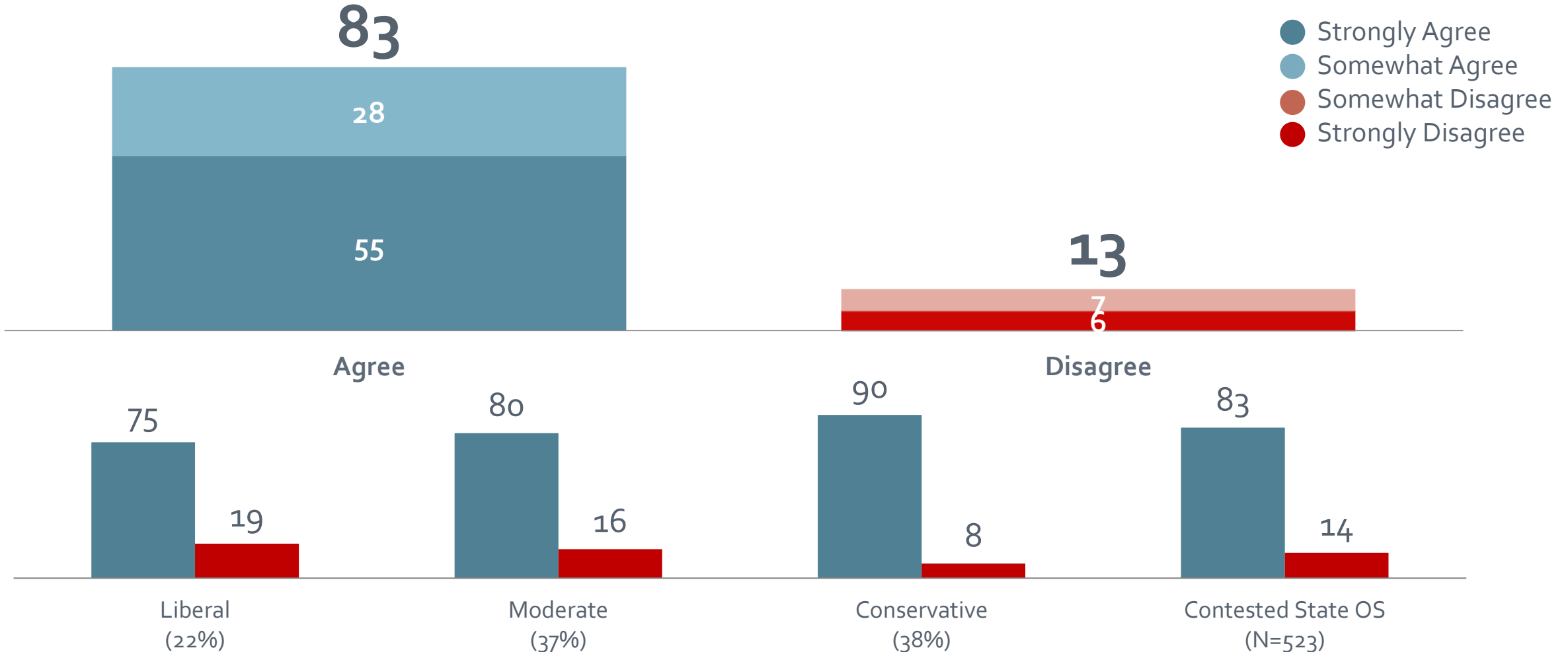

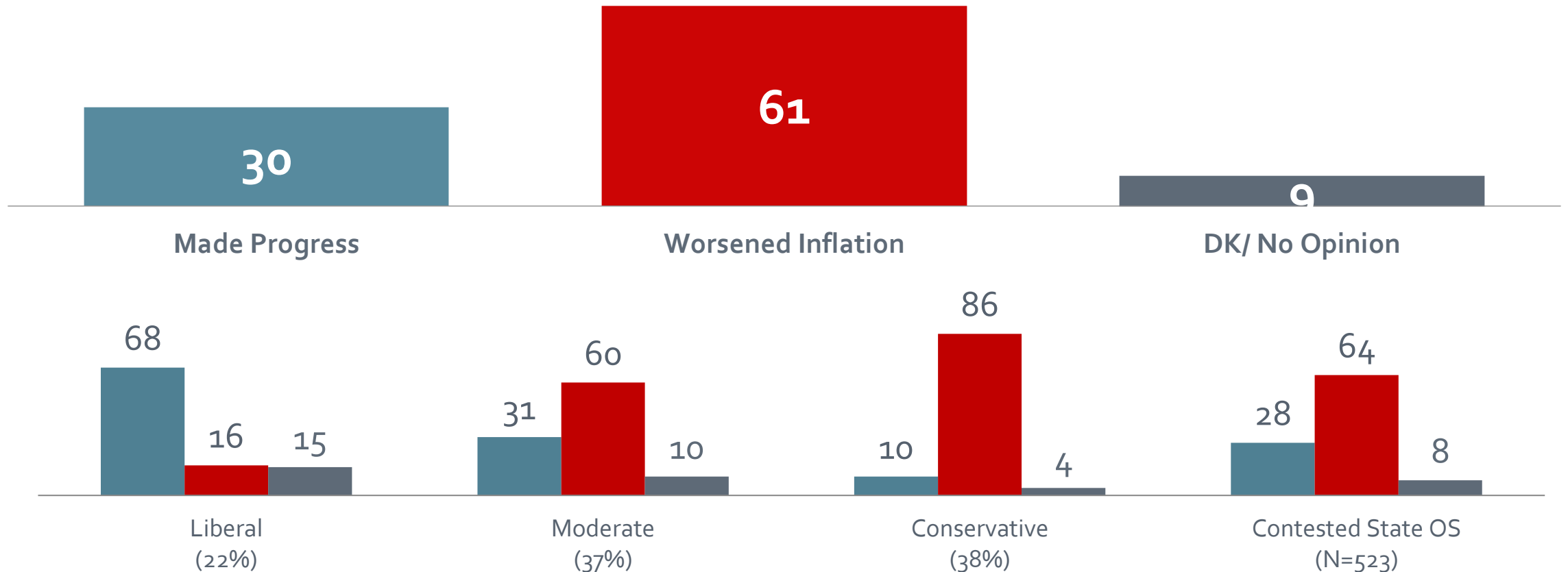

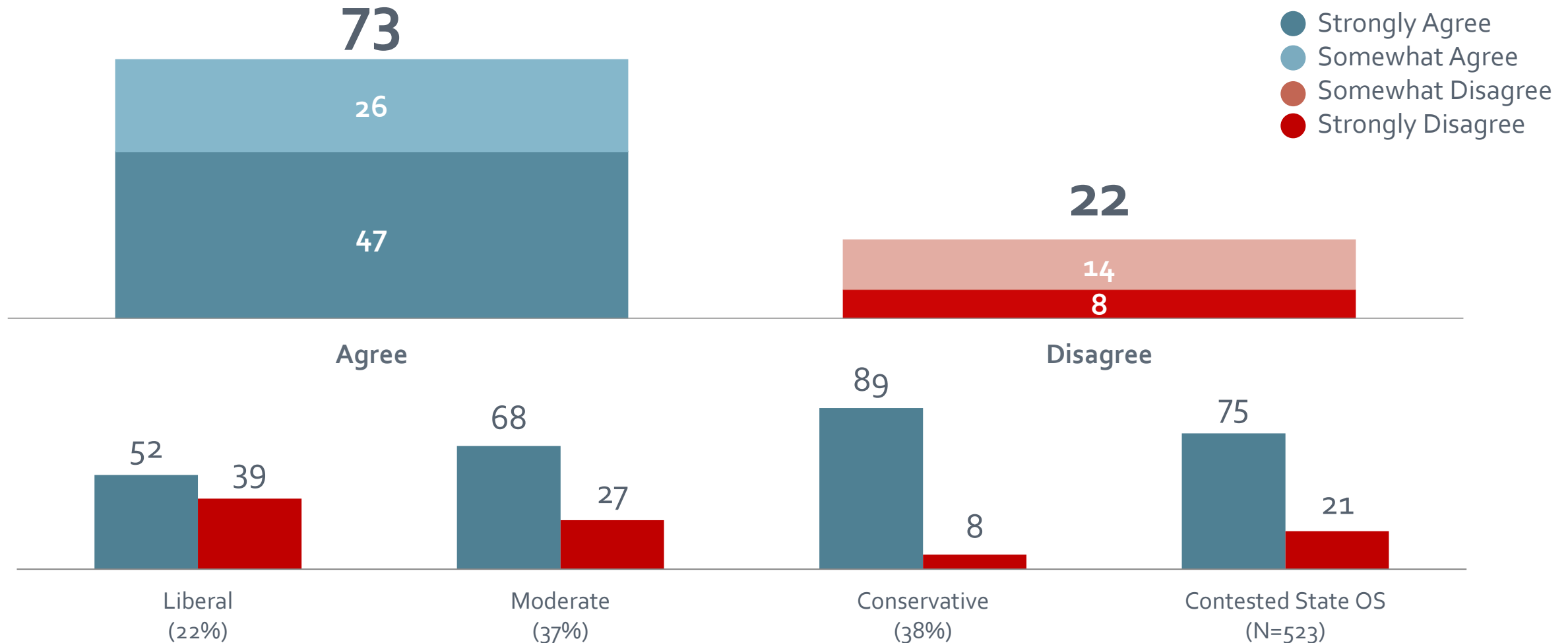

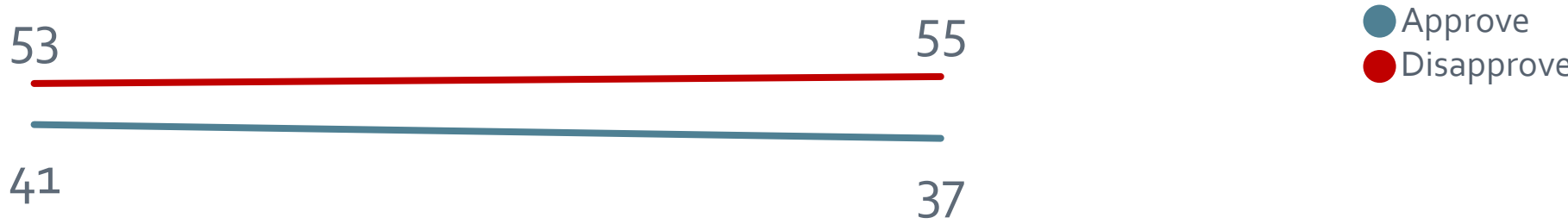

American voters have the right to vote for whoever they want. The attempts to take Trump off the ballot with legal action are the real threats to democracy.





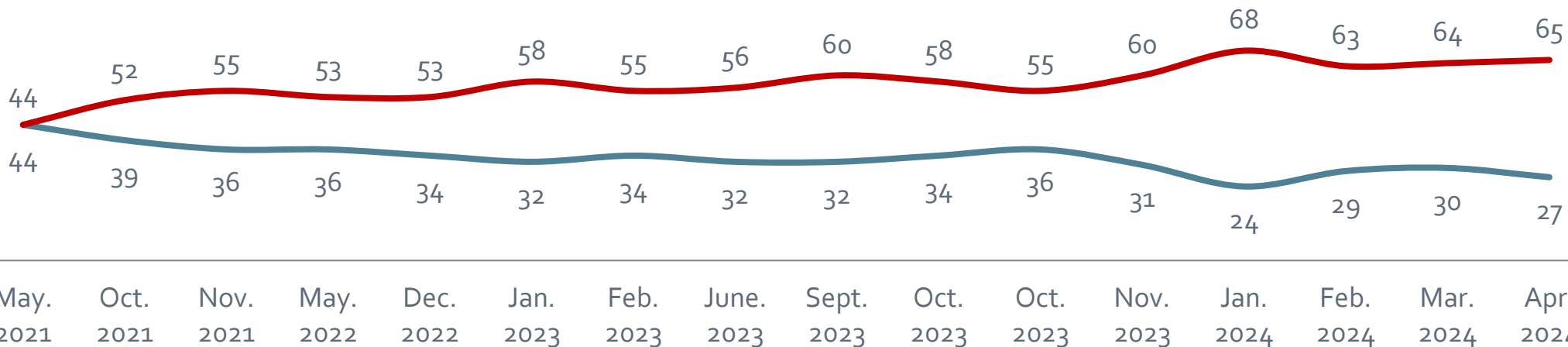

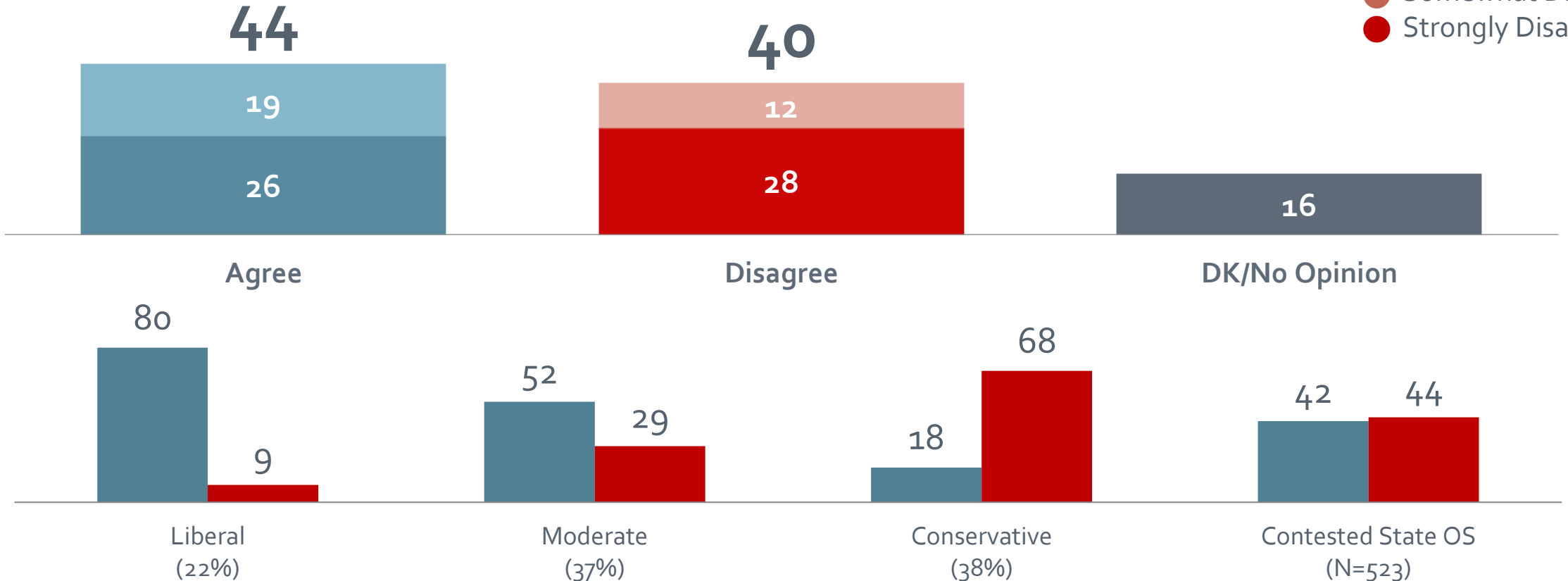

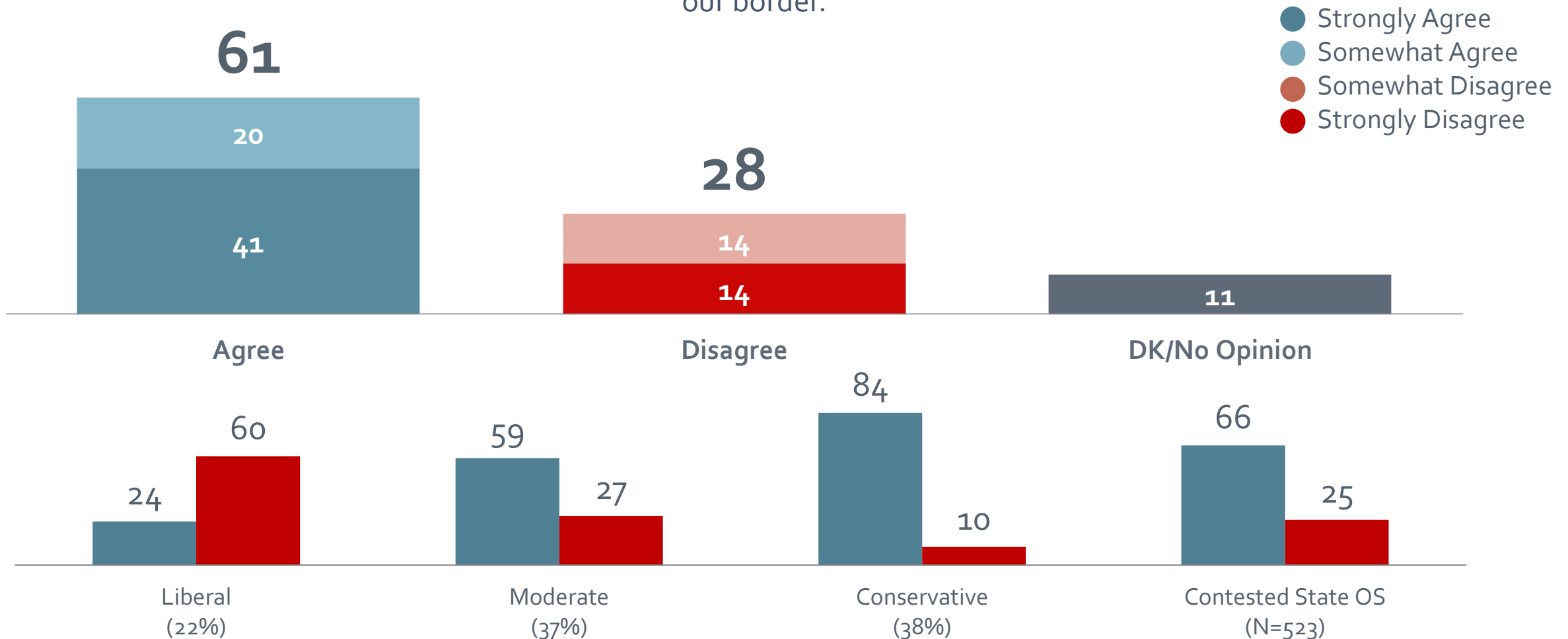
