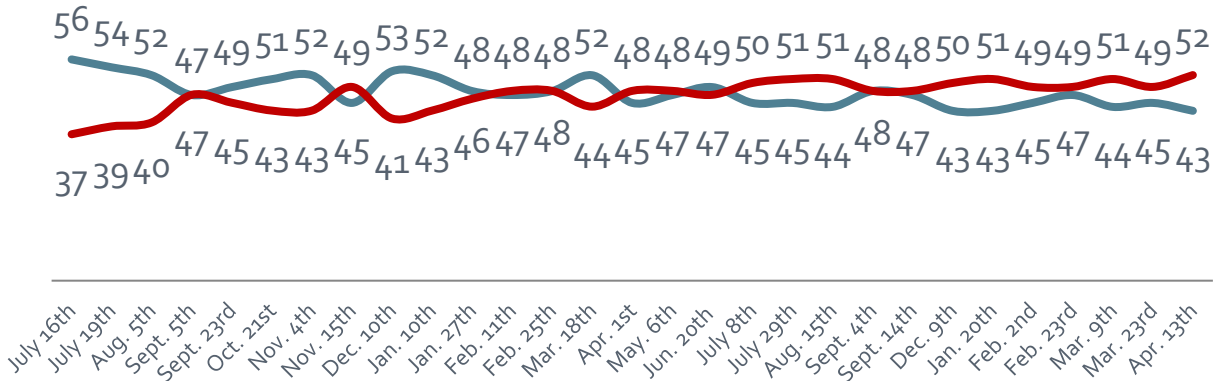

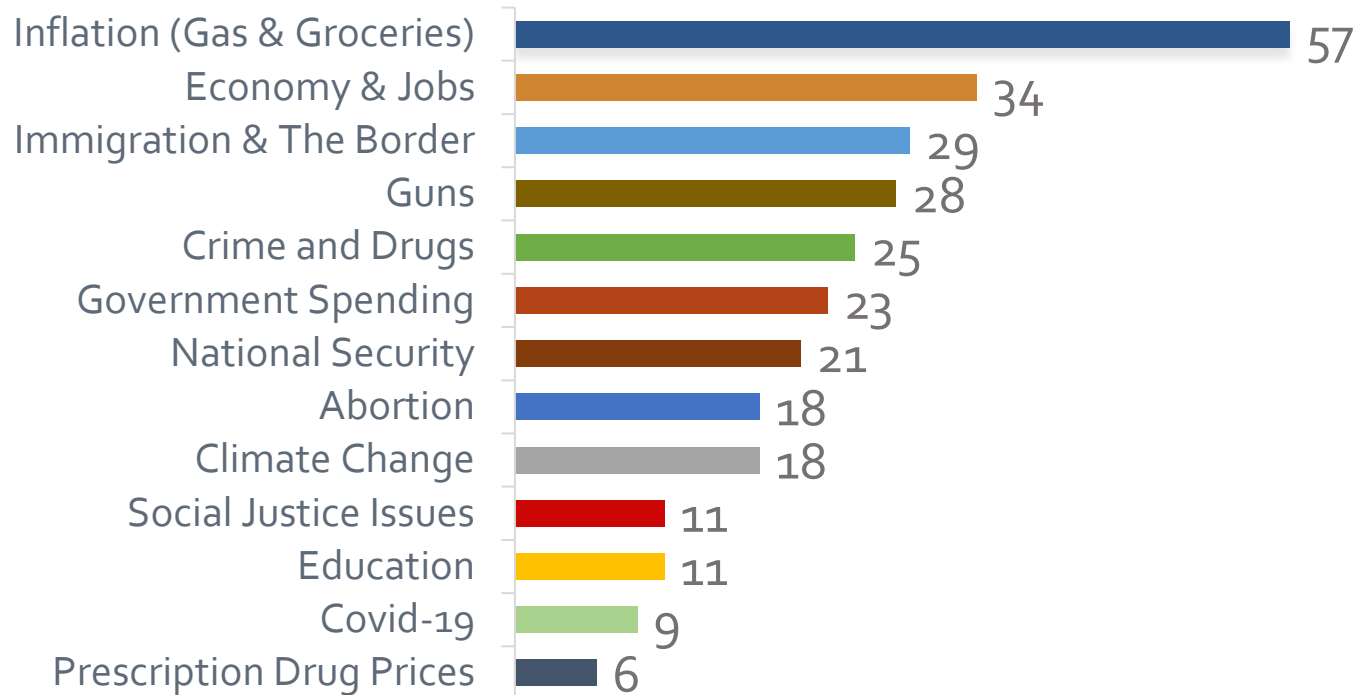

- National Security – 30%

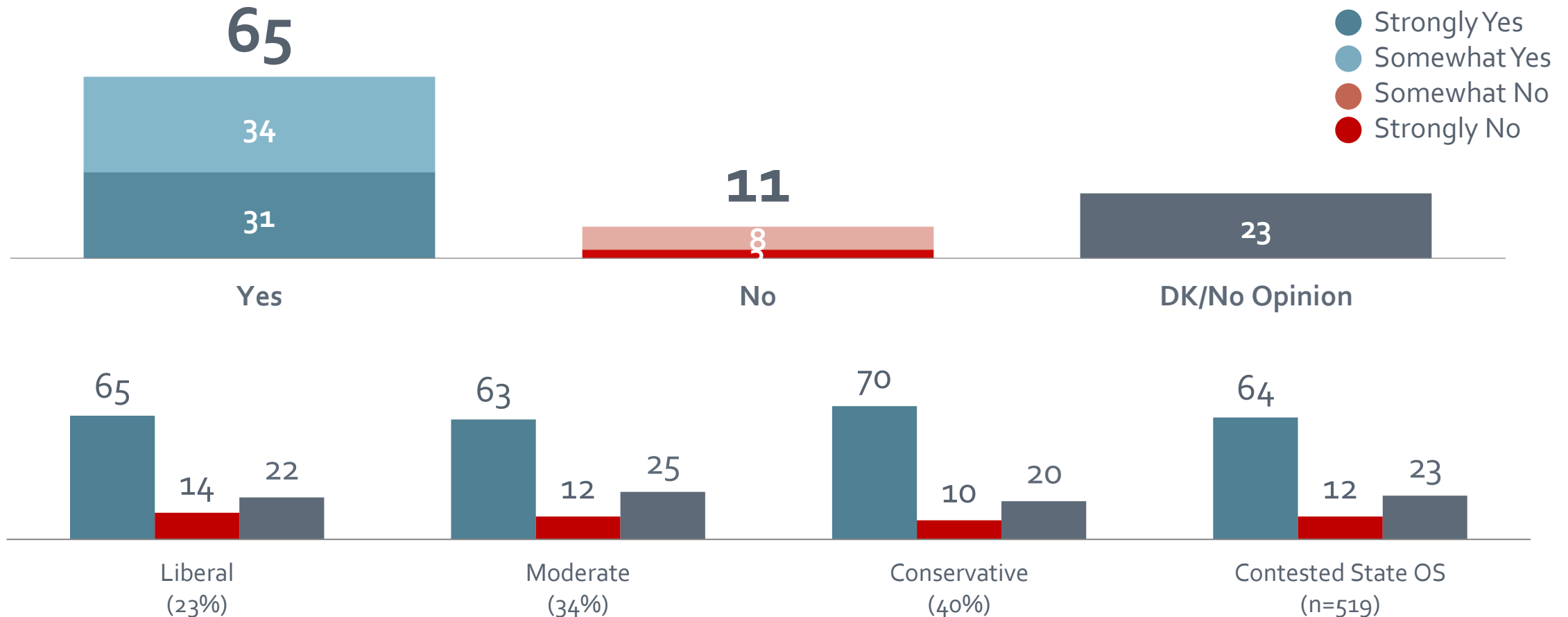




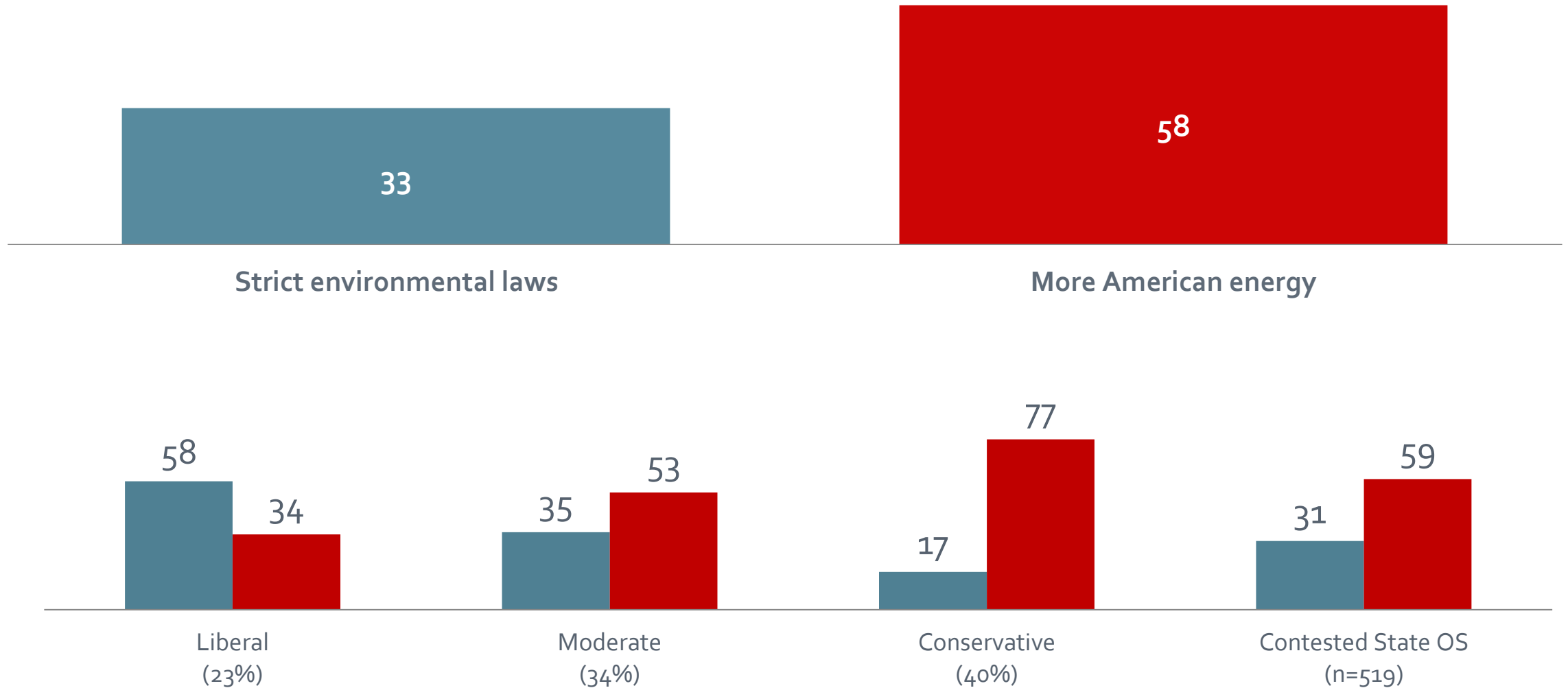

PERMITTING REFORM

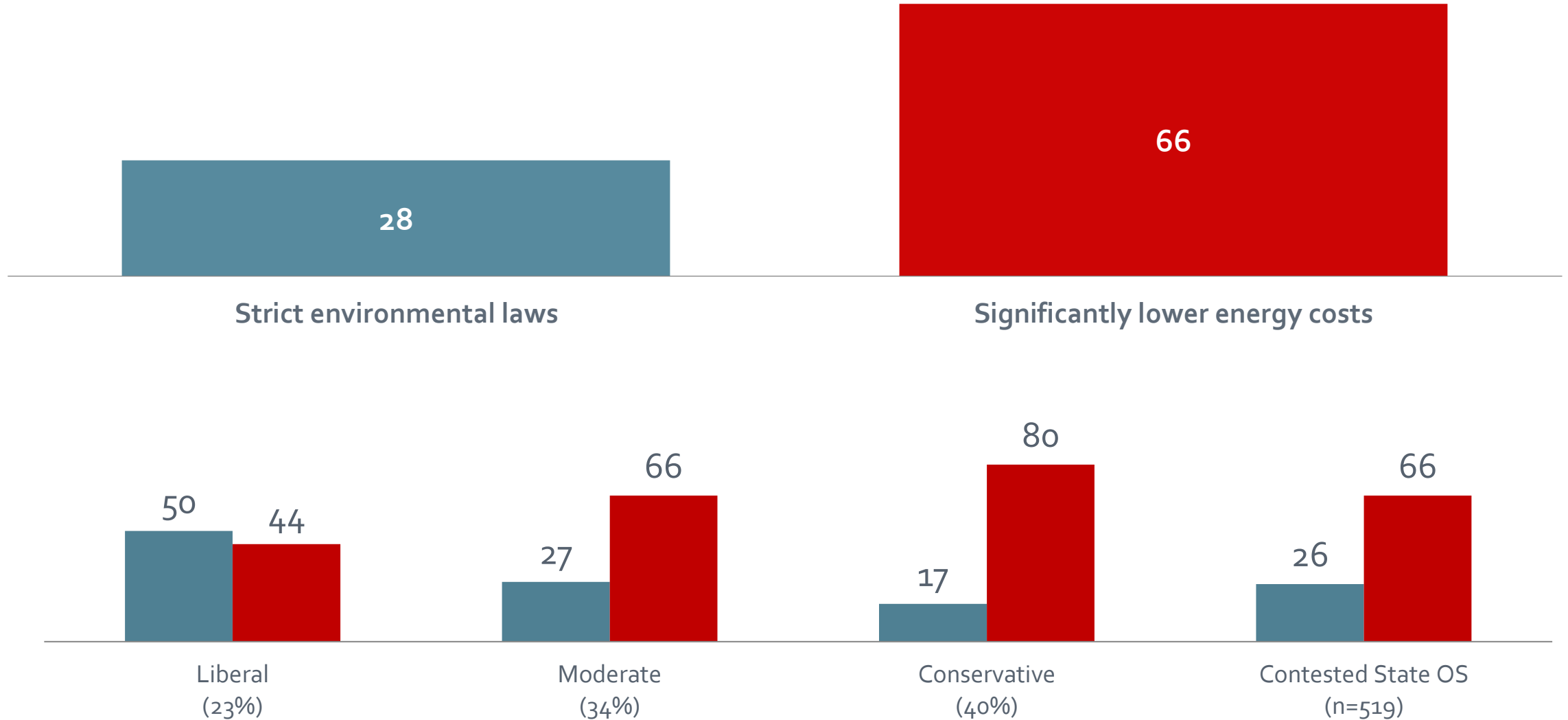

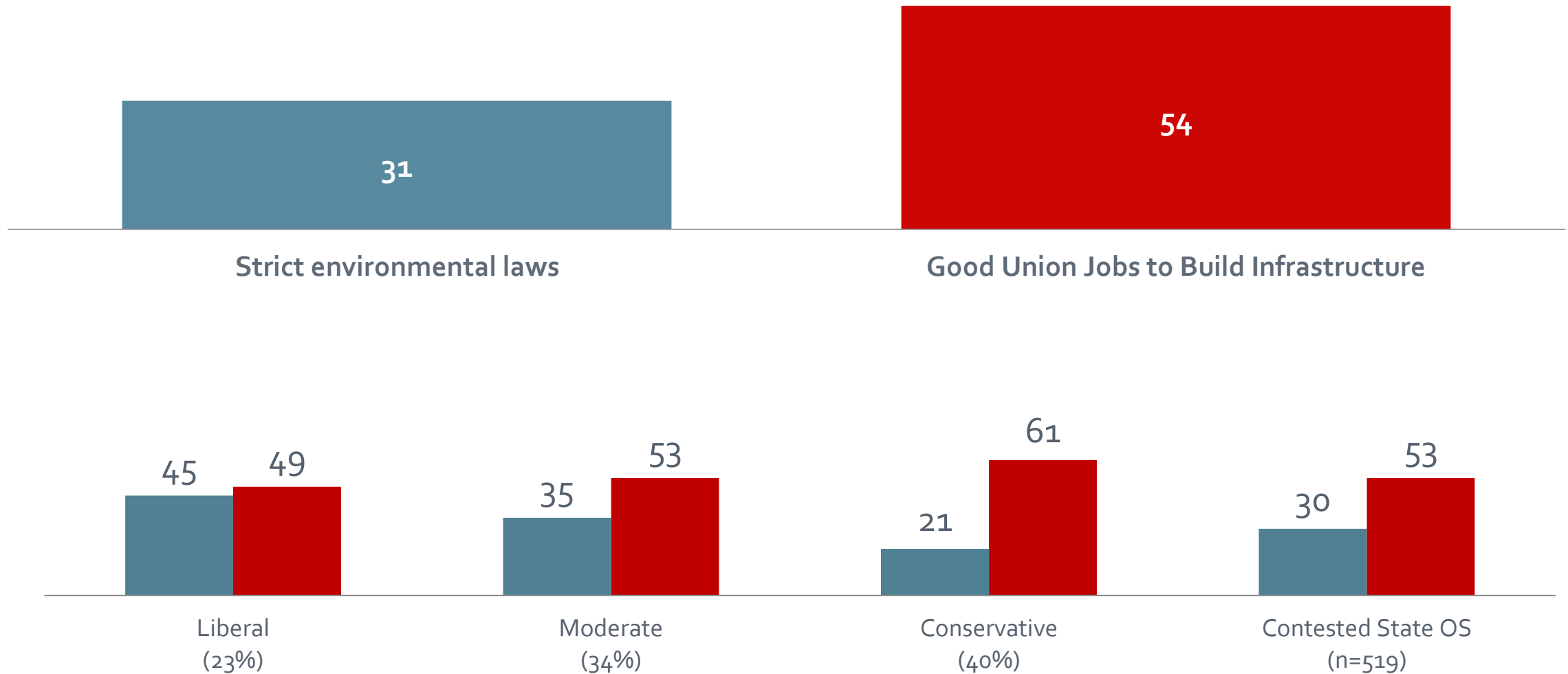
