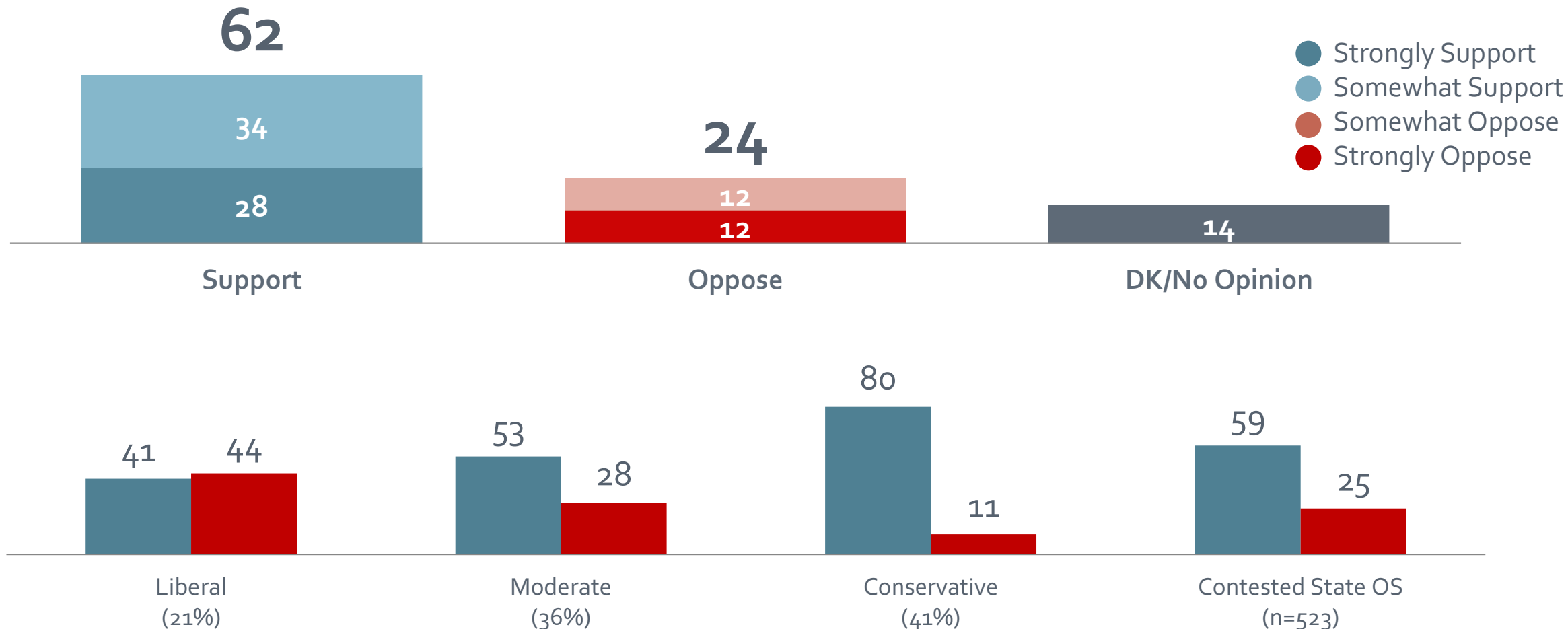
# DEBT LIMIT S/R/H

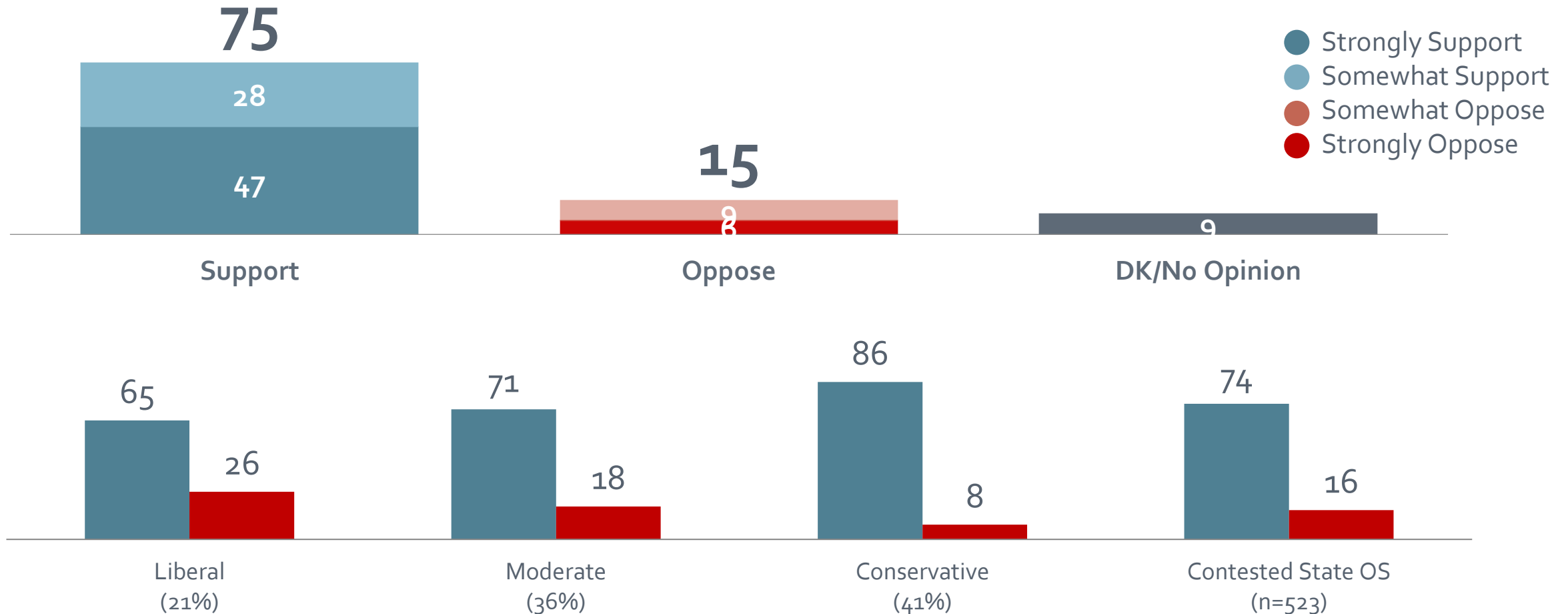

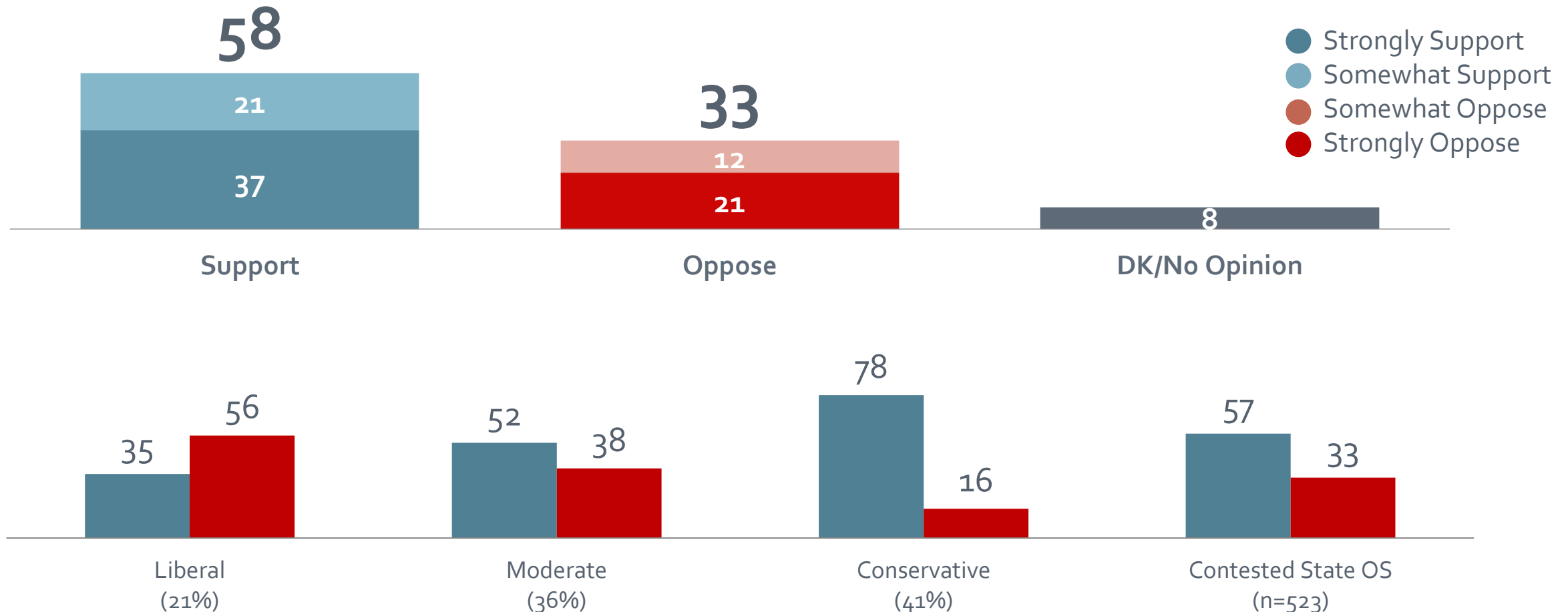

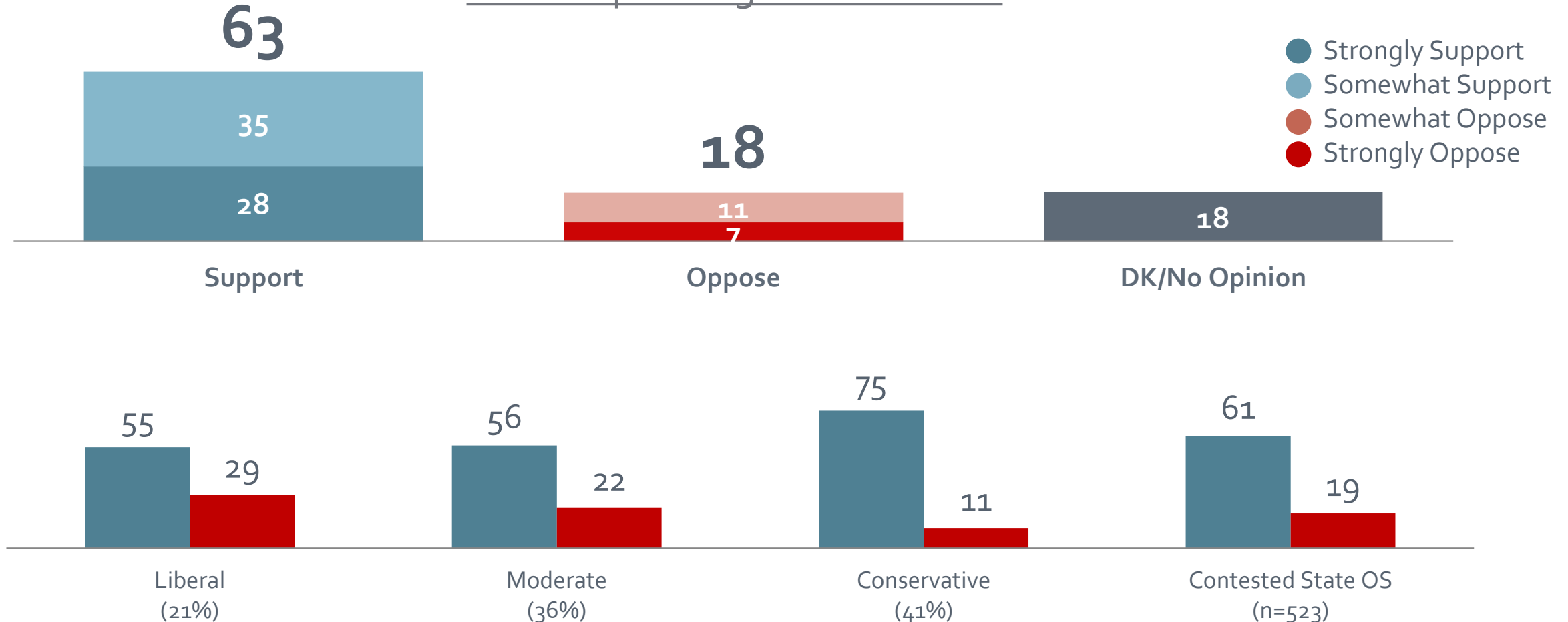
