Other say a Continuing Resolution just keeps the status quo. Congress should oppose a Continuing Resolution and let the government shut down until they get their work done.



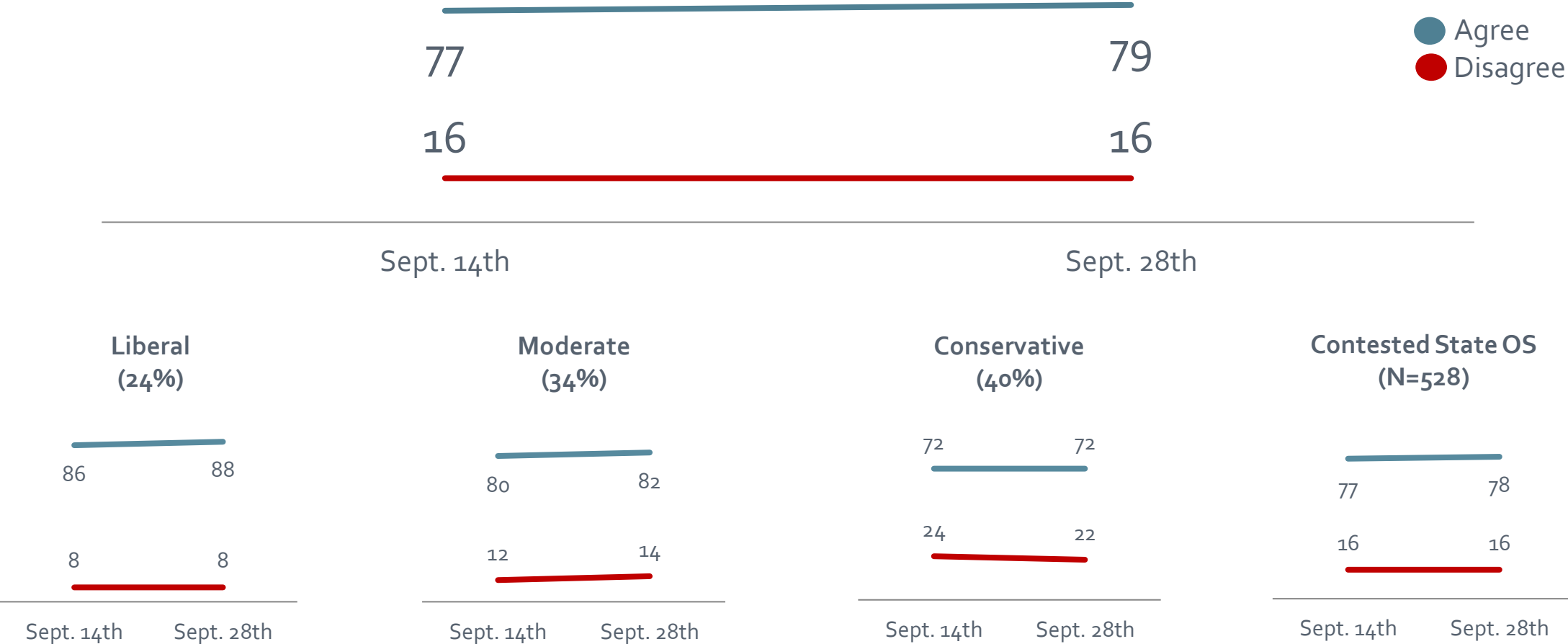
CONTINUING RESOLUTION VOTE

Do you want your Senator or Congressman to vote for a Continuing Resolution to keep the government open?



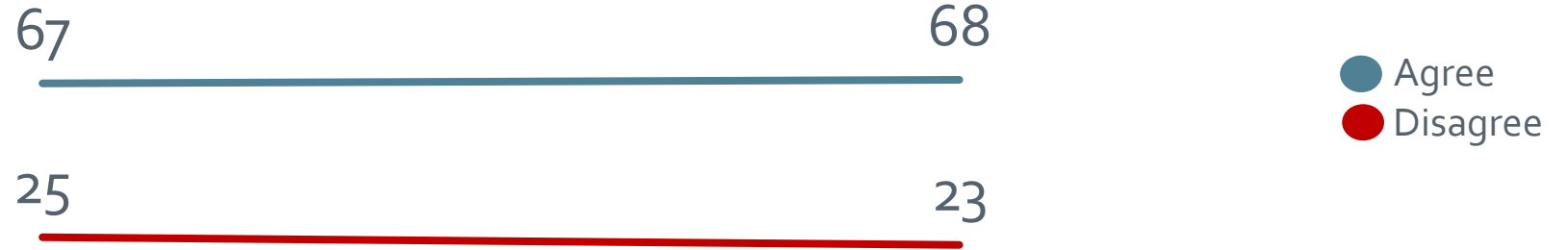
SHUTDOWN OFF THE TABLE

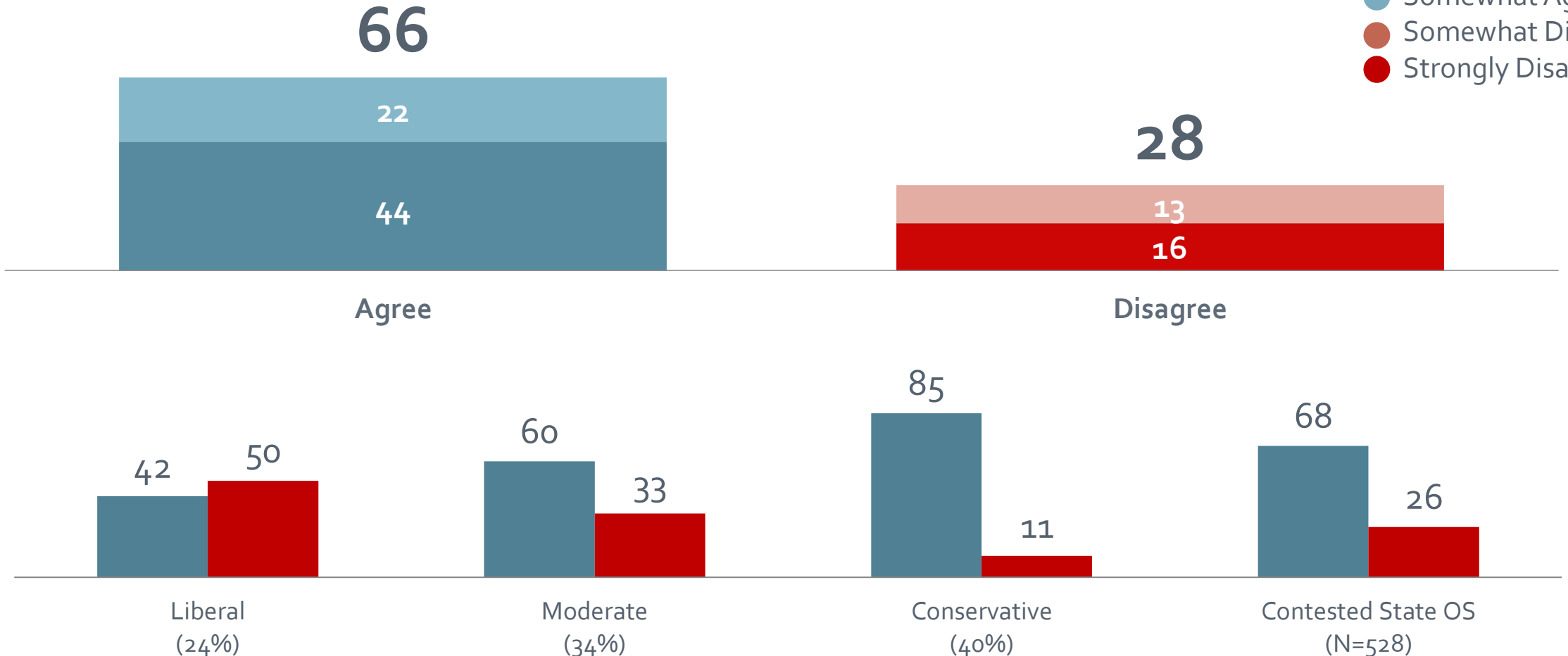

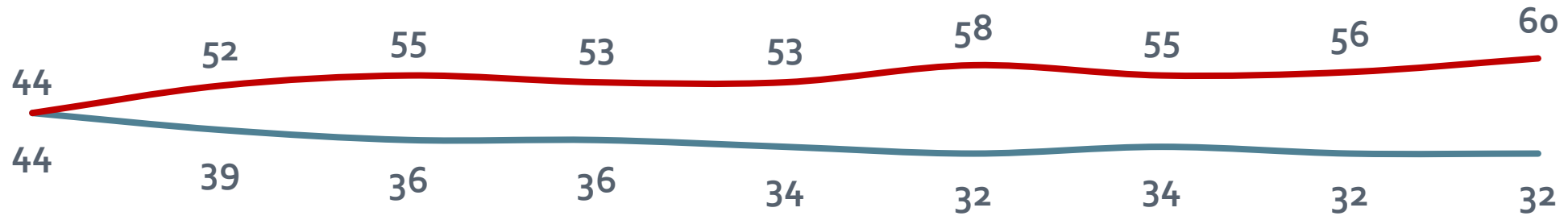

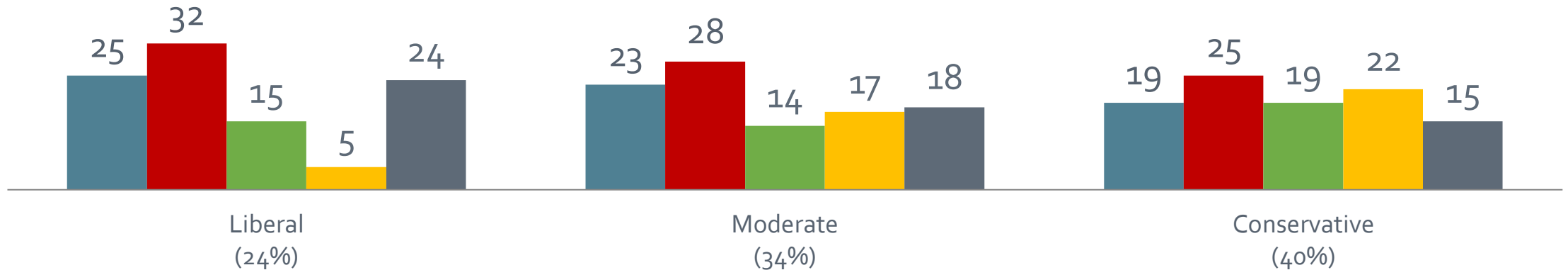
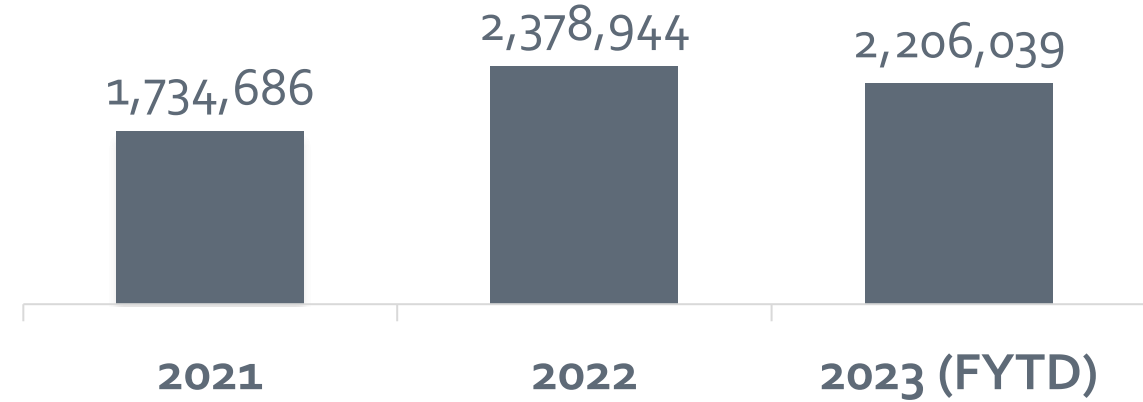
Thinking about illegal immigration at our southern border, who do you blame most?



How many border crossings by illegal immigrants do you believe occur each year?



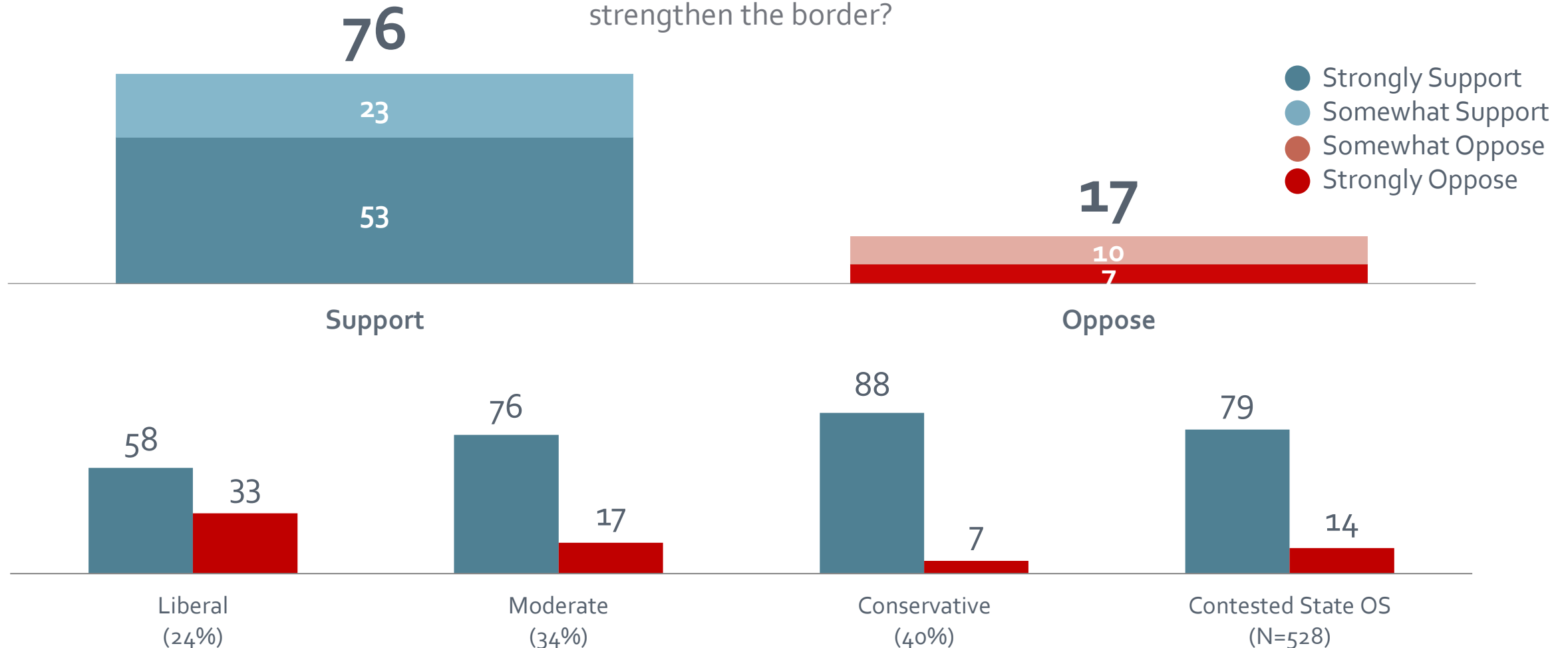

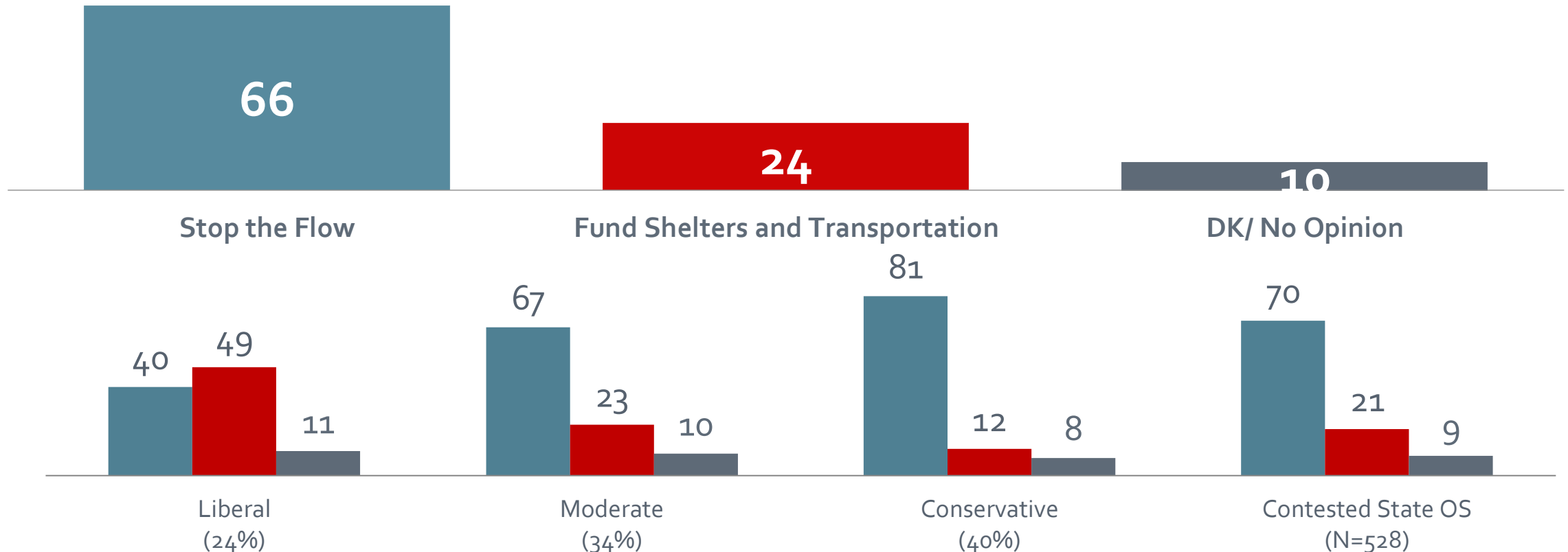
strengthen the border?

Others say that that the federal government should help our cities by significantly increasing funding for infrastructure like shelters and transportation for illegal immigrants.

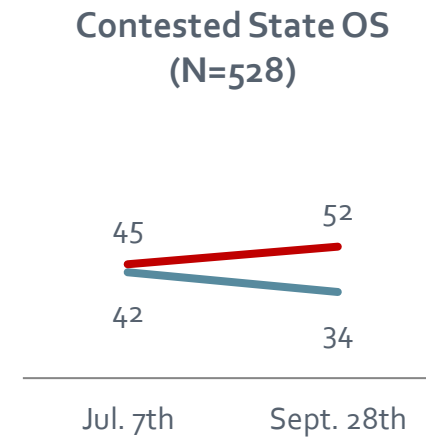
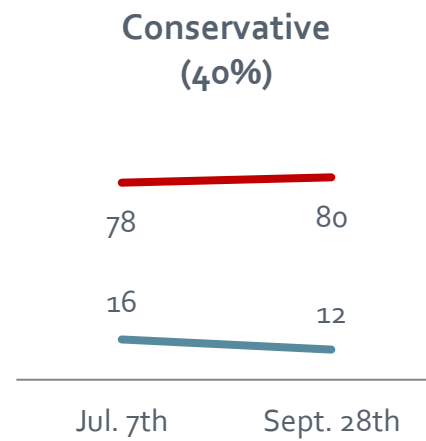
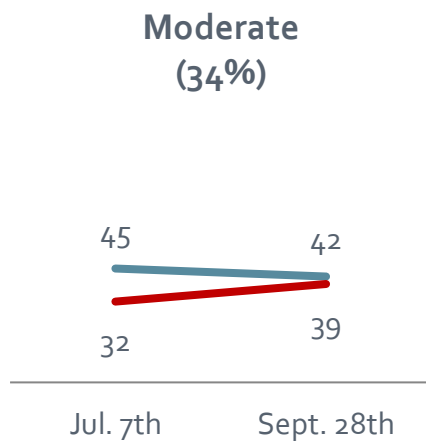
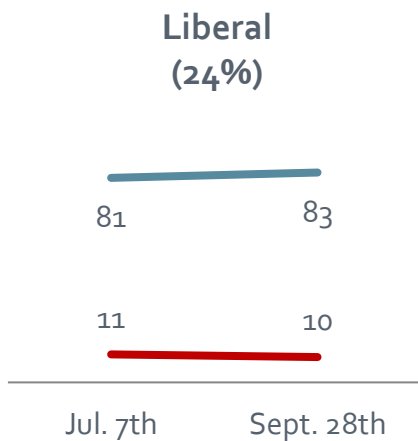
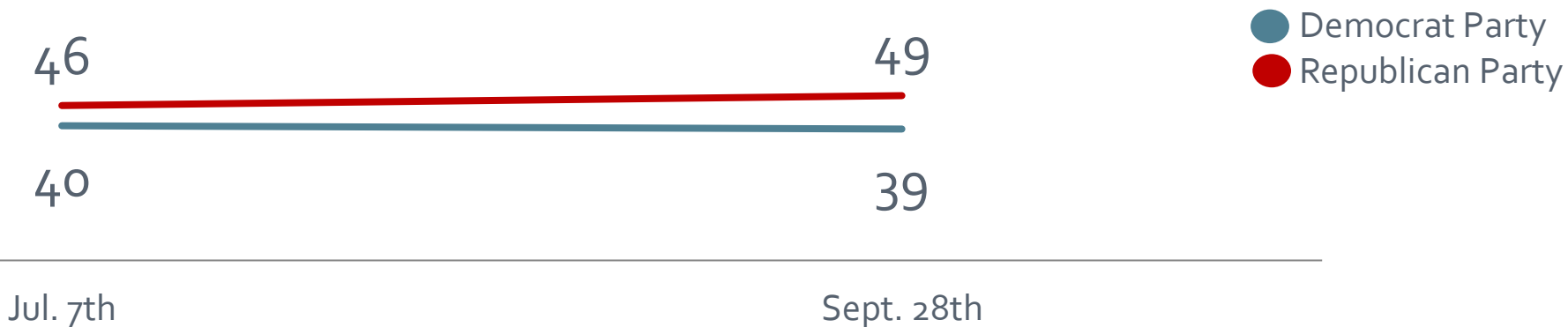

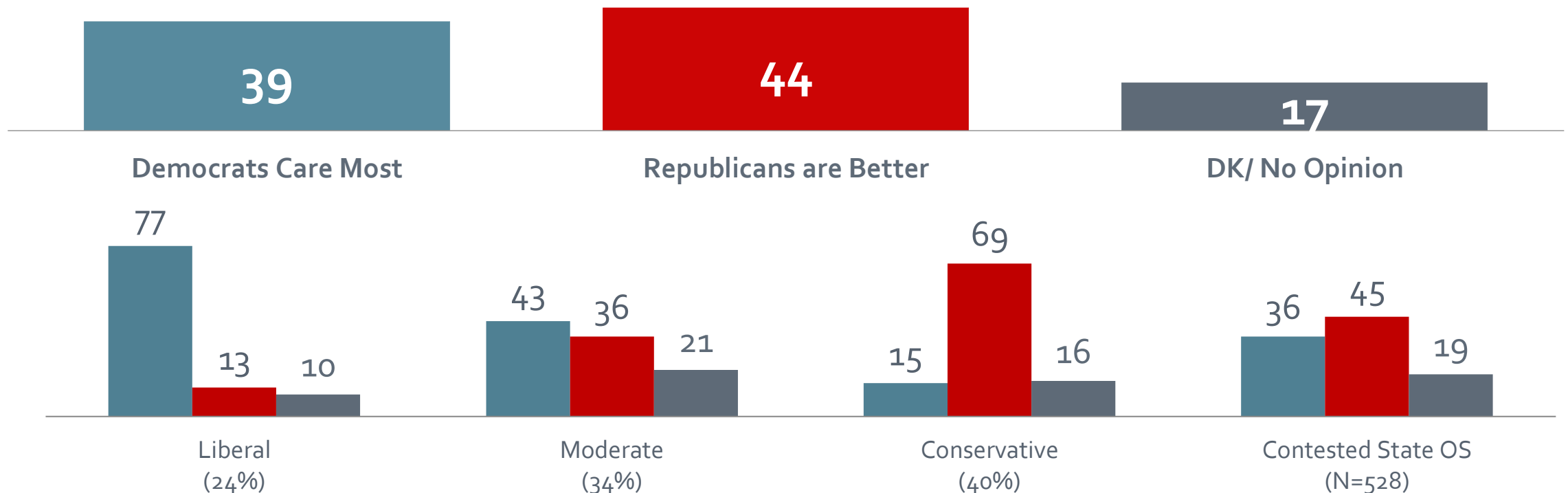
Which major political party do you think does a better job of fighting for working Americans?
