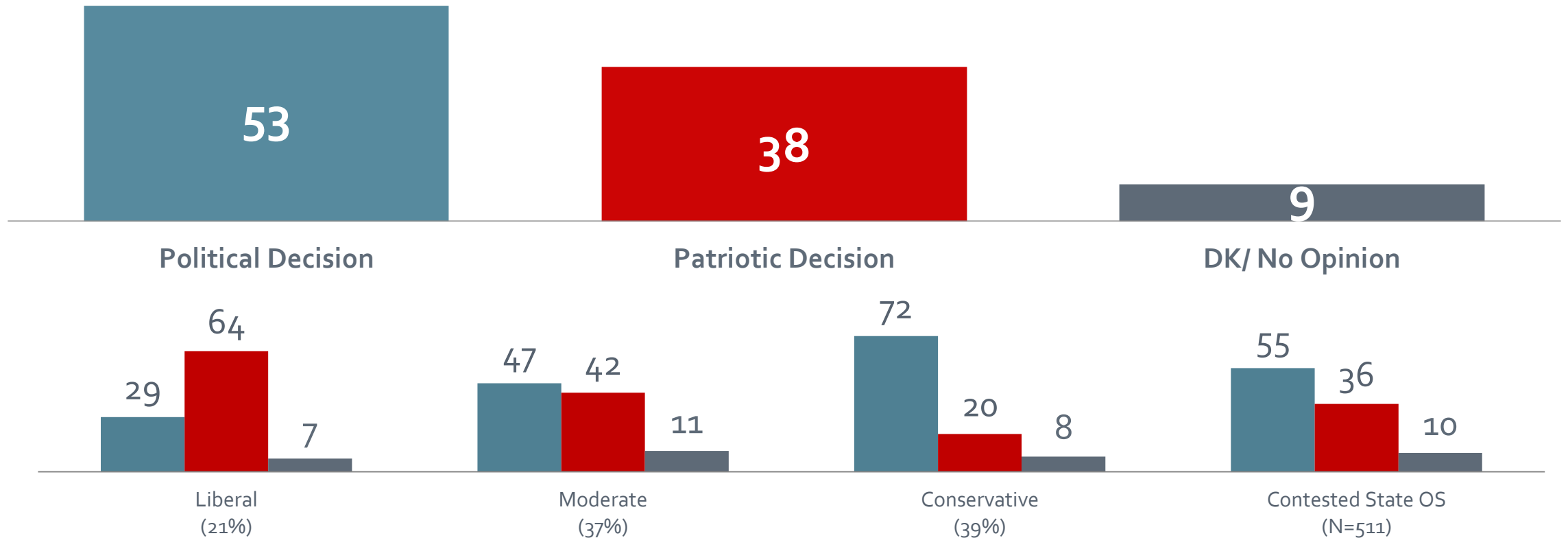


# BIDEN DROPPING OUT

Others say that it was a patriotic decision to step down and let others lead his party.

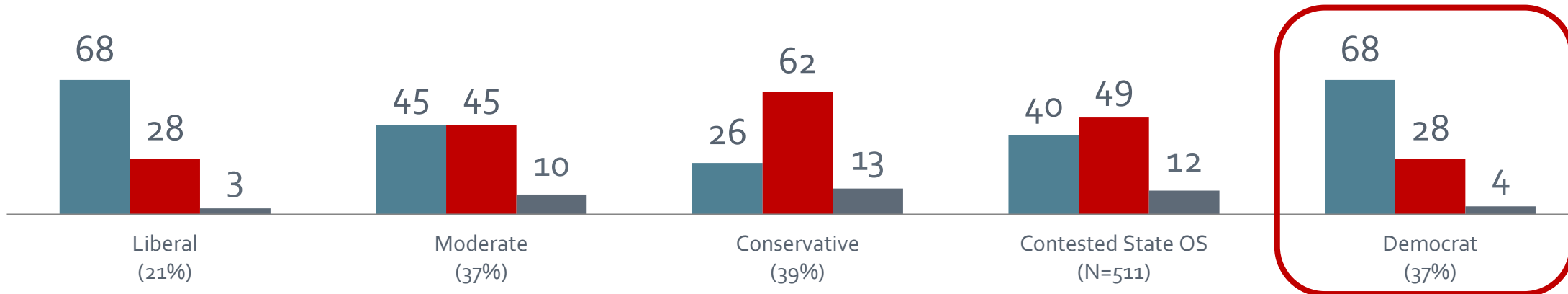
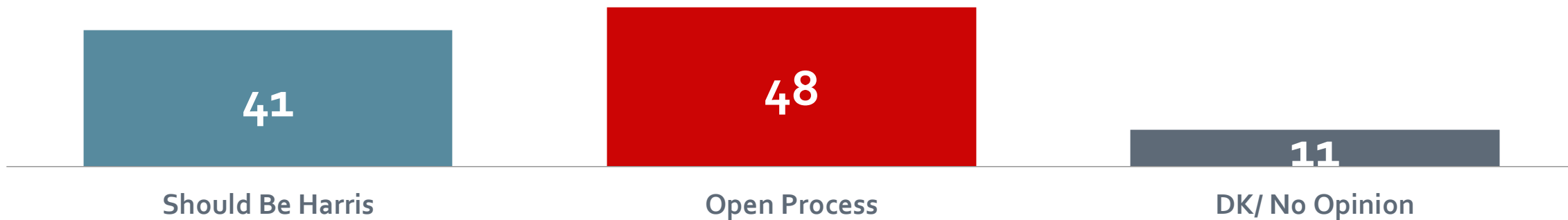




With President Biden stepping out of the race, many are discussing how the Democrat Party should choose its nominee for President. With this in mind, which of the following comes closest to your opinion?

Others say that the Democrat Party should have an open process for choosing its nominee for President, and let other potential candidates make their case.



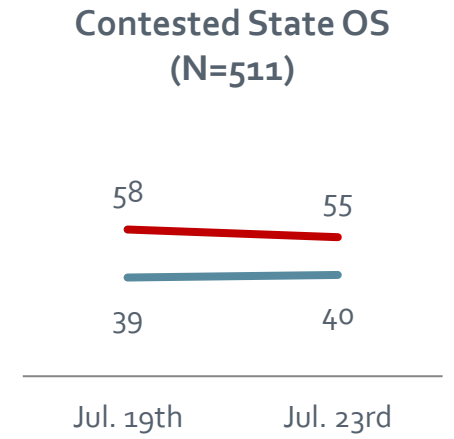
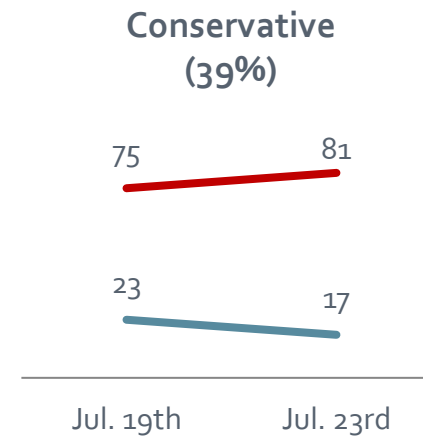
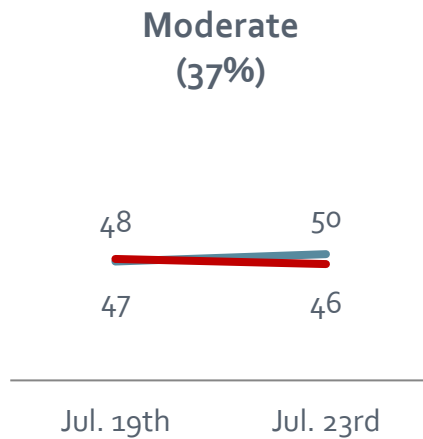
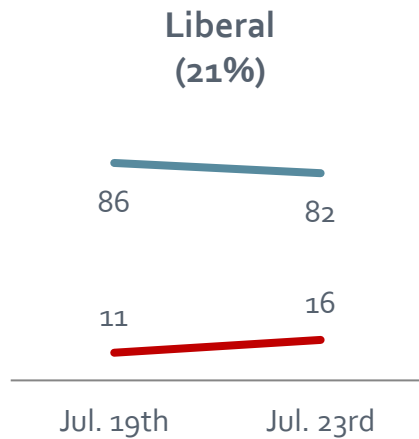
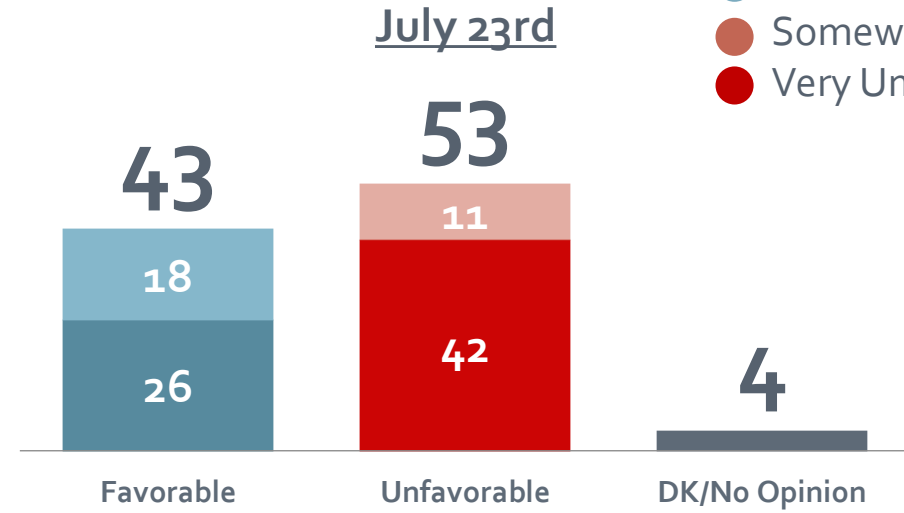
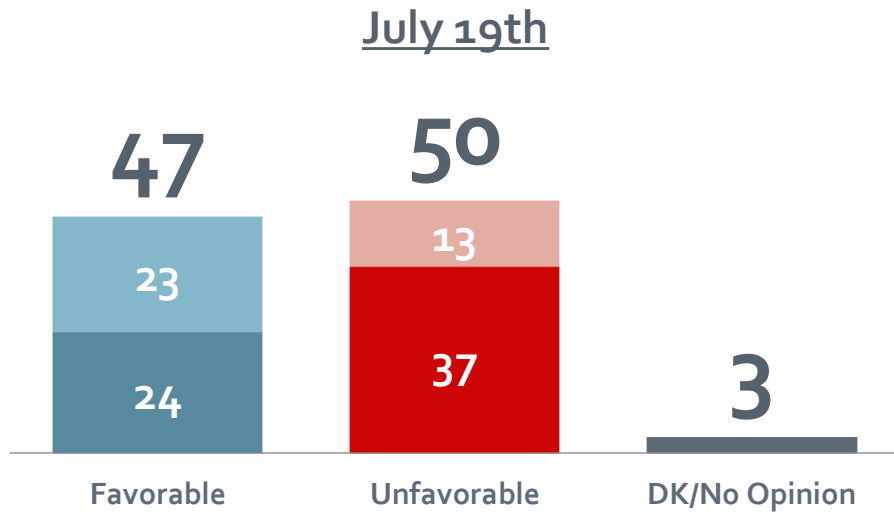

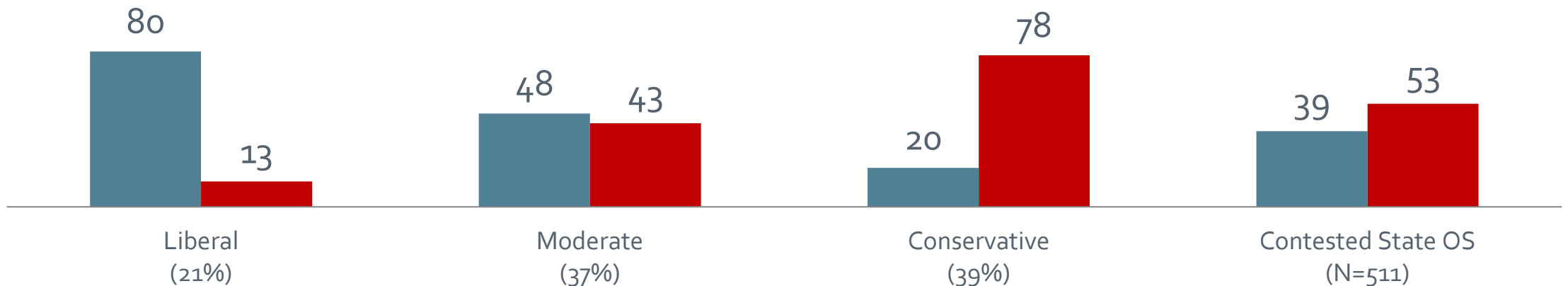

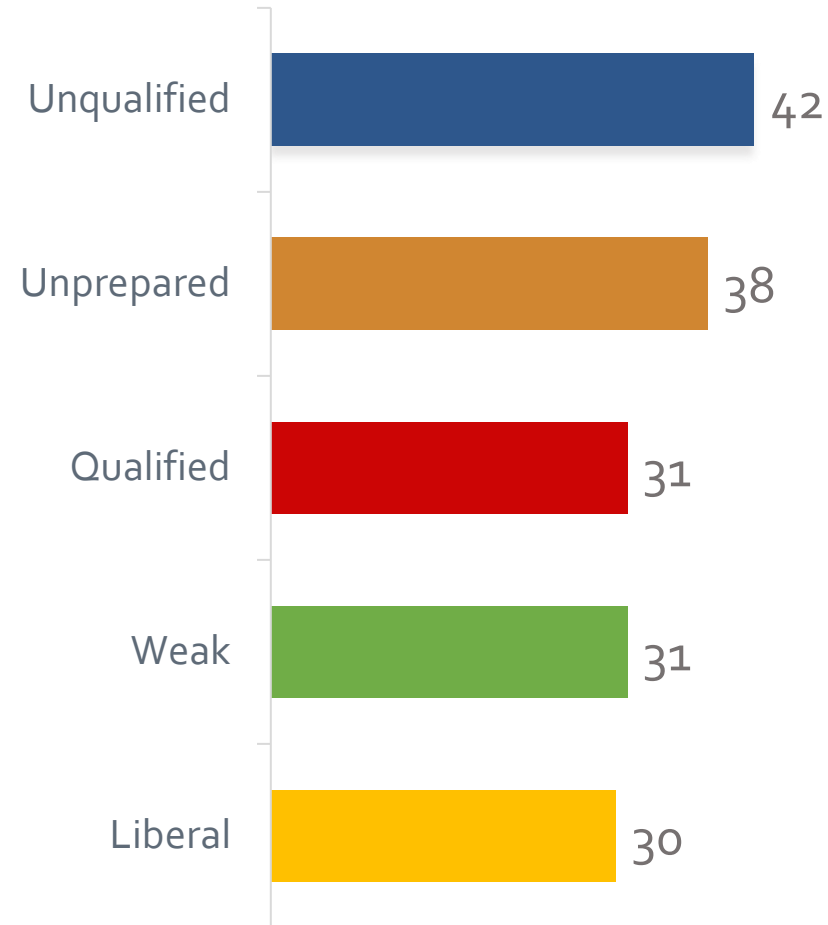

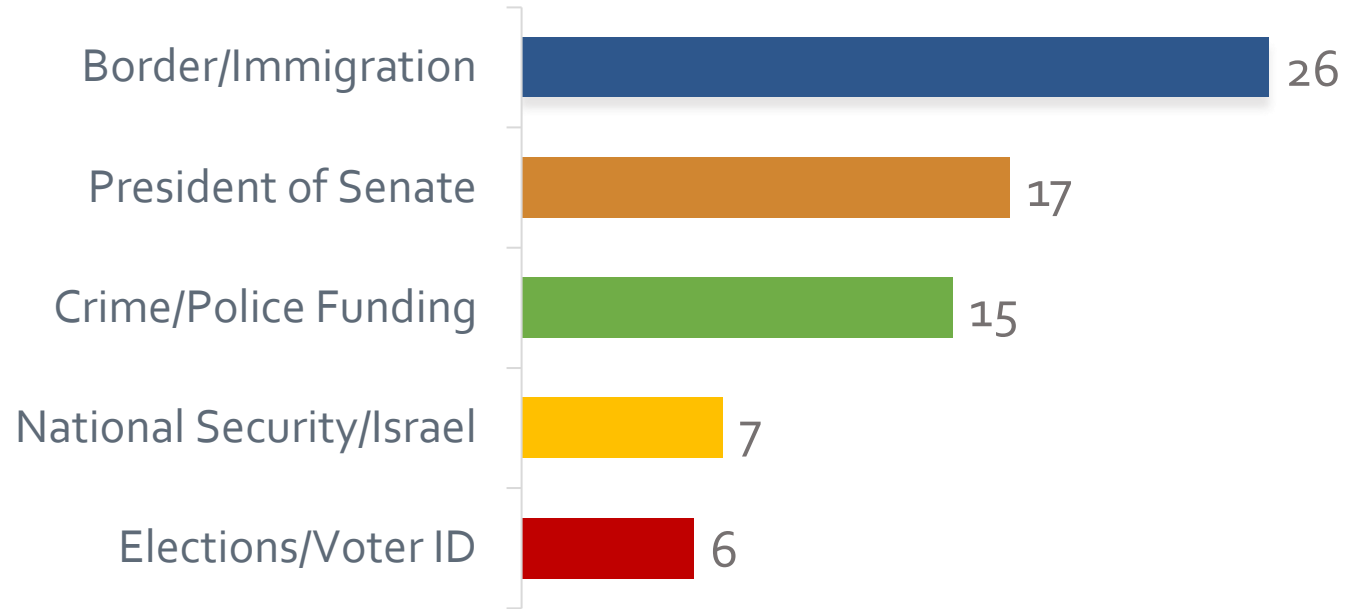

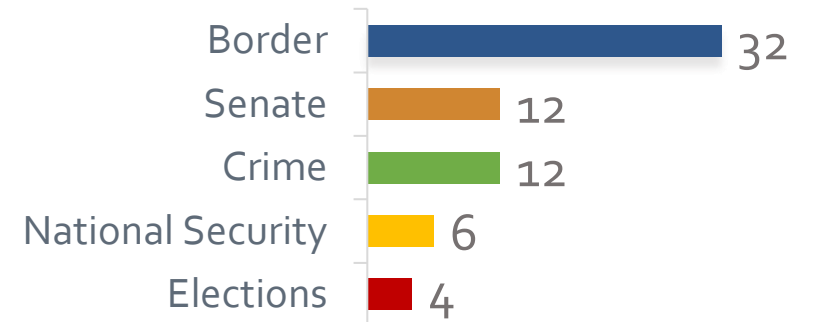

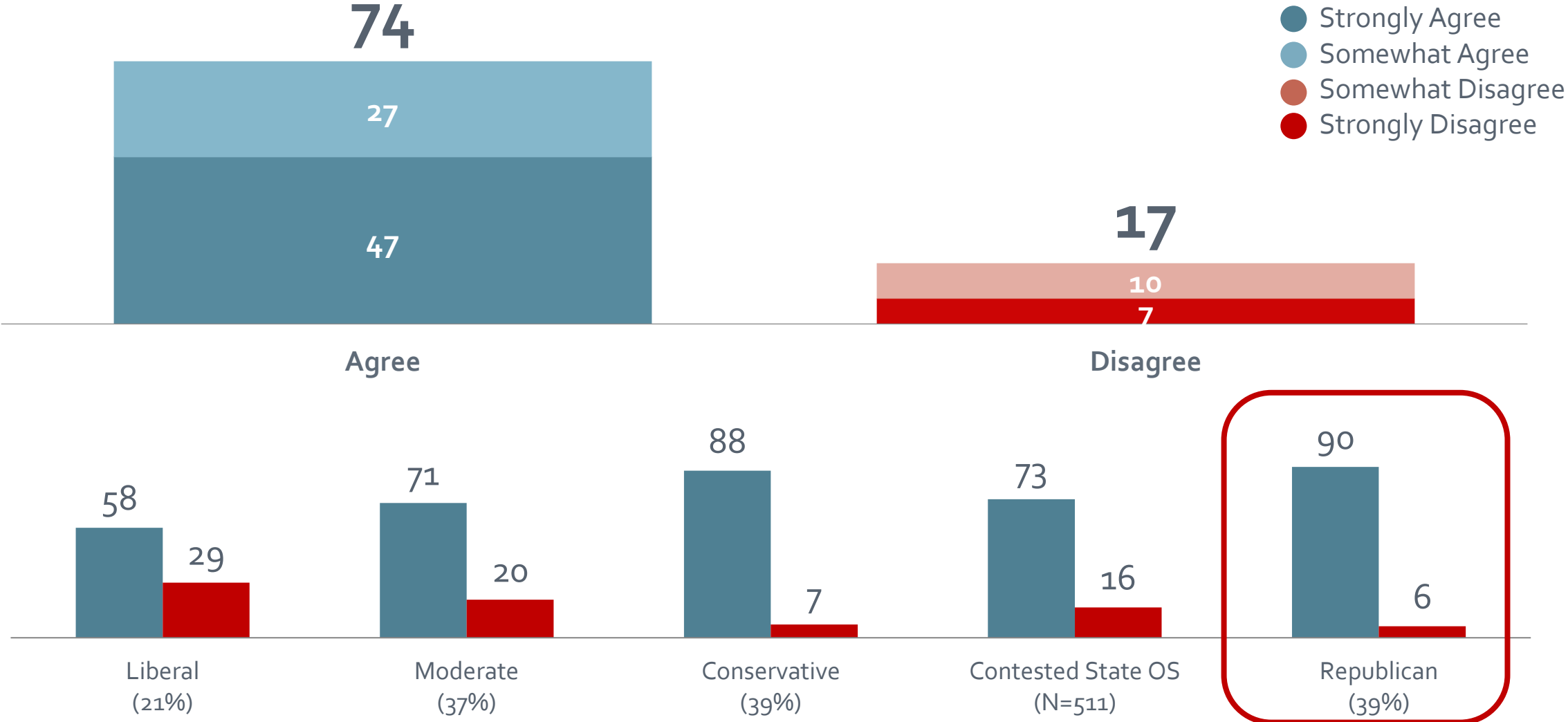

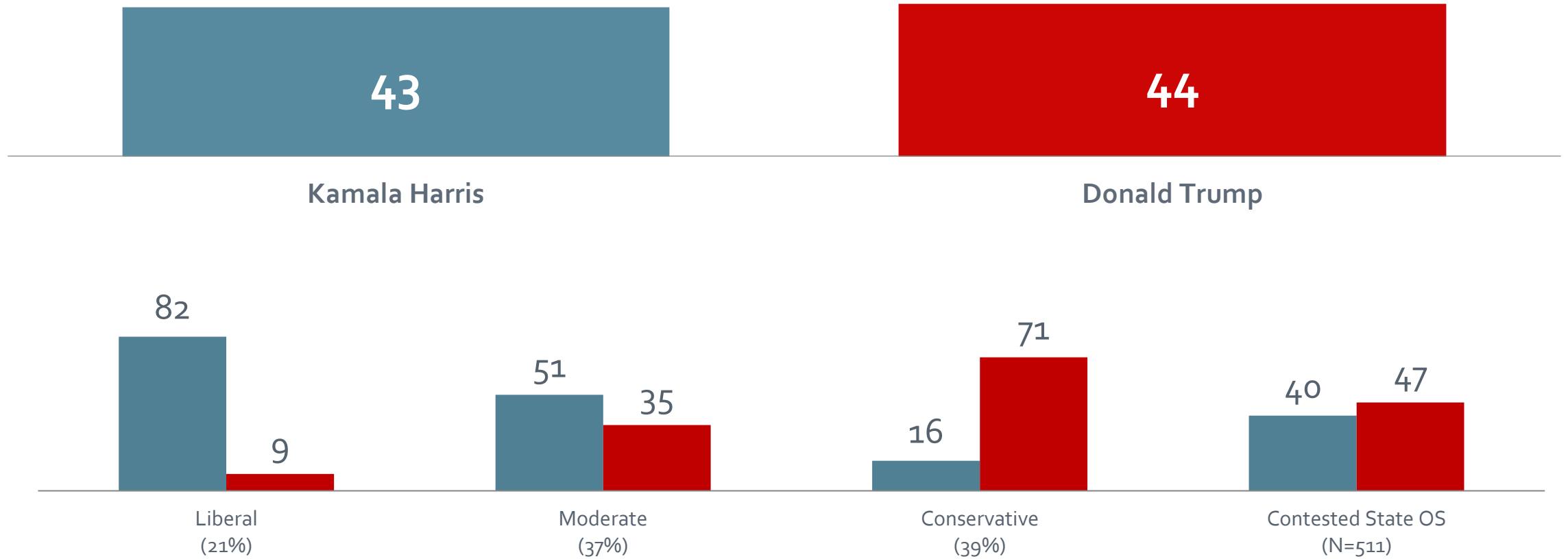
