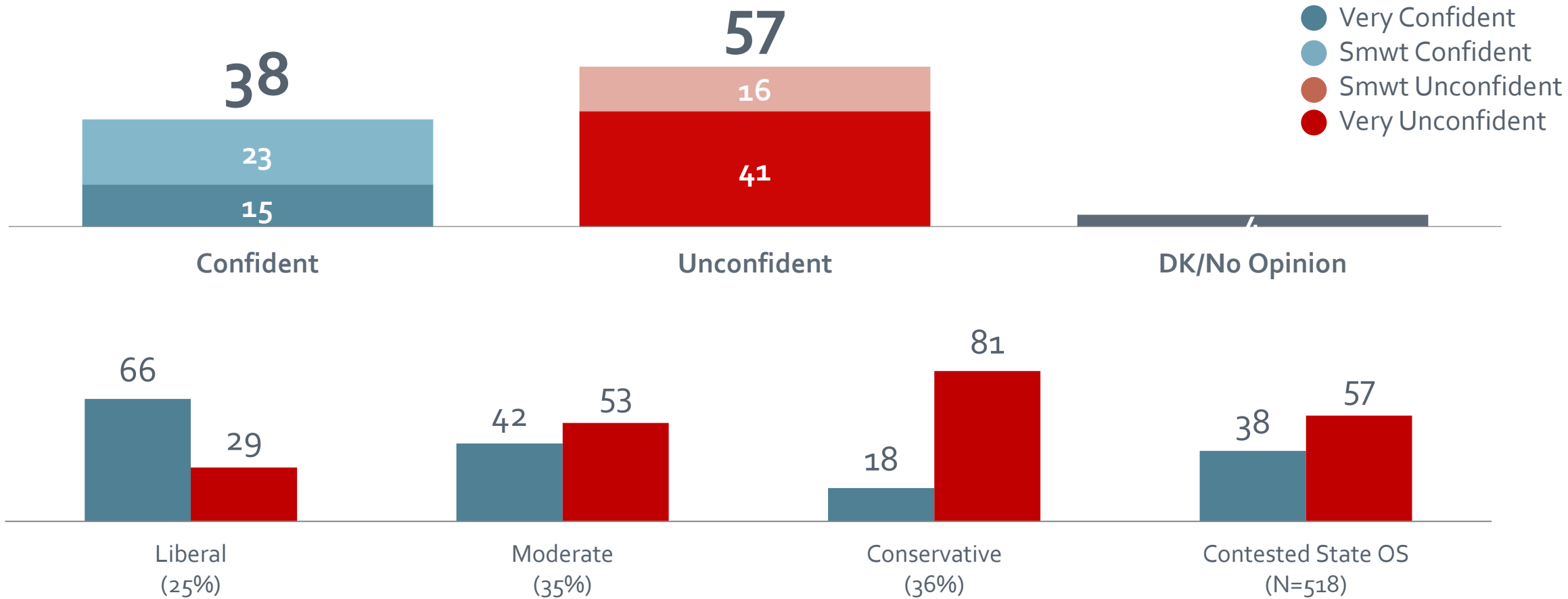

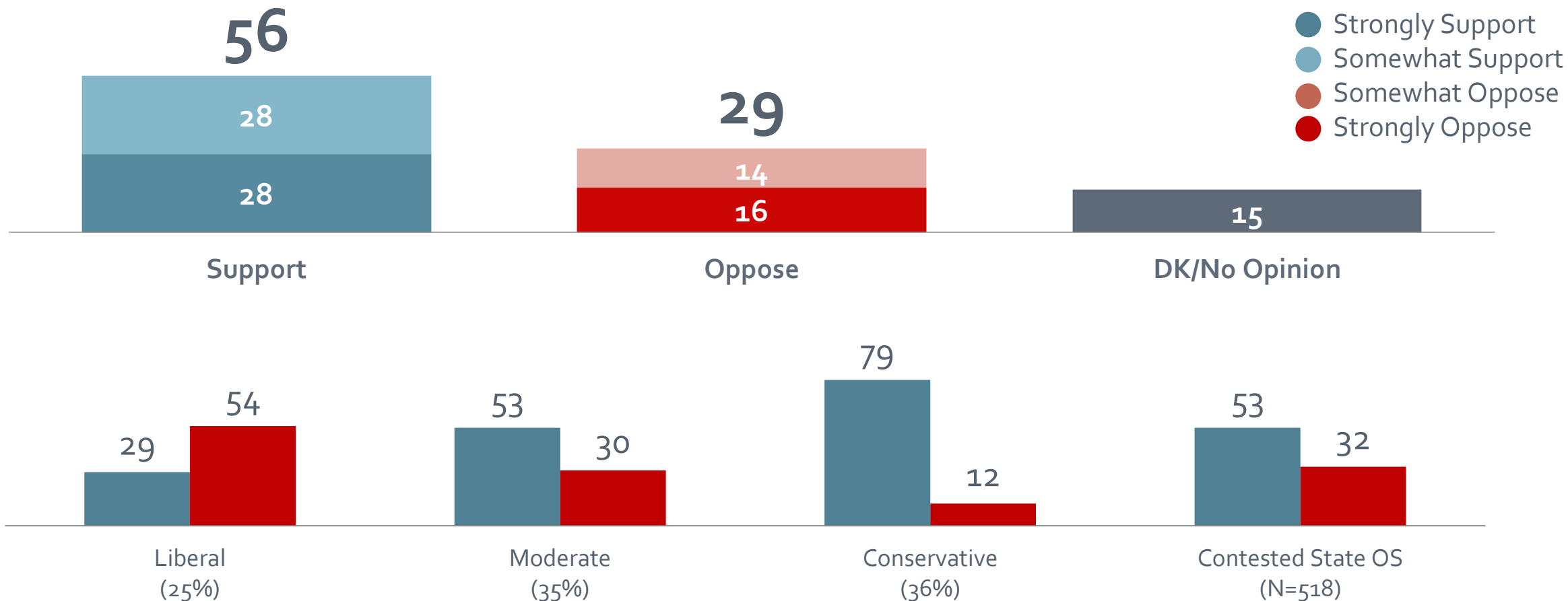
How confident are you that President Biden is capable of handling the economic issues facing our country?

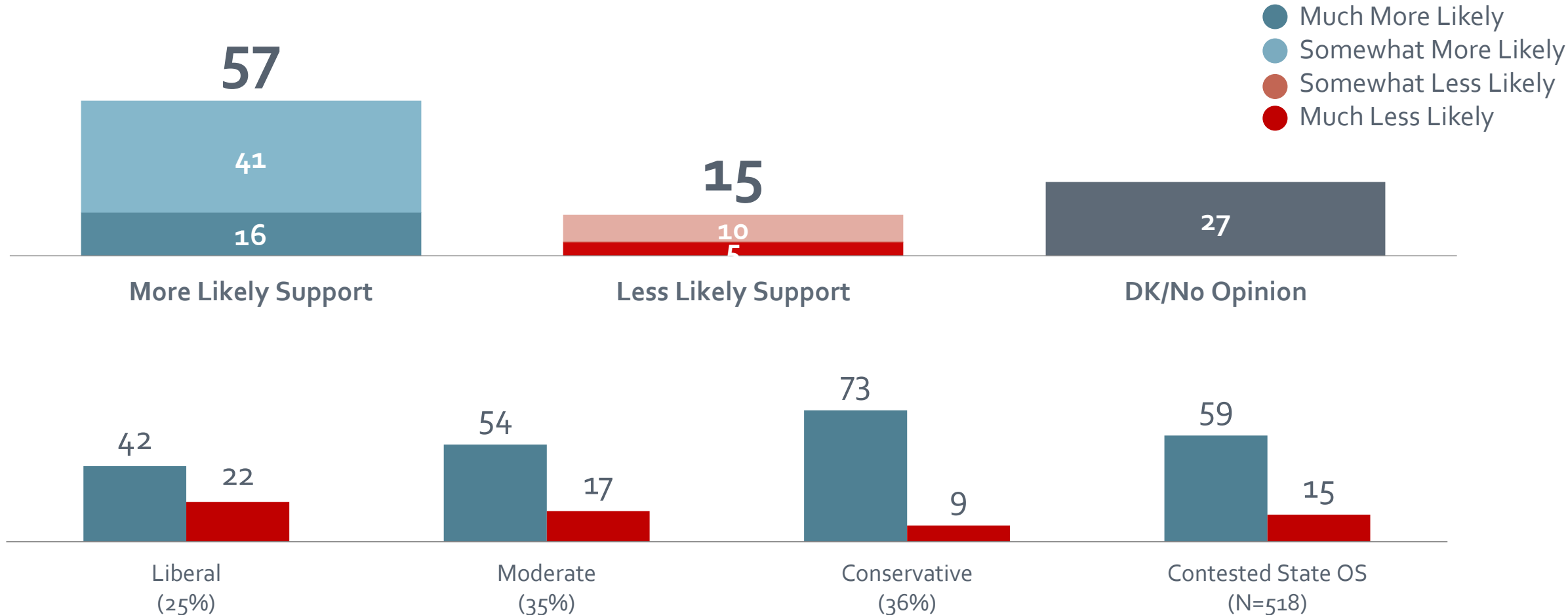
As you many know, one spending cut in the proposal from House Republicans is implementing stringent work requirements for federal welfare programs.

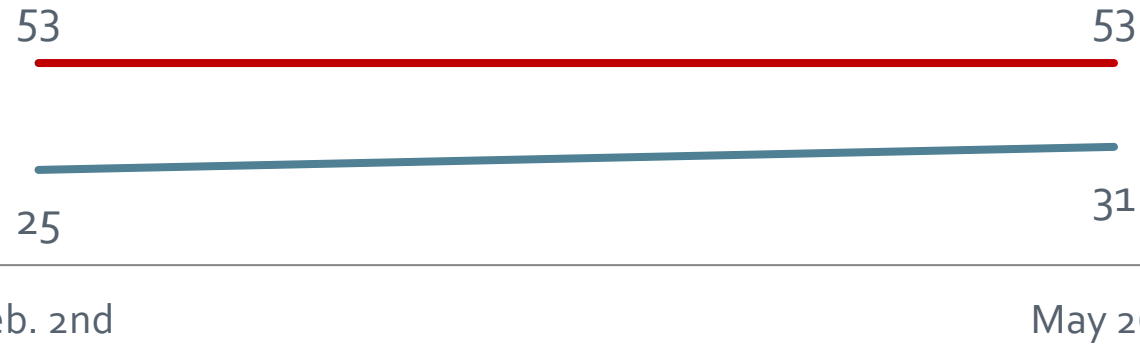
If a debt limit package comes together around spending caps, which would set in place a top level of spending, reduced from the current pace of spending, would you be more or less likely to support the deal?



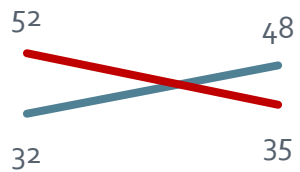
Which of the following positions on addressing the debt limit would you most support?

A debt limit increase paired with spending constraints.

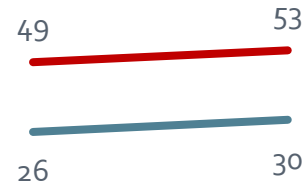

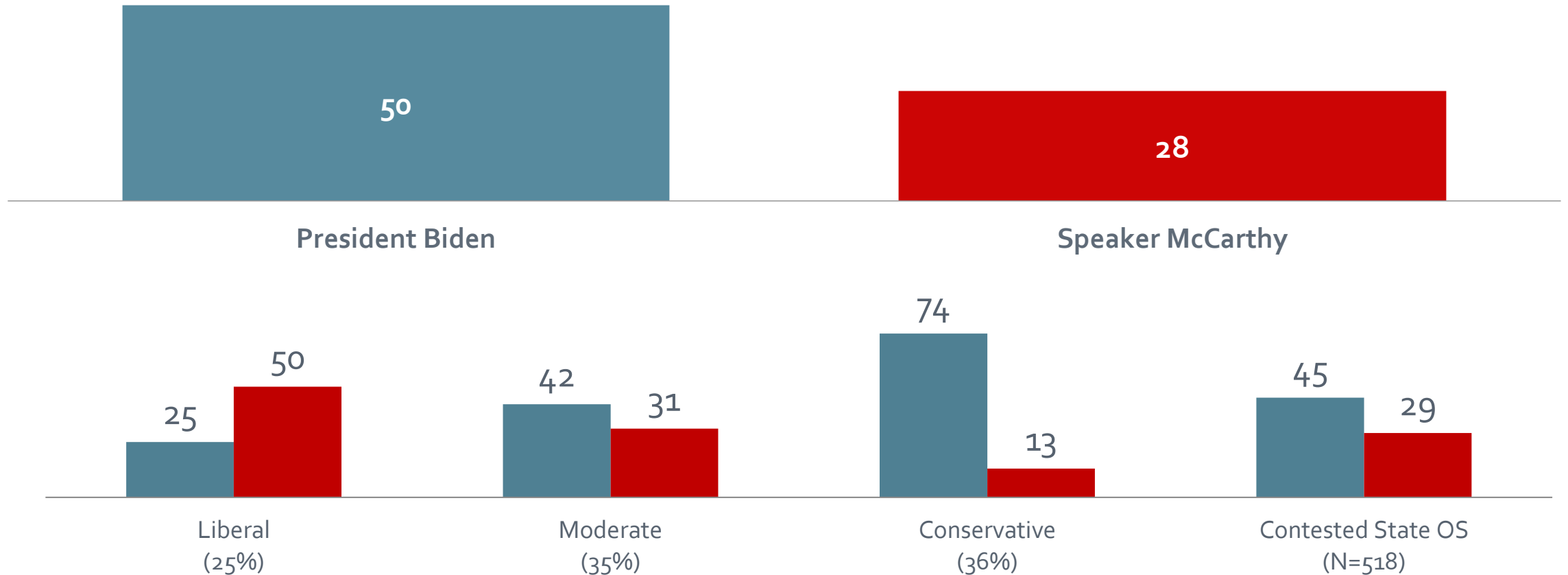
