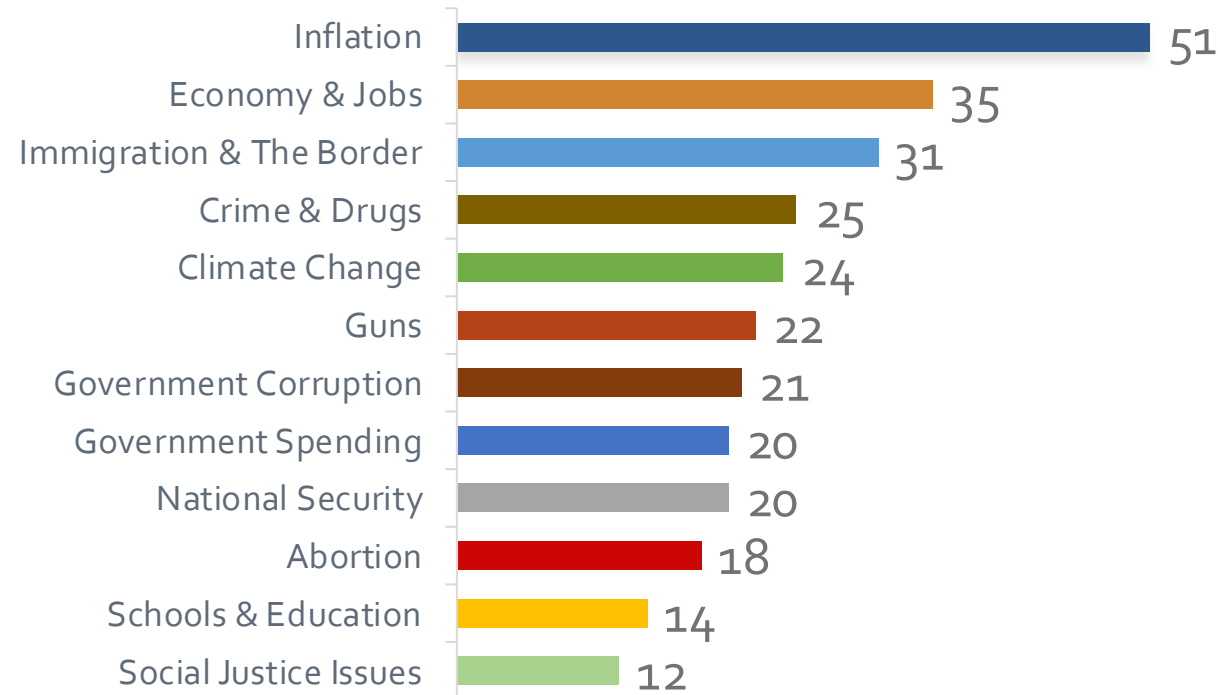

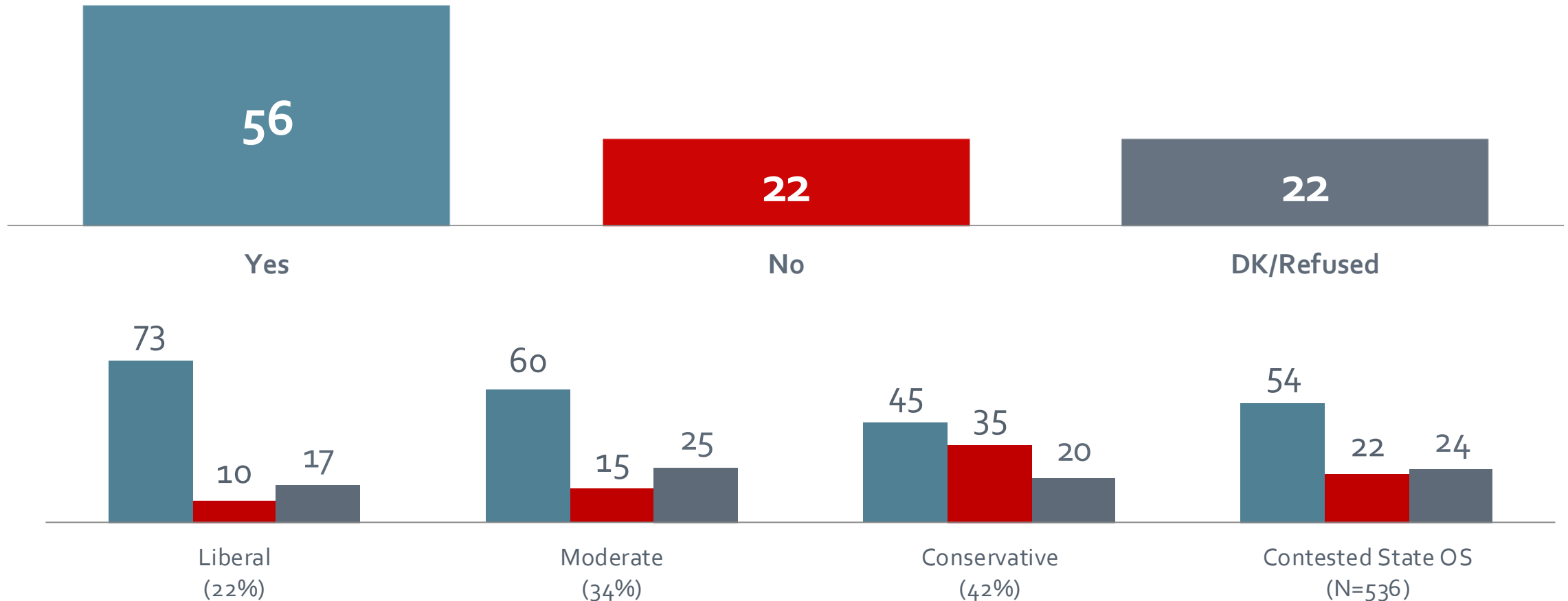
SHUTDOWN BLAME

As you may know, Congress is currently considering spending bills to fund the government. If Congress fails to pass these bills and the government shuts down, who do you blame?



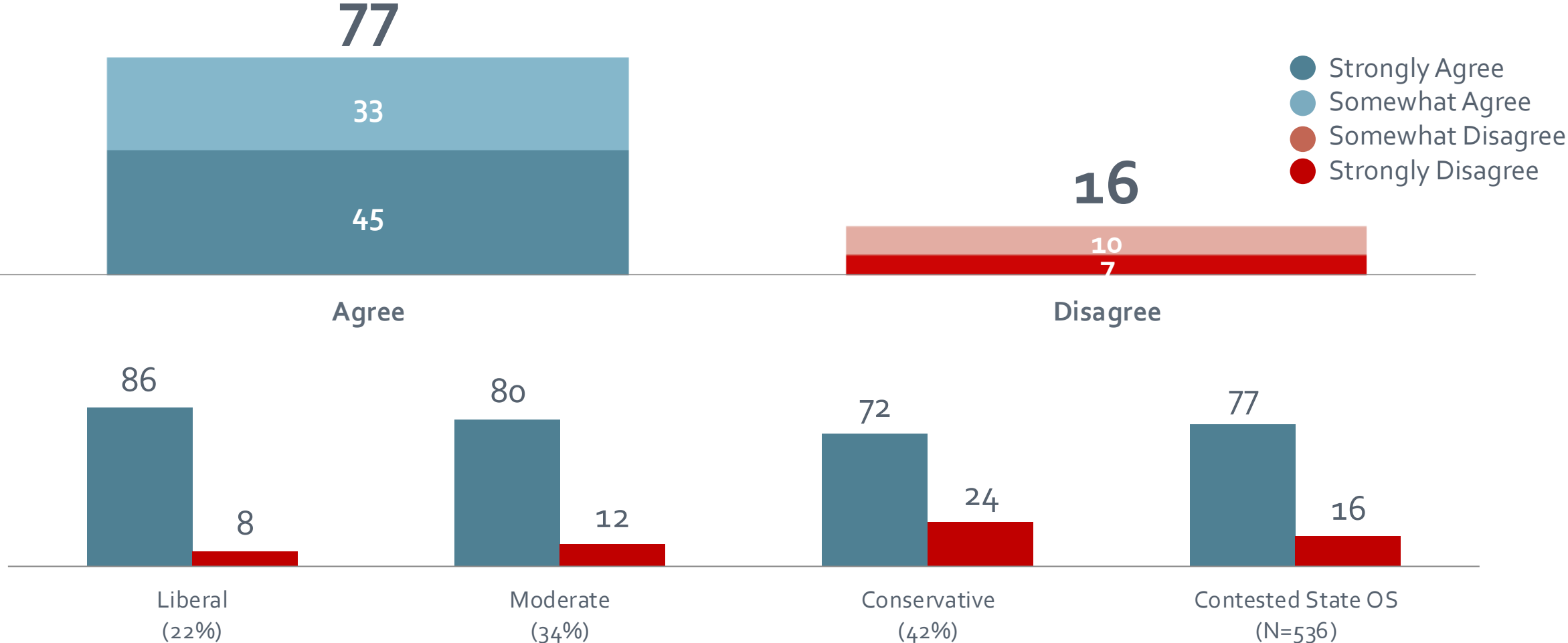
CONTINUING RESOLUTION VOTE

Do you want your Senator or Congressman to vote for a Continuing Resolution to keep the government open?



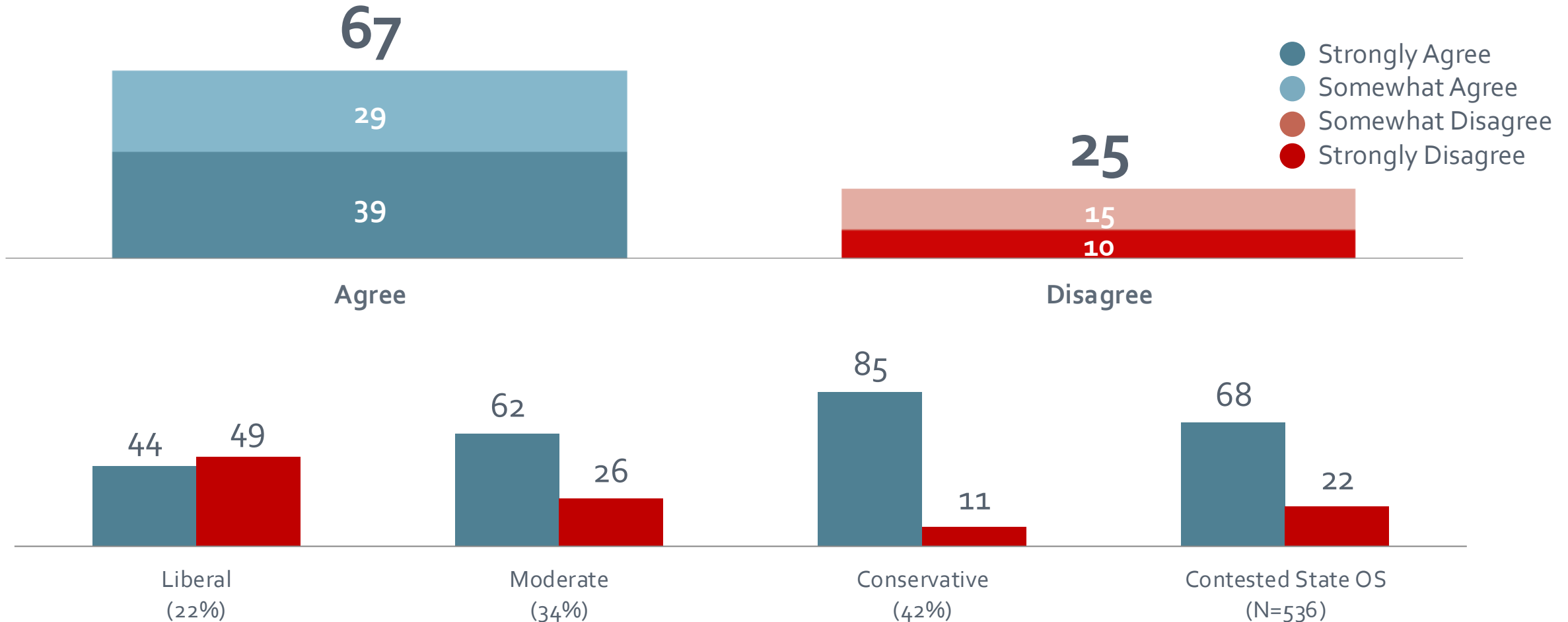

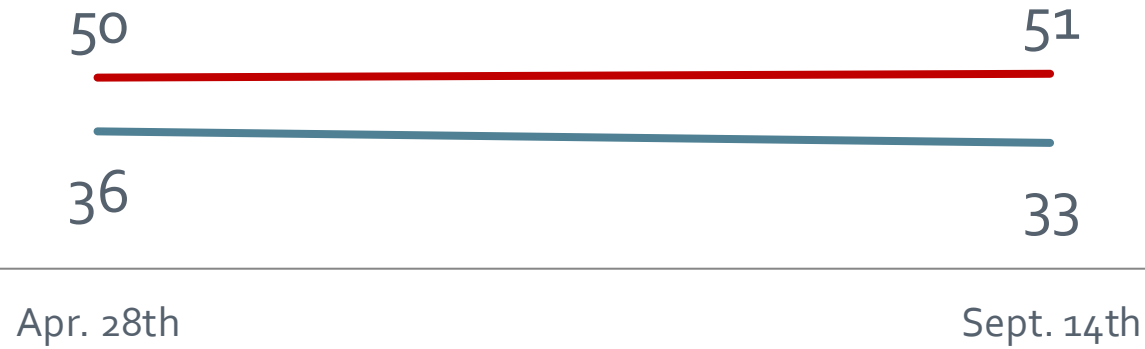

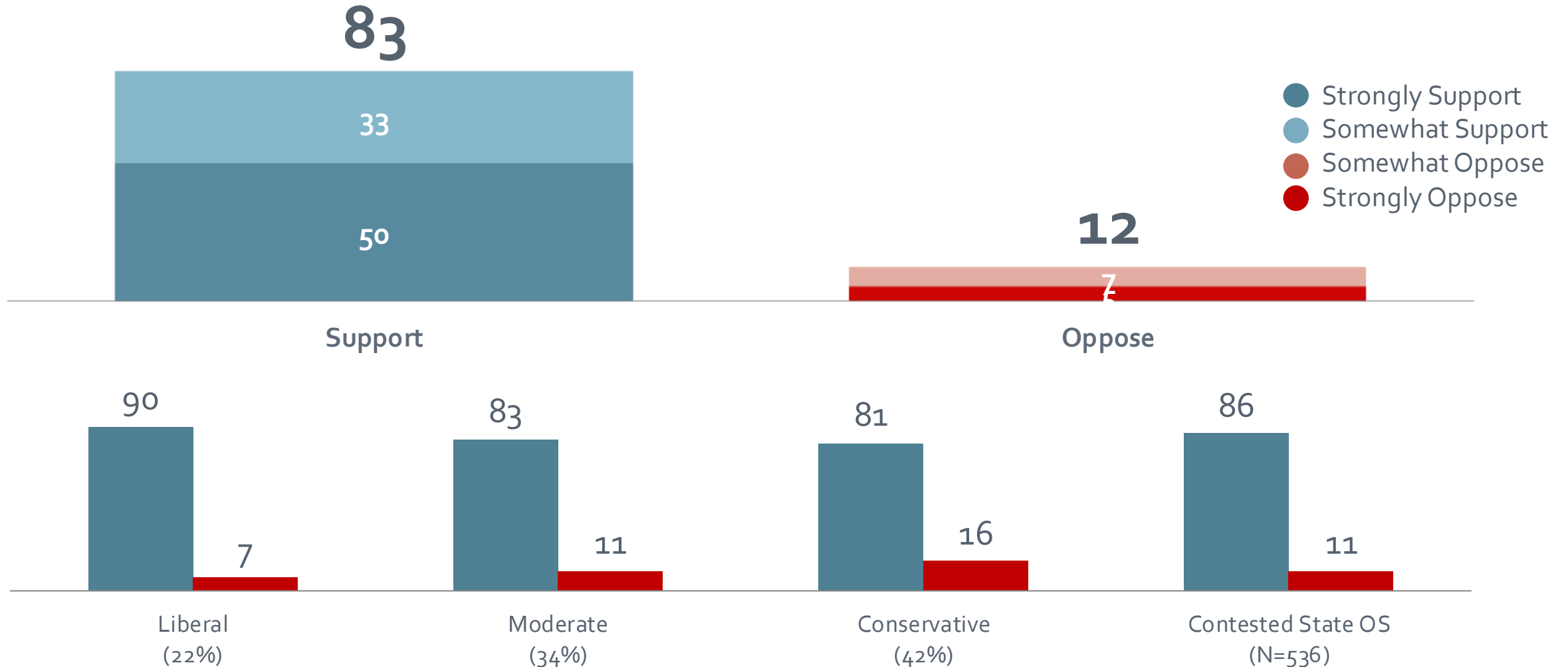
SEPARATE REQUESTS

NATURAL DISASTER FUNDING

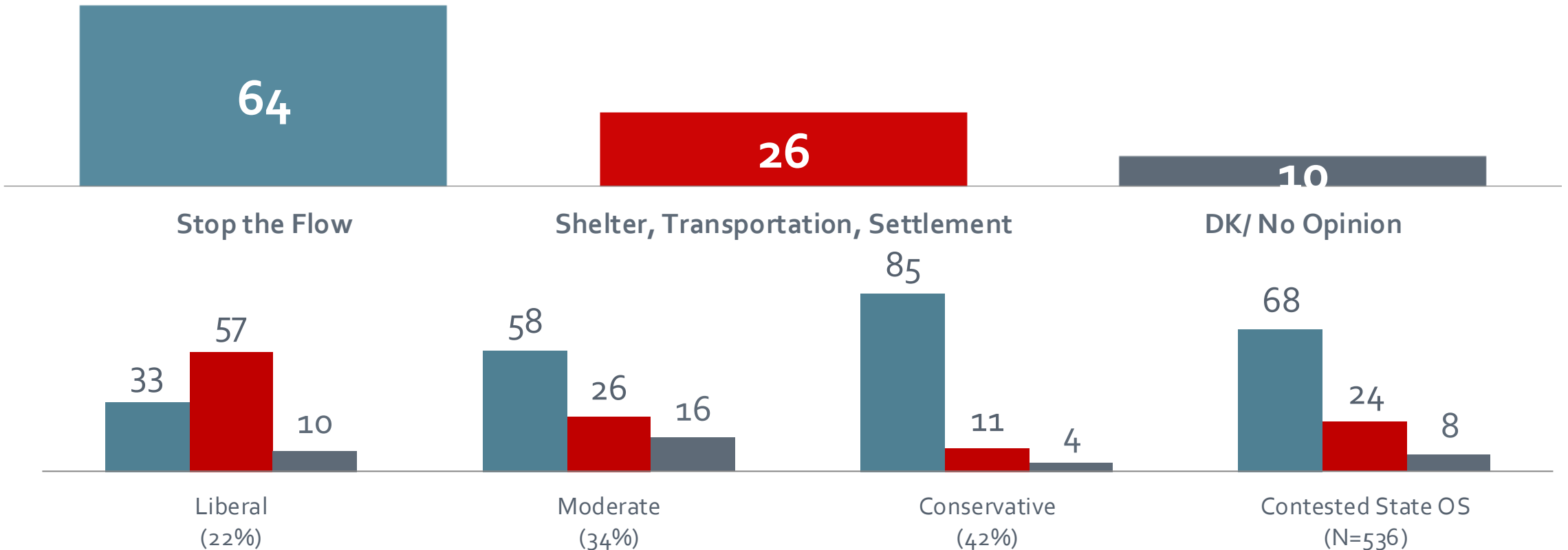
Do you support or oppose the request for \$16 billion of aid for natural disaster relief to help address severe hurricanes, flooding, and wildfire damage?

Others say that funding should focus on providing shelter, transportation, and settlement for migrants.

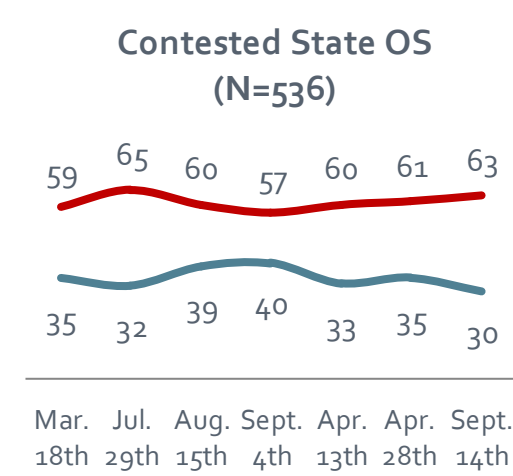
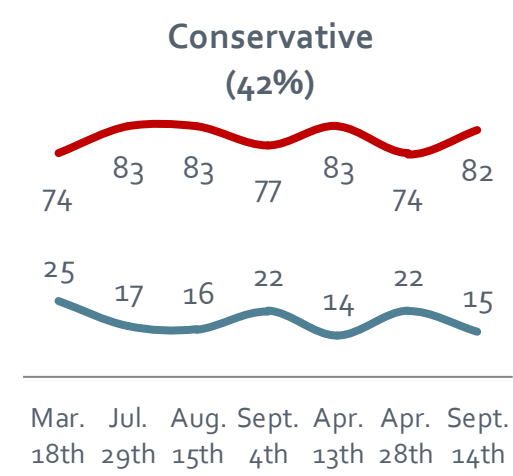
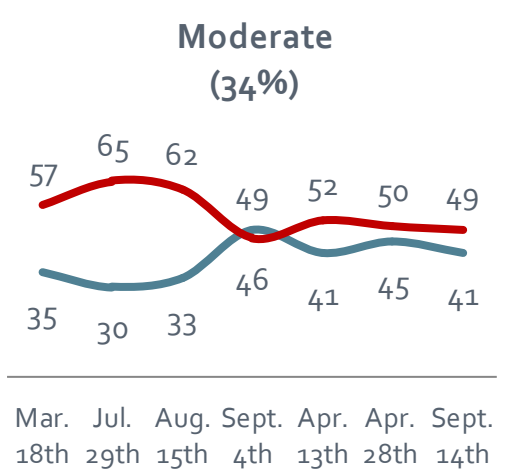
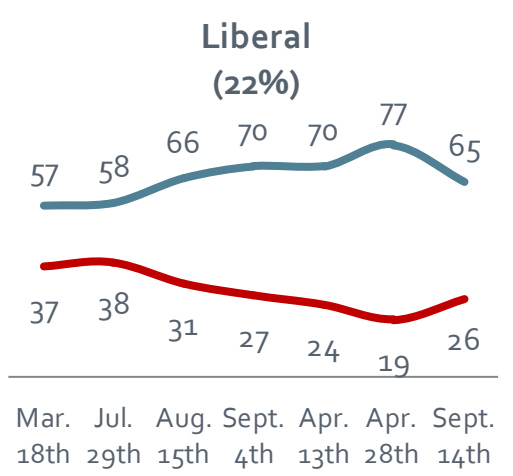
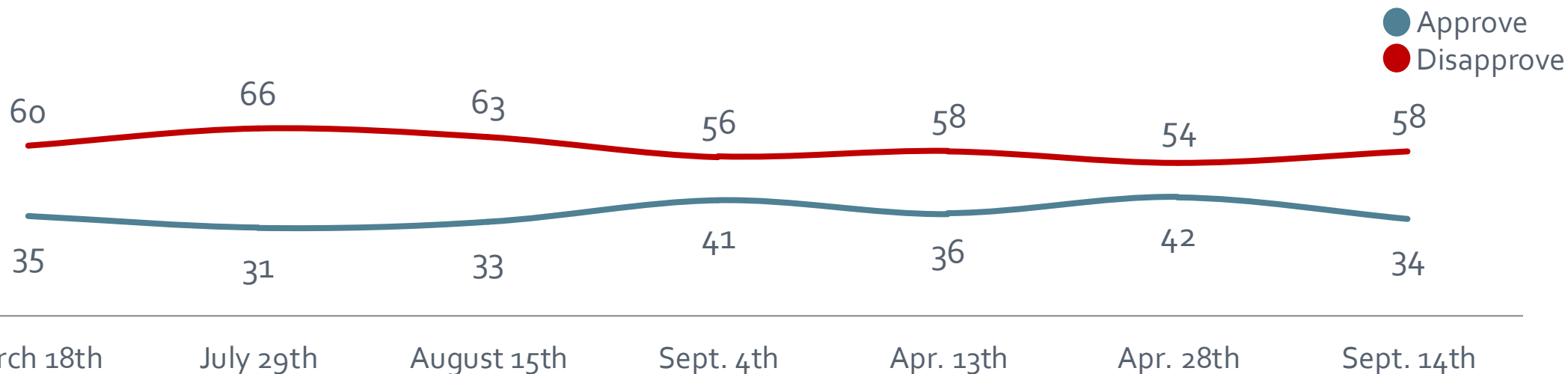

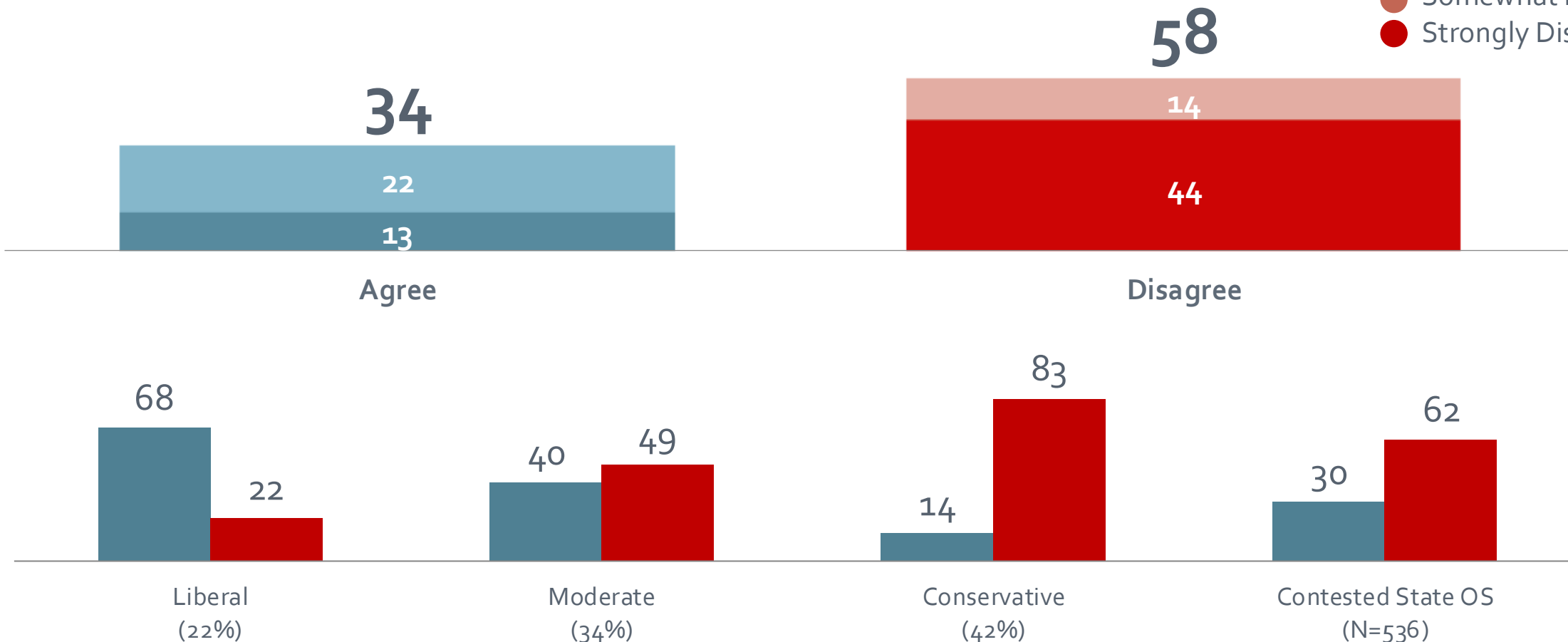
Thinking about the job that President Biden has done **with regard to Inflation**, how would you say you approve or disapprove of the job he has done?

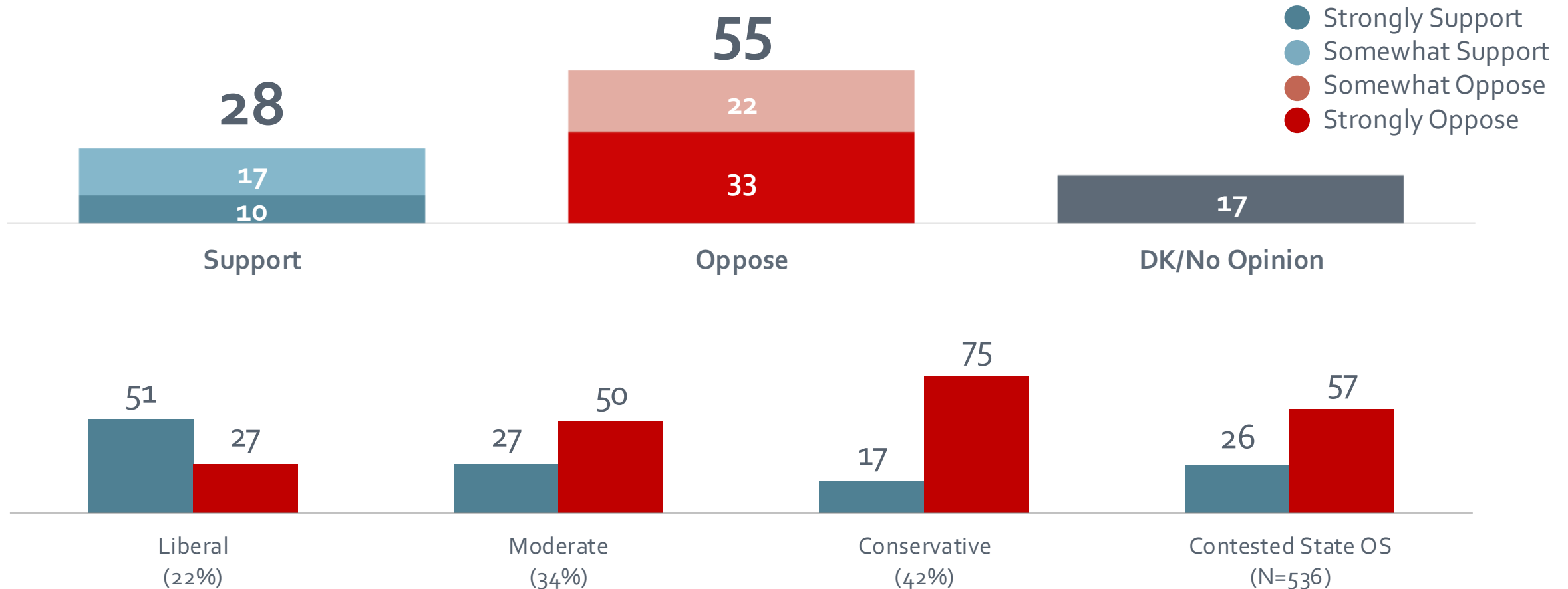




IRAN PRISONER SWAP

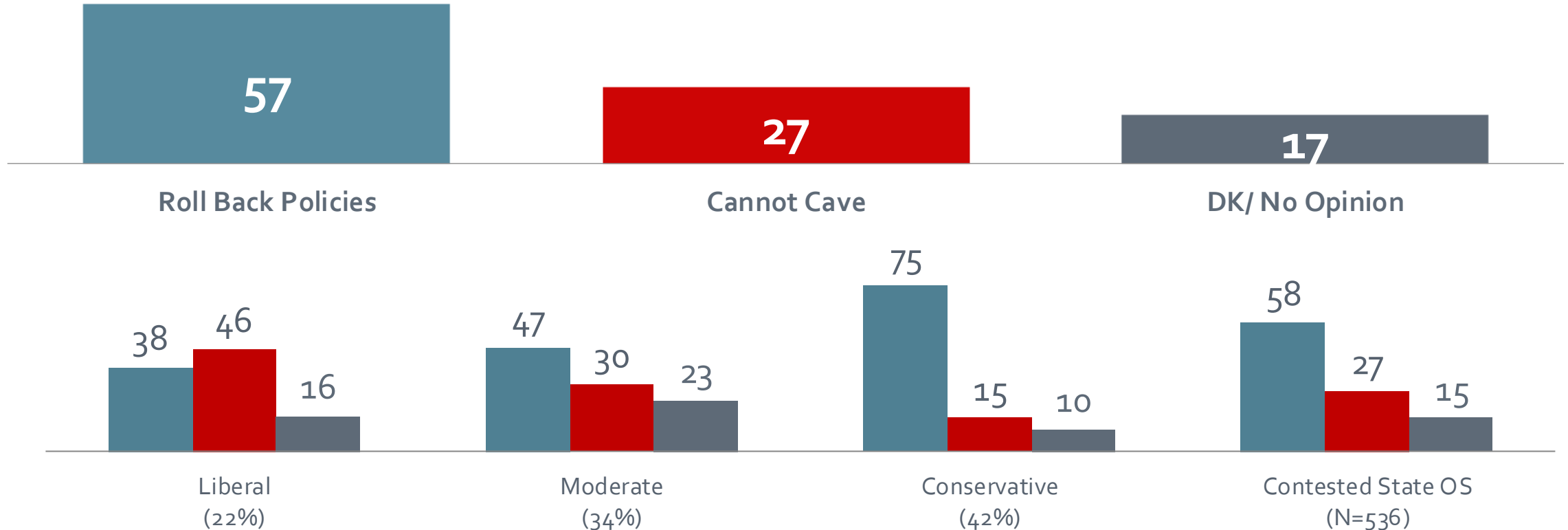


AUTO STRIKE
