

## No, Pete Buttigieg is not doing a good job.

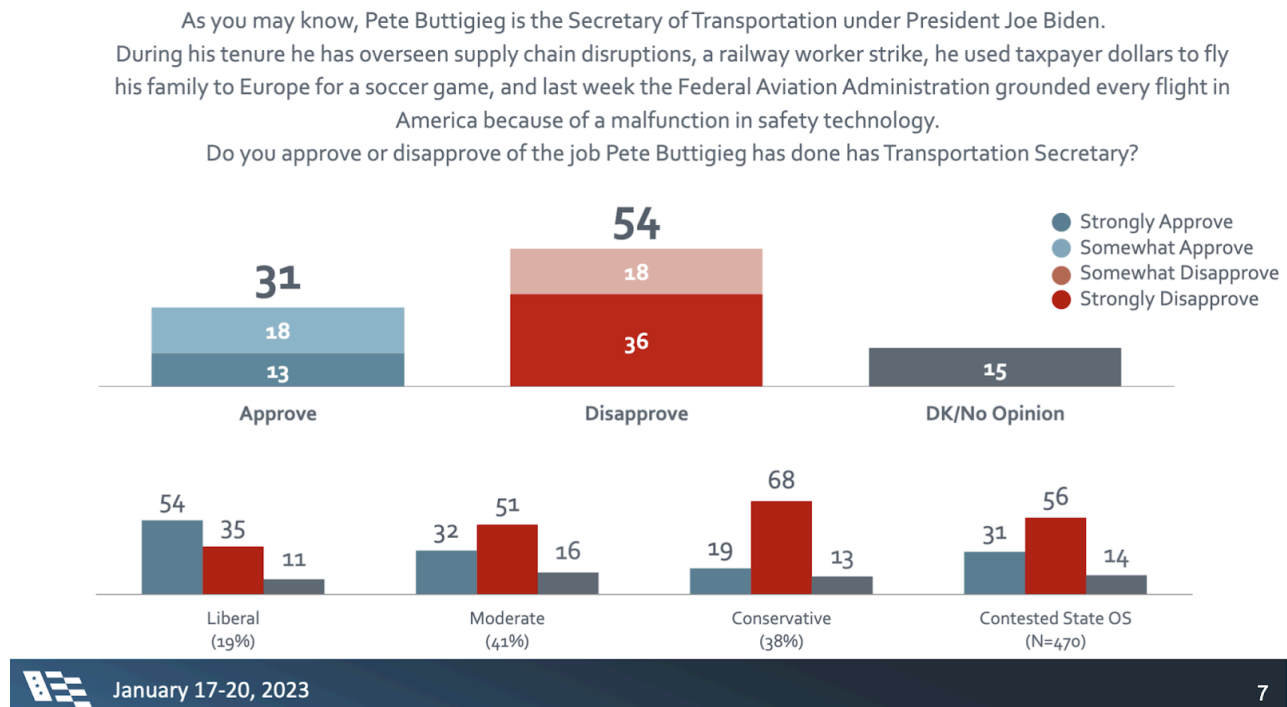
New York Magazine wondered in a recent story, "Is Pete Buttigieg Doing a Good Job?"

Even before the recent airline disasters and airport debacles, Buttigieg's job performance has been viewed unfavorably by the country.

Early last year, a SOF survey found he was viewed unfavorably by 36 percent (and favorably by 29 percent) with moderates split 32/32.

Moreover, 54 percent disapproved of his job performance, with a majority of moderates giving him a failing grade.
