



#### **ASYLUM CONCERNS**


How concerned are you by the number of asylum seekers both in our country and waiting to be processed?




# BORDER POLICY

Others say that we should focus on better funding for our processing of migrants and asylum seekers so that there is less strain on our infrastructure and a smoother process for entering the country.


