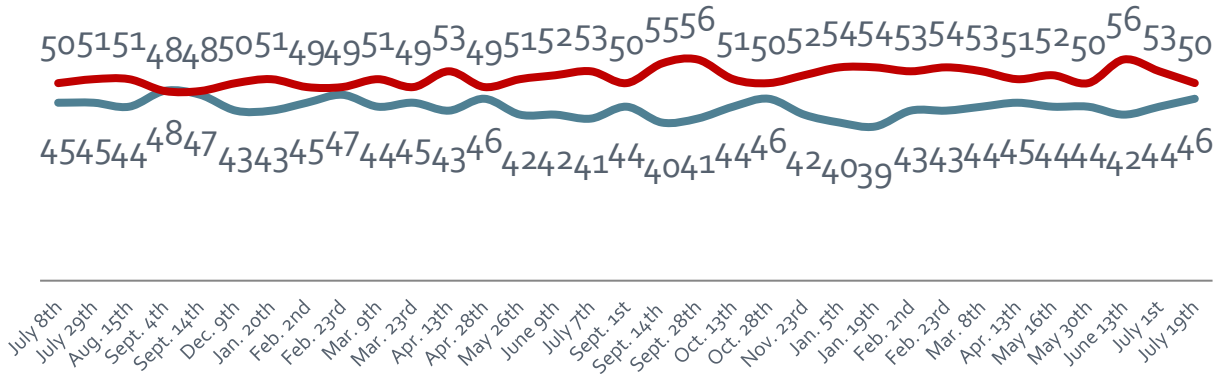

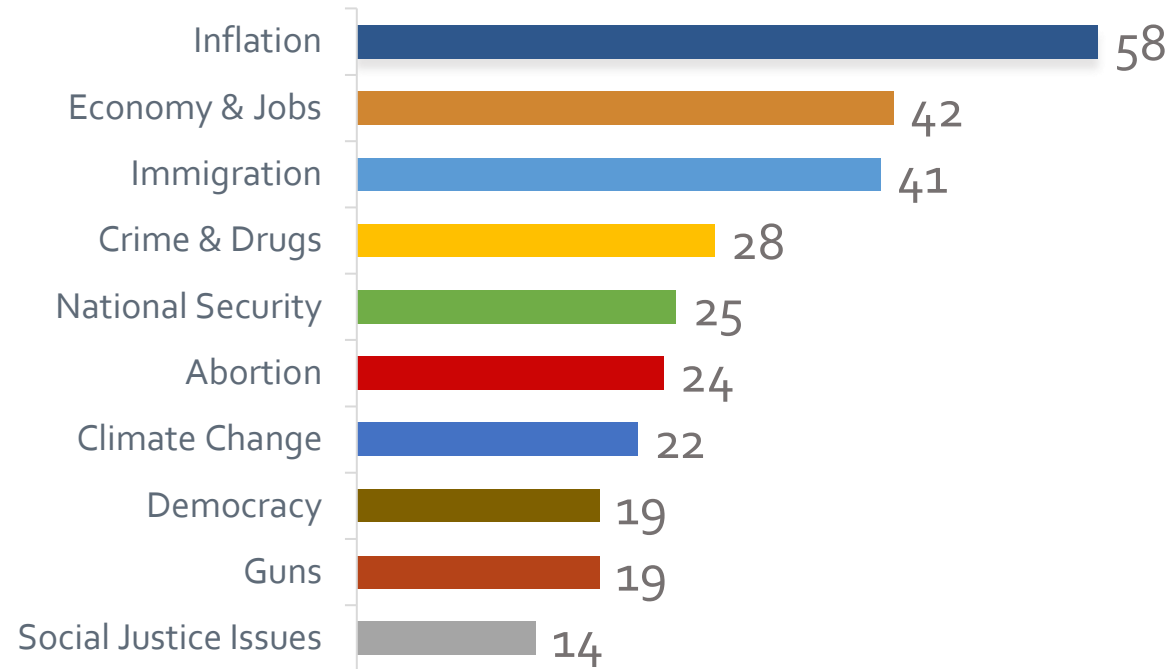

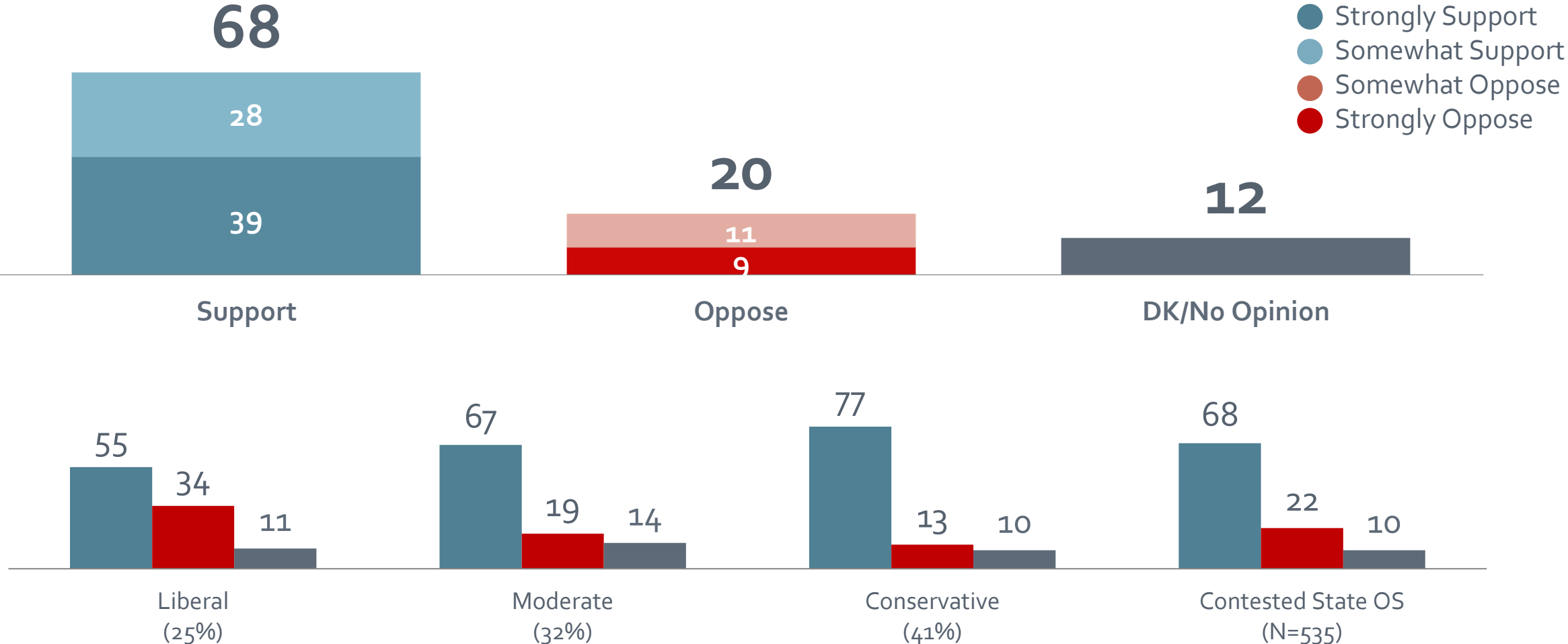

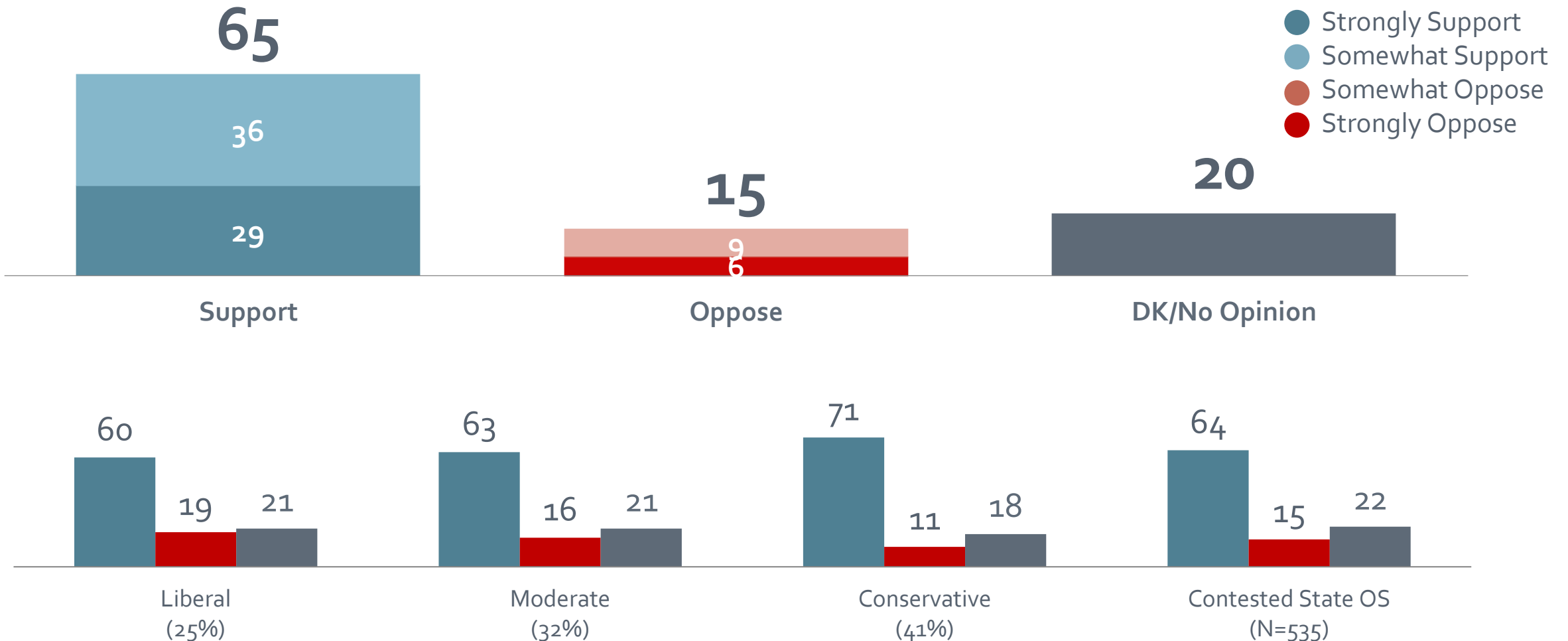
# SUPPORT FOR SCHOOL CHOICE

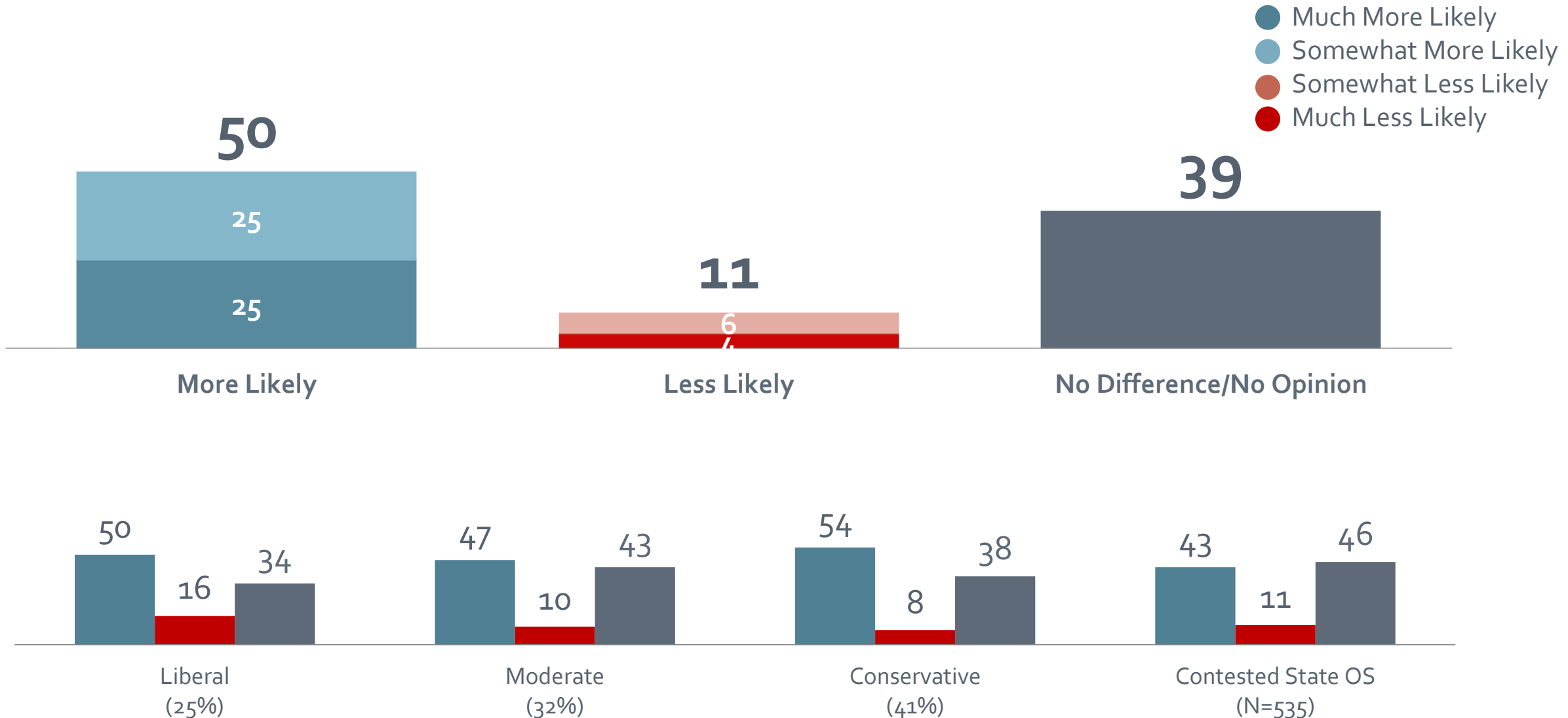
# SUPPORT FOR ECCA
