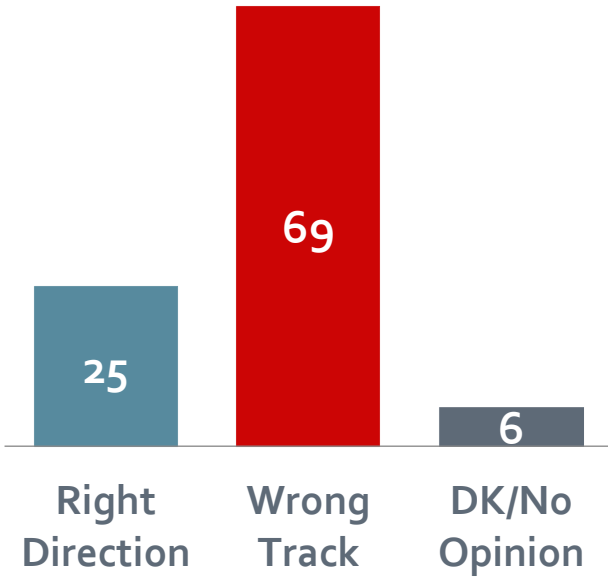

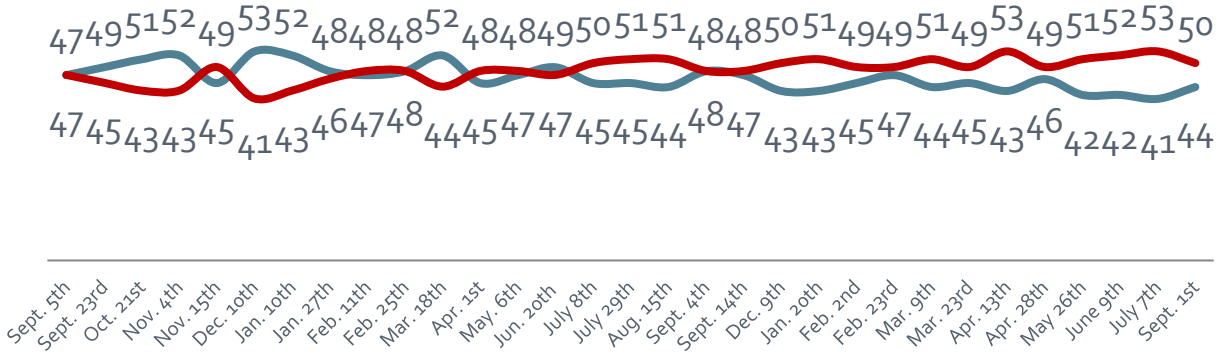

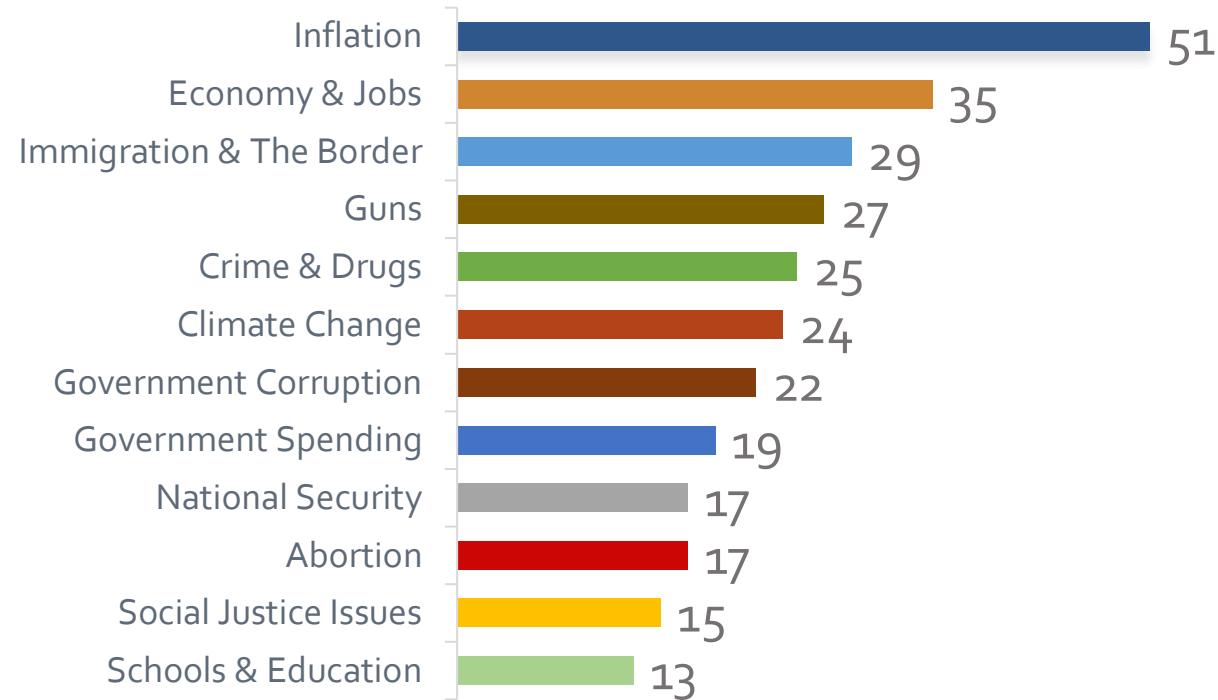

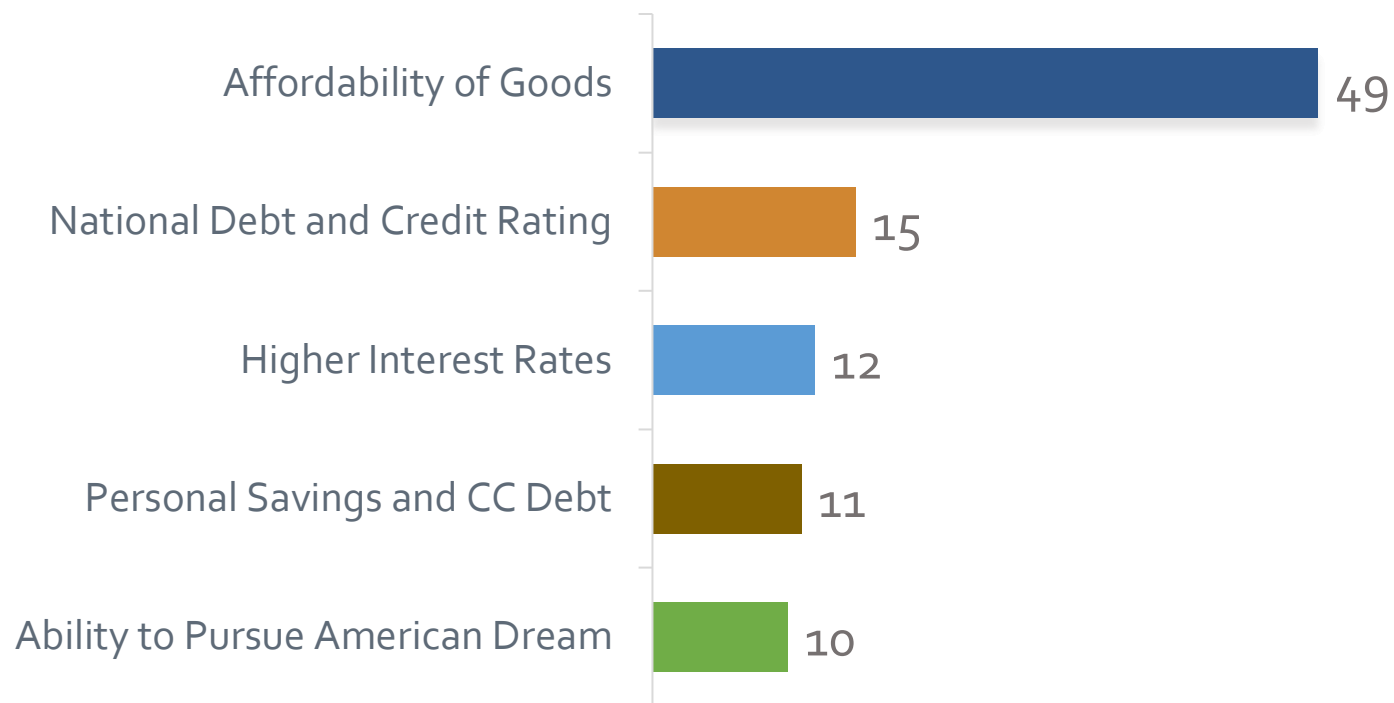

- Personal Savings & CC Debt – 9%

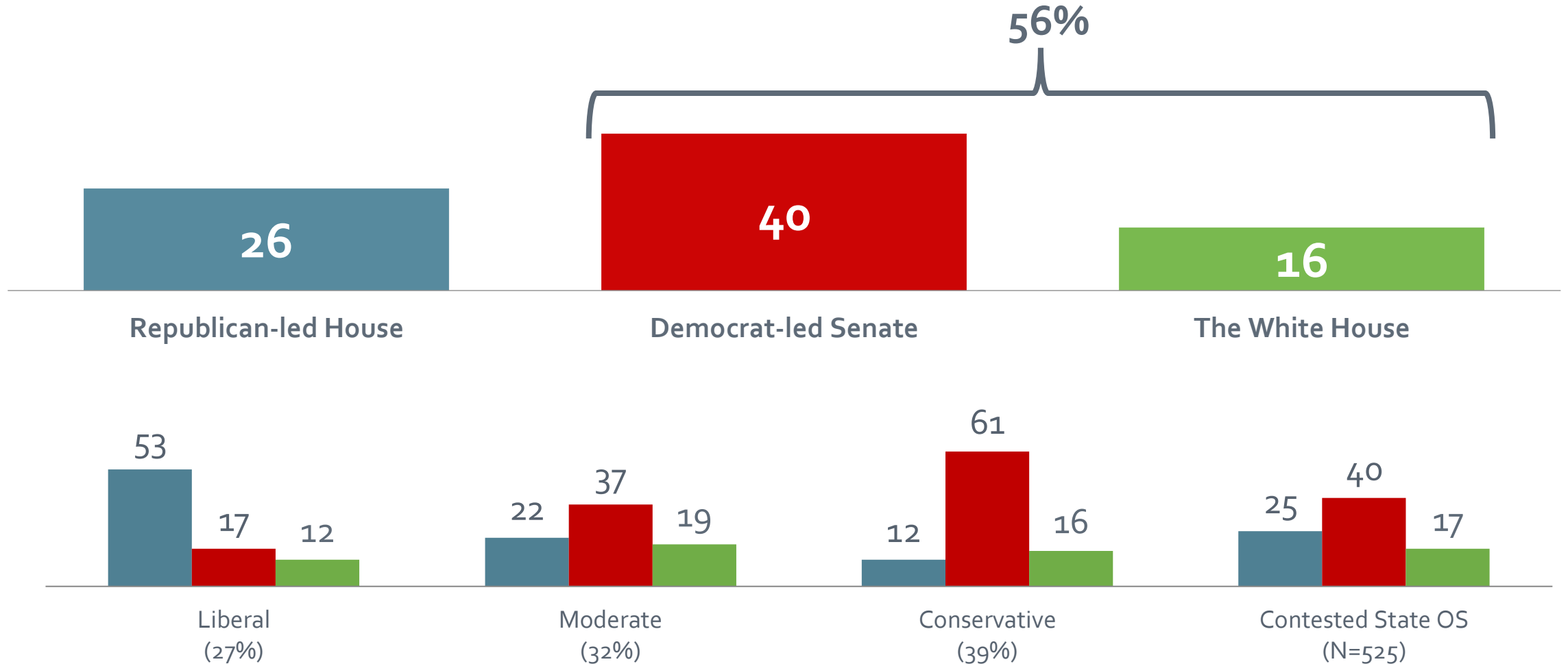
Among Conservatives (39%):

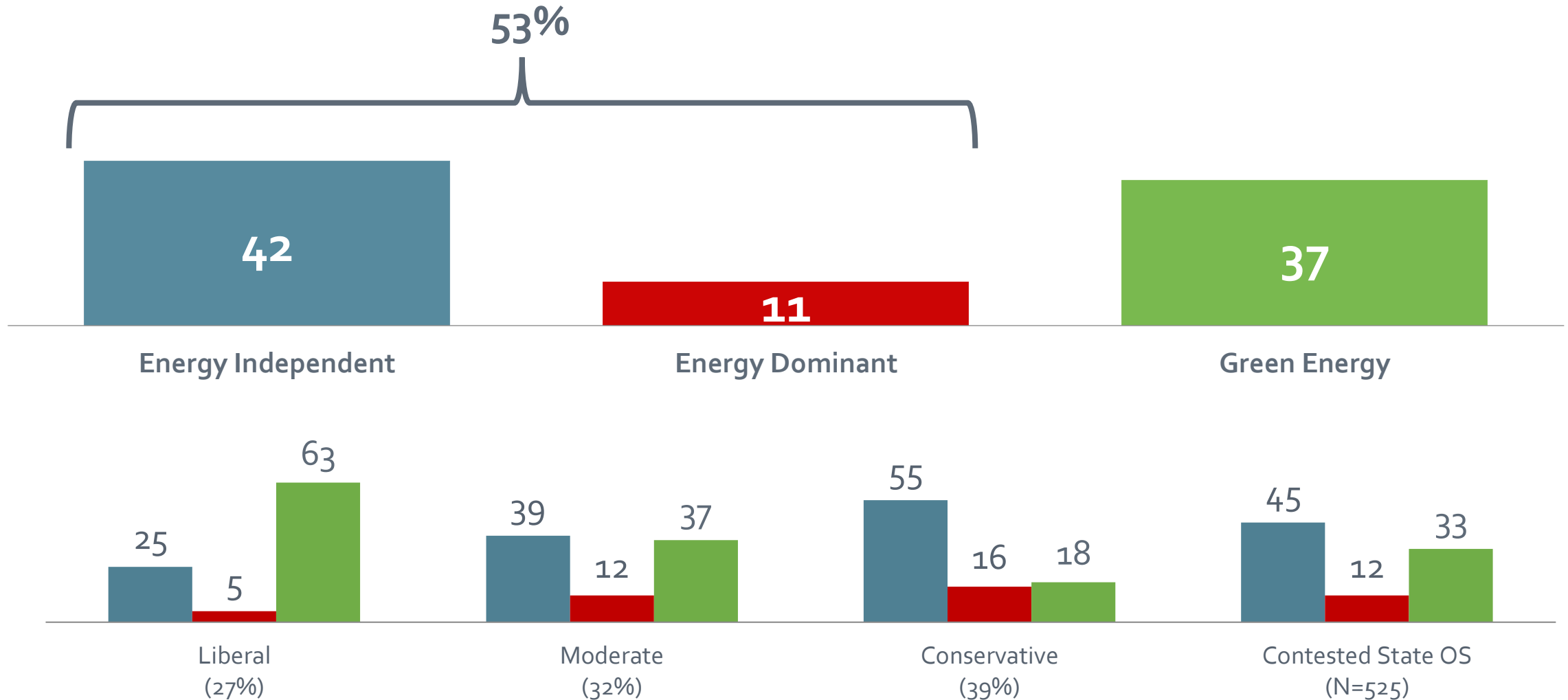

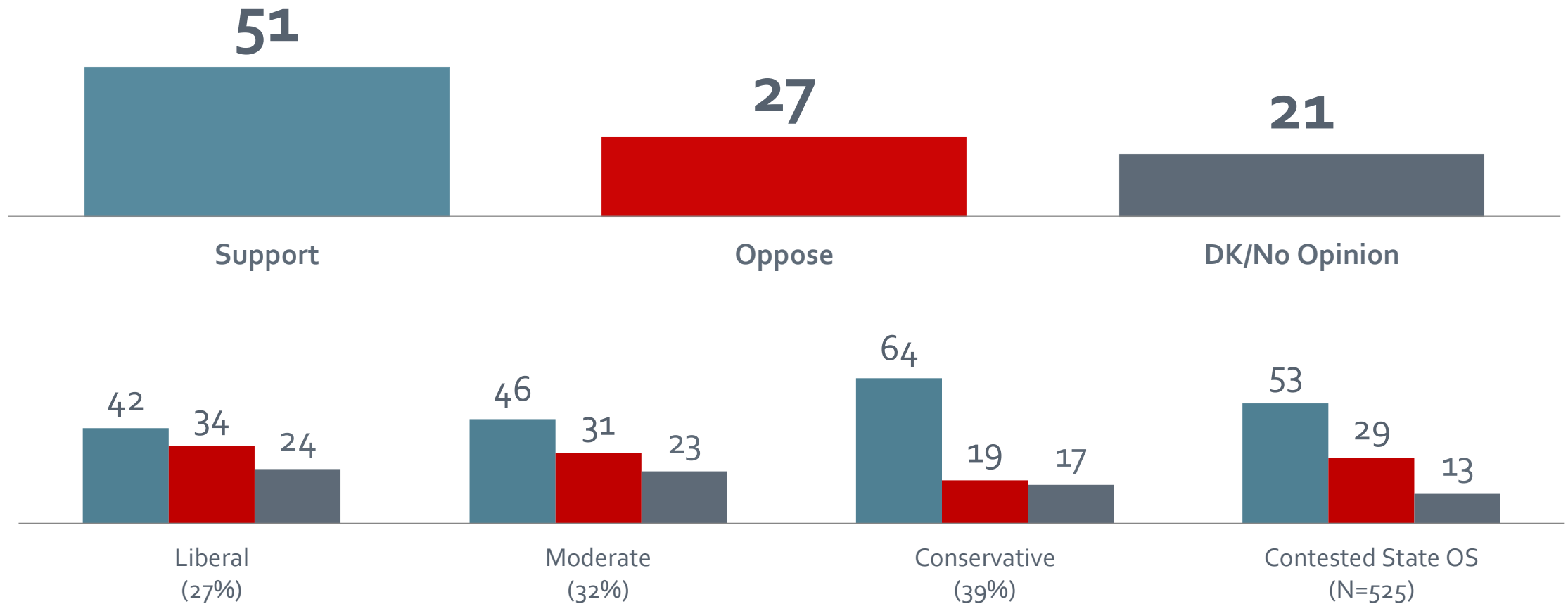

Which of the following phrases best describes the approach you think the U.S. should take on energy?



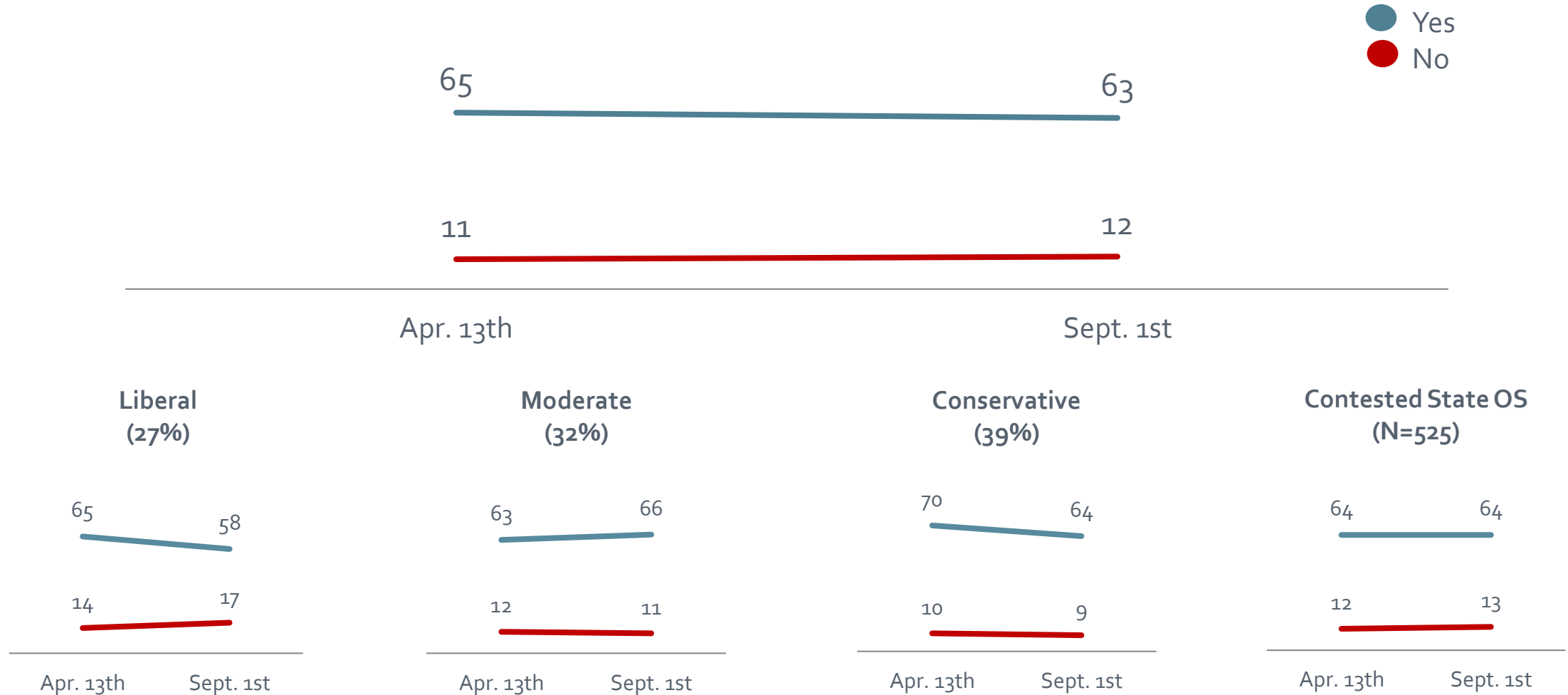
NUCLEAR ENERGY

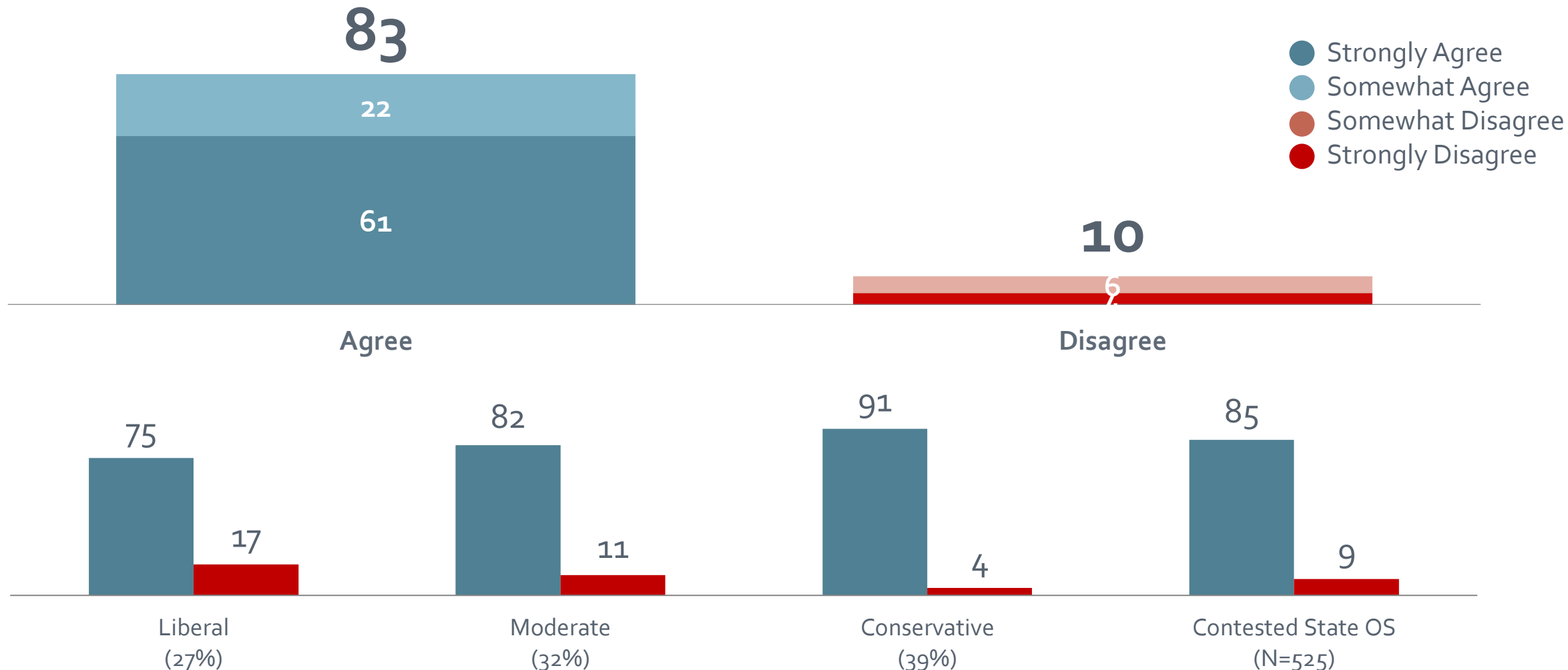

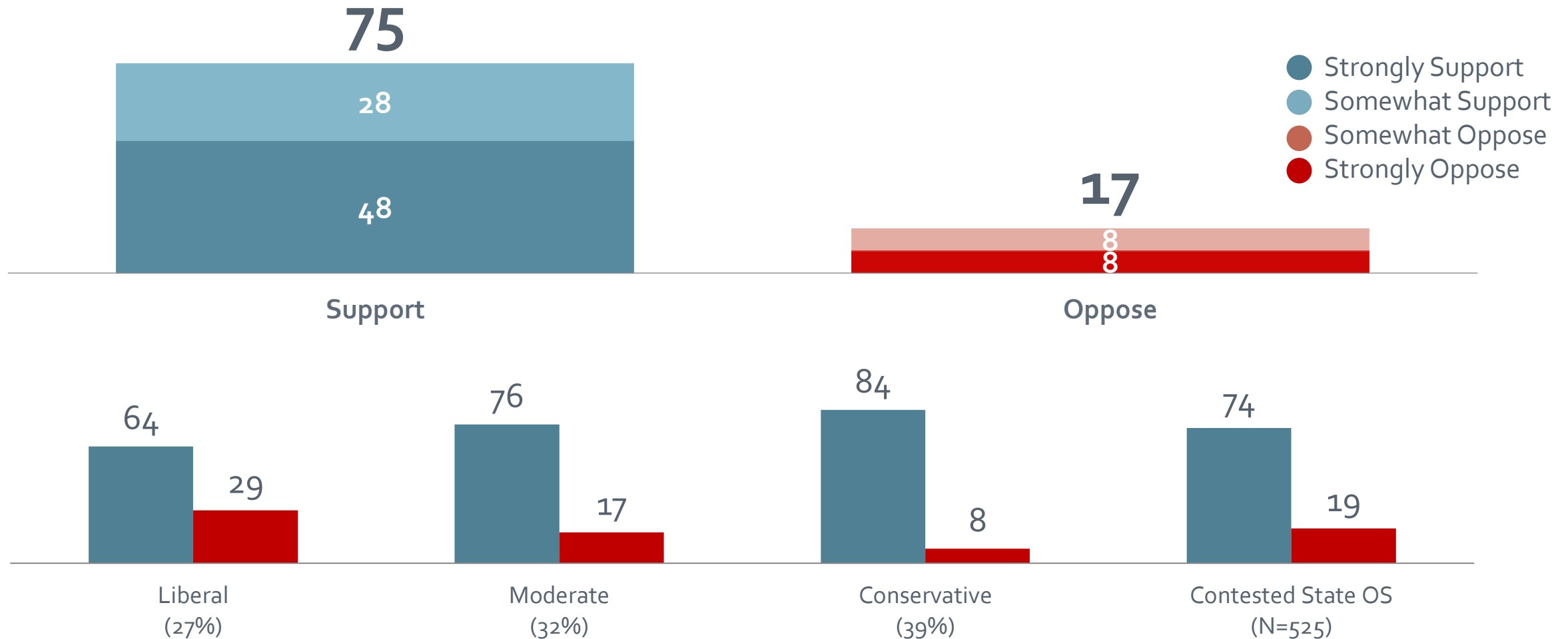
CRACKDOWN ON COUNTERFEITS
